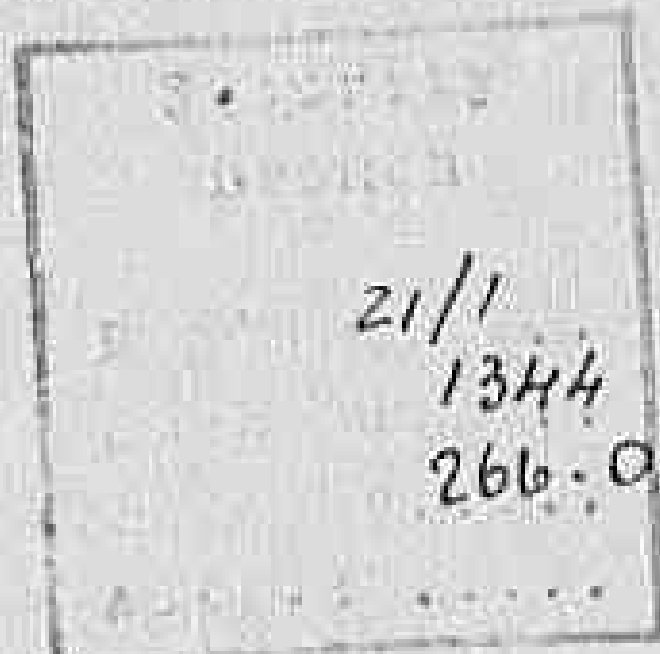

1. Reference Ministry of Foreign Affairs letter dated 16 December 1946 concerning the arrest of the above named.

2. On 20 July 1946 Commanding General MTOUSA addressed cable FX 69402 (see 1a) to this Commission requesting arrest of CHIODI, Major FUMO and DELMATO. All were urgently wanted by USFET for war crimes. All were to be handed over to Prisoner of War Enclosure No. 339 PISA for eventual transfer to PWE 20-9 DACHAU, Germany

3. This Division requested the Ministry of Interior by letter dated 22 July 1946 (see 2a) to make the arrests.

4. On 10 September 1946 the Ministry of Interior advised that CHIODI had been arrested at GENOA (see 14a) and was being transferred to US custody at 339 PWE, PISA.

5. This arrest of CHIODI was notified to HQ MTOUSA by cable 4949 (see 17a) on 13 September 1946.

6. On 18 November 1946, Prince COLONNA, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs representative attached to this Commission handed me a request (see 33a) for information regarding CHIODI's arrest.

7. This request was forwarded to HQ MTOUSA by letter dated 18 November 1946 (see 34a). Reply was received that CHIODI had been transferred to PWE 20-9 DACHAU, Germany (see 35a). This information was conveyed verbally to Prince COLONNA.

8. I would point out that HQ MTOUSA informed this Commission

in their letter dated 10 December 1946 (see 43b) that "under present CCS policies reasons for detention of FUMO may not be disclosed". It is therefore assumed that the same instruction also applies to CHIUDI who is apparently involved in the same war crimes.

ROUGH TRANSLATION

Rome, December 16th, 1946. 46A

Dear Admiral Stone,

On September 7th, 1946, following an order by the American Command, the Italian citizen Girolamo CHIODI was arrested in Genoa and temporarily transferred to the criminals of war camp 339 in Pisa and subsequently, it seems, to Dachau.

More than 3 months have elapsed since and the Chiodi family have not yet been informed either of the reasons of the arrest or the place of detention of their relative. Furthermore the family have not heard of him since.

I think it is my duty to inform you that the Chiodi family are afraid that the arrest is due to a mistake inasmuch as their relative has never been to Germany.

They state that Girolamo Chiodi, who is a medicine doctor, was sent to Albania in 1941 as second lieutenant of the "Alpini" corps, and remained in the Balkans till 1942. After repatriation he was sent for duty to Val d'Aosta and in the early months of 1943, he obtained a special leave in order to take his university degree, after which he was appointed a doctor in S. Martino Hospital in Genoa.

I take the liberty to draw your attention on the above circumstances in view of the fact that the judicial procedure in force in all countries establish, as a firm principle, that arrested persons should be brought to trial with as little delay as possible and they should also be allowed to communicate with their relatives and their Defence Counsel.

The fact that such regulations have never been applied, either in the above case or in other similar ones, is the cause of a painful impression and uneasiness among the Italian population. 00079

As far as the case in question is concerned, the fact is even more regrettable, inasmuch as the Italian Police had given a hand when Chiodi was arrested.

For these reasons, and in order to appease the family's anxiety, I should be much obliged to you, Dear Admiral Stone, if you would take this matter into kind consideration and communicate all the information it will be possible to obtain.
