

Reference to letter from this Office N. 105045
dated 21 December 1945, I communicate that at the office
of the "Patriotic Democratic Party Defence of the South",
in Via Chiaia N. 197, 2nd floor, the so-called leaders
DI MAIO Leopoldo fu Luca and di Luciani Maria, born in
Naples on 5.5.1916, resident in Piazza Nazionale N. 82,
accused of crimes against patrimony and persons, who had
been warned and escaped, exploiter of prostitutes, and ~~ex~~
NIOLA Giuseppe di Raffaele and di Perrella Filomena born
in Mugnano on 12.9.1914, resident in Via S. Maria Ognibene
N. 76, accused of crimes against the patrimony, with the
help of the so-called secretaries of the party DE NICOLA
Totbie fu Pasquale and di Passeglio Margherita, born in
Torre Annunziata on 10.4.1918, resident ther in Via Vesuvio
III, doctor in law, unemployed, and PERRUCCI Luigi of unknown
father and di Perrucci Concetta, born in Naples on 4.1.1908,
resident in Cuda Sf. Sframo Vecchio N. 38, well known inciter
of patriots, accused of pretending to be a doctor, usurper of
titles and swindling, for some time used the a/m quarters
for a clandestine dance hall for speculation reasons, opening
it to the public both men and women for 100 lire per person.
Numerous complaints have been received by this

Office, especially as the office had become a rendez-vous
of well known criminals and prostitutes. On the 12 January
46 at 2100 hours a squad of agents lead by Brigadiere
AZZARRO Giulio made a raid, and in fact, found many couples
dancing, among which 15 criminals and prostitutes.
While DI MAIO and NIOLA have been deferred to the

Judiciary Authorities for the necessary law proceedings,
I suggest to your Prefettura the necessity of dispersing
said Office for public order and moral reasons, also in
consideration with the criminal records of DI MAIC and
NIOLA which this Office will submit together with the
report of DE NICOLA and PERRUCCI concerning the latters

On the 12 January 46 at 2100 hours a squad of agents lead by Brigadiere AZZARRO Giulio made a raid, and in fact, found many couples dancing, among which 15 criminals and prostitutes, also in denouncing, while DI MAIO and NICOLA have been deferred to the Judiciary Authorities for the necessary law proceedings, I suggest to your Prefettura the necessity of dispersing said Office for public order and moral reasons, also in consideration with the criminal records of DI MAIO and NICOLA which this Office will submit together with the report of DE NICOLA and PERRUCCI concerning the latters

warning, according to art. 164 T.U. P.S. Laws. Following the review of their positions to find out if they were "patriots" or not, the members of the movement, following the review, could continue to meet if they be represented by serious persons who have no penal records. At the end of the epuration, I send I feel it my duty to suggest this in order to safeguard the order and public morale, in awaiting your decisions the a/m office has been temporarily closed. I send the keys to your office of the Prefettura, so that you may consider the opportunity of placing the premises at the disposition of the Commissariato degli Alloggi, to be given to some homeless persons, eventually.

Naples, 21 December 1945

Following report from this office even number dated 19 May 1945 and in answer to request mentioned above, I communicate that at present in Naples the following Patriotic Associations were founded with the aim to collect the patriots who on the 27, 28, 29 and 30 September 1943 took part in the fight against the Germans, and accept also other adherents or sympathizers. Each Association follows its own political tendency more or less evident.

- 1) "Lega Italica fra Patrioti Combattenti Minorati e Dimezzati di guerra e politici", (Italian League of Patriots Veterans War and Political Demoted Persons), with central Office in Via Roma N. 210, has about 500 members, it has the aim to help and cooperate with the moral, economical and social reconstruction of the Country.
It is directed by a Central Committee with PRIMIZI Ugo fu Domenico and di DANTE Almerida, born in Leernia (Campobasso) on the 9.9.1902, resident in Naples in Via Ariello Falcone N. 96, a merchant, as President. In the penal records in our custody the following appears:-
On the 8.3.1910 sentenced for voluntary injury;
on the 6.9.1920 denounced for simple bankruptcy;
on the 21.2.1920 denounced for receiving illegal goods and for swindle.
- 2) "Fronte Unico Nazionale Patrioti d'Italia ed Antifascisti" (Solemnity of the National Patriots of Italy and anti-fascists), with Office in Via Tribunale N. 316. It has a few members, and for a short time printed the paper "Il Cimento" one issue per month, printed in the printing press of PANSINI Eduardo in Via Tribunale N. 316. The President is EDUARDO fu RODOLFO and di D'URSO Grazia, born in Piazza Armerina (Catania) on the 28.6.1896, resident in Naples in Via Filippo Salizzi N. 19; a painter and printer. In these records appear that in 1925 he was denounced for slandering and illegal possession; in 1928 for threatening for slandering and illegal possession; in 1931 for not observing orders from the and abusing; in 1941 for not observing orders from the

It is directed by a Central Committee with
DIRECTOR Ugo fu Tonenico and C. D'ARTE Almerida, born in Isernia (Campobasso) on the 5.9.1902, resident in Naples in Via Aniello Falcone N. 96, a merchant, as President.
- In the penal records in our Questura the following appears:-
On the 8.3.1940 sentenced for voluntary injuring;
on the 6.9.1940 denounced for bankruptcy;
on the 7.1.3.1940 denounced for simple bankruptcy;
on the 4.3.1941 denounced for receiving illegal goods and for swindle.
- "Fronte Unico Nazionale patrioti d'Italia ed Antifascisti" (Solefront of the National Patriots of Italy and Antifascists), with Office in Via Tribunale N. 216. It has a few members, and for a short time printed the paper "Il Cimento" one issue per month, printed in the printing press of PANSINTI Eduardo in Via Tribunale N. 216. Eduardo fu Rodolfo and di D'URSO Grazia. The President is PANSINTI Eduardo (Galtanisette) on the 28.8.1886, born in Piazza Armerina (Catania) on the 28.8.1886, resident in Via Tribunale N. 216, a painter and printer. In these records appear that in 1925 he was denounced for slandering and illegal possession; in 1928 for threatening, and abusing; in 1941 for not observing orders from the authorities; in 1939 sentenced to conditional sentence of three months imprisonment for injuring. In 1944 he was accused of embezzlement of looted goods perpetrated in Naples during the 4 days of September 1943.
- "Unione Patrioti Indipendenti Francesco Verde" (Independent Patriotic Union Francesco Verde), with Office in Via S. Giovanni e Paolo N. 38. The members are few, the aim of the Union is to help the patriots. It is managed by a Directive Council whose President is SAMMIGLI Vincenzo of unknown parents, born in Naples on the 7.7.1905, resident in Via

S. Giovanni e Paolo N. 26; a merchant. From the records in this Questura, it appears that in 1929 he was bankrupted and sentenced several times for contravening.

- 4) "Centro Indipendenti Patrioti Giuseppe Cerulli" (Independent Patriotic Centre Giuseppe Cerulli) with Office in Via Cirillo N. 32, and its aims is to collaborate for the rebirth and reconstruction of Italy; it has about 1000 members. It is governed by a directive Council, whose President is CAPPILLO Stanislao fu Salvatore and fu Barbato Rose, born in Naples on the 20.9.1898, resident here in Via Cirillo N. 32 e mechanic. In these R. Questura records it appears that in March 26, 1929 he was denounced for violence to Police Agents; on the 4.2.1919 arrested and denounced for failed personal injuring; on the 4.8.1922 stopped for not giving the right particulars; on the 7.10.1937 denounced for forging and swindle against the Commune of Naples; on the 30.12.1938 denounced for voluntary injuries; on the 28.3.1941 denounced for violence and affront to public functionality.
- 5) "Unione Patrioti Napoletani" (Neapolitan Patriotic Union), with Office in Via Salita Stella N. 47, with about 300 members, managed by a temporary Directive Council, whose President is RUBINO Leopoldo di Gemmo and di Rita Conetta, born in Naples on the 15.10.1908, resident in Via Salvator Rosa N. 317 a marble sculptor. In these R. Questura records appears that in 1925 he was denounced for injuring.
- 6) "Unione Patrioti Indipendenti Pasquale Formisano" (Independent Patriotic Union Pasquale Formisano), with Office in Vico Lungo Teatro Nuovo N. 15, with the aim to safeguard the individual and collective rights of the patriots, to help them morally and materially and to cooperate with the separation and reconstruction of the economical, political and civil life of the Country. The Union has about 300 members, and it is managed by a Council, whose President is TITONE Filippo Neri Michelangelo fu Giovanni and di Leardo Rose, born in Pagusa on the 4.2.1883, resident here in Via Francesco Girardi N. 3, a doctor - surgeon, no penal records in this R. Questura files.
- 7) "Il Nuovo Risorgimento Italiano - Movimento Patrioti d'Italia" (New Italian Rebirth - Movement of the Italian Patriots) with Central Office in Rome, Corso Umberto Vico Scilla N. 67. The Office in Naples in Via Medina 72, is the Regional Delegation and in the Galleria Principe di Napoli the Provincial Office, arisen with the union of the Patriotic Associations situated in the Galleria Principe di Napoli, in Via Paladino 25 and in Via Medina 72, the movement has also an Inspectorate.

in Vico Lungo Teatro Nuovo N. 15, with the aim to safeguard
the individual and collective rights of the patriots, to help
them morally and materially and to cooperate with the epuration
and reconstruction of the economical, political and civil life
of the County. The Union has about 500 members, and it is
managed by a Council, whose President is XIMONE Filippo Neri
Michelangelo fu Giovanni and di Leardo Rosa, born in Bagusse
on the 4.2.1887, resident here in Via Francesco Girardi N. 3,
a doctor - surgeon, no pensl records in this R. Questura files.
- 7) "Il Nuovo Risorgimento Italiano - Movimento Patriotti
d'Italiani" (New Italian Rebirth - Movement of the Italian Patriotes)
with Central Office in Rome, Corso Umberto Vicolo Sciarra
N. 61. The Office in Naples in Via Medina 72, is the Regional
Delegation and in the Galleria Principe di Napoli the Provincial
Office, arisen with the Union of the Patriotic Associations
situated in the Galleria Principe di Napoli, in Via Paladino
25 and in Via Medina 72, the movement has also an Inspectorate
of North, Central and South Italy, with Office in Via Paladino
25 with the aim political and defense of the Monarchy.
The leaders are :
1) CIPONE Gennaro di Carlo and di Giacomo Giuseppine, born in

Genova on the 10.5.1902, with no permanent domicile, an
ex merchant and is qualified as "National Commander".

In the penal records in the R. Questure, it appears that he was denounced for fraudulent bankruptcy and personal violence, he is called Captain but he is not known at the Local Military District.

- 2) Regional Commander BANCA FRACCIA Vincenzo di Adolfo and di Consentino Naura, born in Buenos Ayres on the 13.12.1913, resident here in Via Giacinto Gigante N. 26, so-called captain in pension of the Army, unemployed, formerly belonged to the fascist party. From these records it appears that on the 15.10.1944 he was denounced for swindle.
- 3) Provincial Commander D'ELLOGLI Alberto di Enrico and ci Pisella Filomena, born in Naples on the 7.9.1892, resident here in Via Diocesa Santi N. 20, tries to get business for undertakers. In these R. Questure penal records it appears, that he has been sentenced several times for affront, injuries, threat, abusive carrying of pistol, threatening, desertion and denounced for criminal association and receiving stolen ration cards.
- 4) "Unione Reduci delle 4 Giornate" (Union of the Veterans of the 4 Days) with Office in Via Firenze 54. Few members belong. It is managed by a Directive Council, whose President is PINOCCHIARO Giuseppe Salvatore di Pietro and su Albini Antonina, born in Messina on the 15.2.1898, resident here in Via Poggia N. 11, a nurse. In the R. Questure files it appears that he was sentenced for desertion, injuries, threatening, affront to Police Agents, illegal possession, bankruptcy, swindle continued theft and denounced for false qualification. The Office of said Association has been temporarily closed by this Office for order and morale reasons, while awaiting for orders from the R. Prefecture.
- 5) "Partito D'Azione del 20 Maggio" (Action Party of the 2nd Italian Rebirth), with Office in Via Settembrini N. 15, Politically tending towards the program of the Action Party and the Republic; it has a few thousand members. It is managed by a Directorate, lead by VITTO Vincenzo fu Giovenuti and di Marquato Emilia, born in Naples on the 5-7.1897, resident here in Via Fiorio N. 26, manager of a bar. From the R. Questure files it appears that he was denounced for abusive carrying of a knife, murder, threatening with arms, participation in a fight, threats, homicide violation, theft, violence, menace and affront to a public official, spending of forged notes, receiving stolen goods and swindle.
- 6) "Partito Demo-Patriotic Italiano" (Demo-Patriotic Italian Party) with office in Vico 2° S.Giacomo N. 5, doing propaganda in favour of the Monarchy with the proposition to oppose

di Piselli Filomeno, born in Naples on the 7.2.1892, resident here in Via Diocesa Sanita N. 20, tries to get business for undertakers. In these R. Questura penal records it appears, that he has been sentenced several times for assault, injuries, theft, abusive cursing of plazci, threatening, desertion and denounced for criminal association and receiving stolen ration cards.

- 6) "Unione Reduci delle 4 Giornate" (Union of the Veterans of the 4 Days) with Office in Via Tirense 54. Few members belong. It is managed by a Directive Council, whose President is PIEMONTEANO CRUPI Salvatore di Pietro and in ALBINI Antonina, born in Messina on the 15.2.1892, resident here in Via Poggia N. 11, a nurse. In the R. Questura files it appears that he was sentenced for desertion, injuries, threatening, affront to police agents, illegal possession, bankruptcy, swindle continued theft and denounced for false qualification. The Office of said Association has been temporarily closed by this Office for order and morale reasons, while awaiting for orders from the R. Prefettura.
- 9) "Partito D'Azione del '92 Risorgimento Italiano" (Action Party of the 2nd Italian Republic), with Office in Via Settembrini N. 15, politically tending towards the program of the Action Party and the republic; it has a few thousand members. It is managed by a Directorate, lead by PIEMONTE VINCENZO FRANCIOZI and di TORQUATO SAMILA, born in Naples on the 5.7.1897 resident here in Via Portici N. 36, manager of a bar, from the R. Questura files it appears that he was denounced for abusive carrying of a knife, murder, threatening with arms, participation in a fight, threats, domicile violation, theft, violence, wence and affront to a public official, spending of forged notes, receiving stolen goods and swindle.
- 10) "Partito Demo-Patriotic Italiano" (Demo-Patriotic Italian Party) with Office in Vico 2^e 3.Giacomo N. 5, doing propaganda in favour of the Monarchy with the proposition to oppose the extremist tendencies of the parties which do not agree with them. The General secretary is ORTILIO MARIO DI FRANCESCO and di RIOCIARDI CLOTILDE, born in Naples on the 31.3.1909, resident here in Via Filippo Kero 18, unemployed. In the R. Questura files it appears that on the 29.5.1945 denounced to the R. Prefettura according to art. 18 of the U.S. Laws of P.S.; on the 27.8.1945 denounced to the local Procure for aggravated private violence and on the 25.9.1945 denounced to the local Prefettura according to art. 18 of the U.S. Laws, also in April 1947 he was searched

by request of his wife who accused him of having an unbalanced mind. He belonged to the fascist party and to the milizie as an officer.

11) "Partito Patriottico Democratico Difesa del Mezzogiorno" (Democratic Patriotic Defence of the South Party), with Office in Via Chiaria 157 with a Monarchic tendency, the secretary is DR NICOLA TOBIA fu Pasquale and di PASSEGGIA Margherita, born in Torre Annunziata on the 16.4.1918, resident there in Via Teano 177, doctor in law, no penal records in this R. Questure files.

12) "Fronte Combattentistico Italiano" (Italian Fighting Front) with Office in Via Chiaria 157 at the Democratic Patriotic Party's Office, formed by the union of some local patriotic associations with a Monarchic tendency. The general secretary DR NICOLA Tobia.

13) "Movimento Caribaldino Antifascista Partiziani d'Italia (C.A.P.I.)" (Antifascist Caribaldini Partisans of Italy Movement) with Office in Via Grande Archivio N. 8, it has about 1000 members. Until now its political tendencies are not well known, it is a branch of the Central Office in Rome in Via Serdegna N. 1, directed by the well known general SAMUELI Caribaldini. The Regional Secretary is BENINCASA Luca fu Antonio and fu Artese Vincenzo, born in Vibo Valentia (Catanzaro) on the 31.1.1896, resident in Via S. Nicolo dei Casertani N. 5, a cabinet-maker. In the records of the R. Questura files it appears that on the 24.7.1924 he was denounced for illegal possession, on the 27.2.1932 for false statement and on the 27.4.1942 stopped for security measures.

14) "Divisione Arditi d'Italia" (Arbiti Division of Italy), with Office in the "Torrette" on the right of Porta Capuana, was formed to collect the Arditi of the war 1915-18, it counts amongst its members all kinds of arditi, patriots and people calling themselves such and its aim is to help such persons, and it tends towards the Monarchy. The leader is Commander CIANCIULLA Alfonso fu Raffaele and fu Giordano Maria, born in Naples on the 15.3.1883, resident here in Via S. Giovanni a Paolo 125, a school teacher at present unemployed. In the R. Questura records it appears that in June 1944 he was denounced by the Allied Police for abusively issuing of Arditi identity card to Allied soldiers. He belonged to the fascist party and had the appointment of "fiduciario" (sort of secretary) of the sectional group "Tarente" and was an officer of the milizia.

15) "Unione Patriottico Italiano" Patriotic Union of Italy, with Office in Via Matteo Schillizzi N. 16, about 1000 members. Its aims is to point out the sacrifice of the dead, the mutilated, the war wounded and to give to its members moral

- 12) "Movimento Garibaldino antifascista Partiziani d'Italia (G.A.P.)" (Antifascist Garibaldi Partisans of Italy Movement) with Office in Via Grande Archivio N. 8, it has about 1000 members. Until now its political tendencies are not well known, it is a branch of the Central Office in Rome in Via Sardegna N. 1, directed by the well known General SANTU Garibaldini. The Regional Secretary is BENINCASA Luca fu Antonio and zu Arrese Vincenzo, born in Vibo Valentia (Catanzaro) on the 11.1.1896, resident in Via G. Nicolis dei Casertini N. 5, a cabinet-maker. In the records of the R. Questura files it appears that on the 24.11.1924 he was denounced for illegal possession, on the 27.2.1932 for false statement and on the 27.4.1942 stopped for security measures.
- 14) "Divisione Arditi d'Italia" (Arditi Division of Italy), with Office in the Morrette on the right of Porta Capuana, was formed to collect the Arditi of the war 1915-18, it counts among its members all kinds of arditi, patriots and people calling themselves such and its aim is to help such persons, and it tends towards the Monarchy. The leader is Commander CIVARELLI Alfonso fu Raffaele and fu Giordano Maria, born in Naples on the 15.7.1893, resident here in Via G. Giovanni a Faolo 145, a school teacher at present unemployed. In the R. Questura records it appears that in June 1944 he was denounced by the Allied Police for unlawfully issuing of Arditi Identity card to Allied soldiers. He belonged to the Fascist party and had the appointment of "fiduciario" (sort of secretary) of the Sectional Group "Bertha" and was an officer of the militia.
- 15) "Unione Patrioti d'Italia" Patriotic Union of Italy, with Office in Via Matteo Schilizzi N. 16, about 1000 members. Its aims is to point out the sacrifice of the dead, the mutilated, the war-wounded and to give to its members moral and material help, assistance and legal and doctors advice. It is managed by a directive council and the President is SCHETTINI Giulio di Gabriele and di Stelle Anna, born in Naples on the 20.4.1902, resident in Via Salute 106, employee of the Assicurazione Generali Venezia. From the records in the R. Questura files it appears that he was stopped for public safety measures, and in 1939 denounced because suspected of theft.

16) "Movimento Partigiano", (Partisan Movement) with temporary Office in Via S. Brigida 16, It wishes to collect those who isolated or in groups fought against the nazi-fascist and give assistance to the demobilized partisans.

The Central Direction is situated in Nona, Vergo Corrado Ricci Torre dei Conti, the manager is GALLATI di Gonella Lodio fu Carlo and Ricciuti Maria, born in Rome on the 15.3.1907, resident in Fiazzo del Martiri 10, Naples, an unemployed tailor. From our records it appear that on the 20.11.1932 he was denounced for continued theft.

Recently in the Patriotic Movement Office in Via Chiaia 127, due to quarrels between ORBETELLO Mario and the criminal MAIA Leopoldo, ORBETELLO was expelled from the party and immediately formed for himself the Italian Patriotic Party, with Office in Vico 2^o S. Giacomo N. 5, uniting with the Association of RUBINO Leopoldo, and later they divided again for money reasons, so that at present he leaning towards the Italian Democratic Party, situated in Cagliari Umberto N. 50, while at the same time he is making propaganda for the "Front of the Man of the Street". ORBETELLO at the beginning showed communist tendencies, later Liberal and now he is a supporter of the Monarchy. In conclusion it can be stated that in each of the a/w associations under-hand currents are working, which by intrigues attempt directly or indirectly to the National Union, causing disbandments, delusions, incidents troubling sometimes also the public order, as it happened on the 27.11.1945 in Somma Vesuviana, caused by the so-called Captain CERULLA Mario fu Sigismondo and others, later dismissed from the Arditi Division and also in Pompeiiano d'Arco where the so-called patriots provoked

In conclusion it can be stated that in each of the a/m associations underhand currents are working, which by intrigues attempt directly or indirectly to the National Unison, causing disbands, delusions, incidents troubling sometimes also the public order, as it happened on the 27.11.1945 in Somme Vesuviana, caused by the so-called Captain CERNIA Mario fu Sigismondo and others, later dismissed from the Arcti Division and also in Pomigliano d'Arco where the so-called patriots provoked disorders and incited unemployed and ex POW to devastate the Alfa Romeo factories. 1

Already this Office has proposed to the local Prefecture the disbandment of said Associations, according to art. 210 of the P.U. of Public Safety Laws, as dangerous to the public order, especially in view of the elections, and also considering that their members for what concerns their political opinions, even belonging to different parties, they can hold to their beliefs.
