1. Reference this Commission's letter 6517/299/EC dated 17 December 1946, I have been further instructed to inform you that the below named Italian nationals listed by the United Nations War Crimes Commission on behalf of Yugoslavia are of no further interest to the Allied authorities. The responsibility for their continued detention, if in custody, or release, is entirely a matter for the Italian authorities. Any question of their surrender will be a matter for direct settlement between the Italian authorities and the Claimant Government.

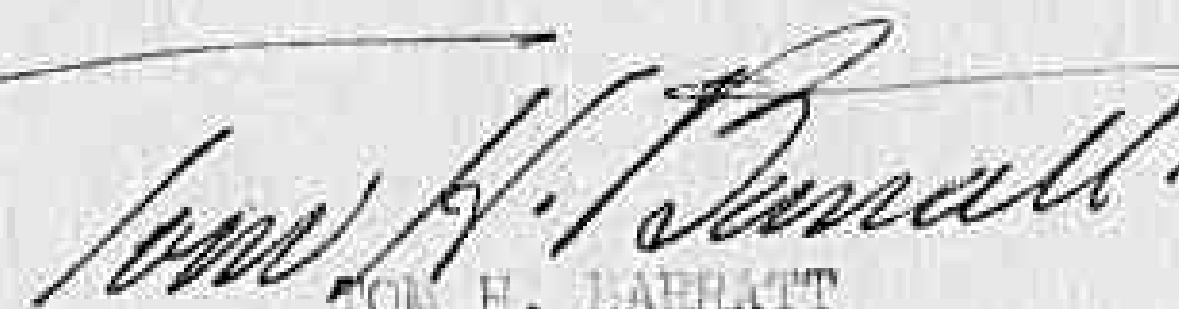

1. It is presumed that you are taking all necessary action to inform the Italian authorities that this HQ has no further interest in the Italian personnel listed at para 1 (b) of this HQ letter #6000/47/AJ dated 1 Nov 46.

2. In order to assist in the tracing and disposal of these men a schedule of references and general information is given below:

- a. Major Roberto BRUNELLI - UNWOC List No 5 Serial 73
BRUNELLI disappeared from 209 PW Camp in or after May 1946 and his present location is unknown.
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LANDINI was last located as being in 211 PW Camp, North Africa in October 1945.

HQ Allied Commission Public Safety Sub Commission Security Division letter SD/266.01-43 dated 6 Dec 45 : HQ Allied Commission Legal Sub Commission letter LC/4016/3/L dated 3 Sept 46 : G5 AFHQ minute 936.22-3 of 9 Sept 46. It appears that MADORI is in the custody of the Prefettura of PISA.
- f. PALERMO Salvatore - UNWOC List No 15 Serial 365
HQ Allied Commission Public Safety Sub Commission Security Division letter SD/266.01-88 dated 20 Sept 46. It appears that PALERMO was transferred from the custody of the Carabinieri Legion Command of BOLZANO to that of the Prosecuting Officer of the Special Court of Assize of TRIENTO on 27 Aug 46.

1. I have been instructed to inform you that the following Italian personnel listed by the United Nations War Crimes Commission on behalf of Yugoslavia are now held in a war crimes status at 1 SEP Centre Riccione:

- (a) Major General Angelo SCOMAVILLA - UNWCC List No 12 Serial 185
- (b) Federico CERRETANI - UNWCC List No 5 Serial 77
- (c) Efisio LIGAS - UNWCC List No 15 Serial 316

2. The Allied Authorities propose to hand over these men in custody to the Italian Government and as from the date of their handover, the responsibility for their disposal, continued detention or release will rest entirely with the Italian Authorities. Any question of their surrender will be a matter for direct settlement between the Italian Authorities and the claimant Government.

3. You are requested therefore to state with as little delay as possible into whose custody these men are to be handed.

2. This HQ has been instructed by AFHQ that, in view of NAF 696 forwarded to you in AFHQ cable FX 72714 of 16 Oct, the disposal of these men is now the responsibility of the Italian Government and that any question of their surrender is a matter for direct settlement between the Italians and the claimant Government.

3. This HQ proposes, therefore, to handover these men in custody to the Italian authorities: they are of no interest to this HQ and, as from the date of handover, the responsibility for their continued detention or release will rest entirely with the Italian Government.

4. You are requested to state with as little delay as possible into whose custody these men are to be handed.
