SUBJECT: Italian Union Movement.

Following letter from this Office of even number dated 15 January 1946, I communicate that the "Italian Union Movement" (M.U.I.) is headed by:-

- 1) President MONTAGNARO Albino fu Ernesto and fu Merolla Filomena, born in Naples on 29.11.1899, resident in Bagnoli Via Enea N. 10, widower with children, unemployed; it does not appear that he belonged to the fascist party;
- 2) Vice President MONTAGNARO Ernesto fu Ernesto and fu Merolla Filomena, born in Naples on 28.6.1892, resident in Bagnoli Viale Rocco Messina N. 3, married and with children, a merchant seaman; formerly he belonged to the fascist Party. From our records it appears that :-
 on 2.7.1910 he was denounced to the Judiciary Authority for attempted murder and illegal carrying of firearms;
 on 5.9.1923 he was denounced and sentenced by the Milan Tribunal to 5 years and 6 months imprisonment for belonging to a criminal gang, swindle and forgery;
 on 18.8.1937 he was denounced to the local Procura del Regno according to art. 468 C.P.
 on 29.9.1937 he was denounced to the local Pretura for insults.
- 3) Secretary GAY Giovanni fu Pietro and fu Ruotolo Anna, born in Naples on 20.9.1882, resident in Bagnoli, Viale Campi Flegrei 59, married and with children, Maresciello of Finance Guards, pensioned; formerly he belonged to the Fascist Party, no penal records in our Questura files.
- 4) Secretary for Propaganda and Press, MIGNOGNA Mario, fu Nicola and Di De Martino Concetta, born in Naples on 28.1.1914 resident in Corso Vittorio Emanuele 471, a bachelor, unemployed. Formerly he belonged to the fascist party; no penal records in our Questura files.

The movement has no paper, and it has formed a branch Office in Boscotrecase, led by CAPOZZI Vincenzo di Angelo and di De Luca Maria, born in S. Giorgio del Sannio, on 21.6.1912. Information will be forwarded concerning him.
