He formerly belonged to the Fascist Party and to the Milizia. From the records of our Questura, it appears that in 1937 he was denounced to the local Procura del Regno for attempting to force a person to prostitution.
- 2) Member of the Committee - **MERUGI ELIO** fu Onere and di **CIAFFI GIAELE**; born in Naples on 12.12.1917, resident in Via Monte di Dio n. 74, married and has children, a doctor in economical and commercial science, formerly a member of the Fascist Party. No penal records in our files.
- 3) **MARTINO LUIGI** di **GUGLIELMO** and fu **DUCER MARIA**, born in Naples on 29.2.1912, resident at Vico Canale n. 46, a bachelor, a student at law, formerly a member of the Fascist Party. No penal records in the R. Questura files.
- 4) General Secretary - **BARRA CARACCIOLO VINCENZO** di **ADOLFO** and di **COSENTINI LAURA**, born in Buenos Ayres on 5.12.1913, resident in Via Giacinto Gigante n. 28, unemployed, so-called Captain in the Army and Patriot. SUBJECT: "Italian Monarchic Party" Office in Via Chiaia N. 184.

In this city the "Italian Monarchic Party" has been formed, with office in Via Chiaia N. 184. It has about a few hundred members and its propaganda is monarchic.

It has no connection with other associations of a monarchic tendency, or does it have any branch offices in other provinces.

The principle leaders are:-

1) CUTOLO Antonio fu Angelo and fu Vaccaro Carolina, born in Angri (Salerno) on 19.12.1882, resident here in Via Vittorio Colonna N. 9, chief book-keeper at the local Town Hall, captain in the army (pensioned), formerly belonged to the fascist party, no penal records in the R. Questura files.

2) CUTOLO Eugenio di Carmine and di Della Noce Edina, born at Ottaviano on 18.7.1917, resident here in Via Nilo N. 22, doctor in science economical and commercial, formerly belonged to the fascist party, made speeches during the past fascist regime, a strong supporter of the Corsican irredentism.

From our Questura files it appears that on 30 May 1943 he was warned not to wear abusively the badge of inspector of the Corsican irredentist groups, and was denounced to the Allied Summary Court for abusively publishing the periodical paper 'L'Idea'.

3) PLINI Lucifero Lucio di Giovanni Teobaldo and di Metelli Caterina, born in Terni on 15.5.1900., resident in Via Belvedere N. 11 Naples, employed at the local Town Hall, a pensioned Army Officer, formerly inscribed in the fascist party. No penal records in the R. Questura files.
