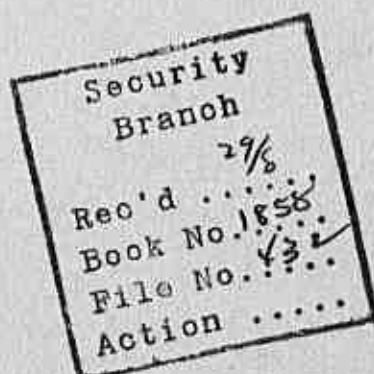
1. You are informed that the British Consulate General was reopened officially at Naples on 14 August 1944. The Consul General will perform the usual consular functions on behalf of British Nationals and Regional Commissioners should submit any communications or enquiries from British Nationals to him.
2. The area for which the Consulate General will be responsible is that covered by Regions III (excluding BARI) III and VII. The Province of Bari and the Island of Sicily may be added to the Consulate General's responsibilities but no decision has yet been taken on this.
3. Mr. Consul-General Swan is in charge assisted by Mr. B.J. Garnett, Mr. J.M. Fisher and Mr. W. Parkin of His Majesty's Foreign Service.

1. With reference to your letter (1 S.C.I./430/45 of 15th August to Mr. H.A. Coccia respecting the premises 9, Via della Gensola, further enquiries reveal as under.

2. On the door of 13 Lungotevere Anguillara a small metal plaque reads as follows "Sotto la protezione della R. Legazione di Danimarca". On enquiring within if a certain CALZAVARA lived there, the porter gave a negative reply and state that CALZAVARA lived at Piazza della Gensola 11, which information was verified.

3. It is interesting to note that although the two addresses are completely independent they both form parts of the one large building, forming one of the corners of the junction of the streets Lungotevere Anguillara and Via della Gensola.

Possible Abuse of Consular Cover.

It has been reported to this Unit that the premises at Via Della Gensola 9, formerly occupied by Baron VON KLEIN, of the Commercial Attaché's staff of the German Embassy to the Quirinale and one time agent for the German Intelligence service, have now been occupied by Col. CALZAVARA, former MVSN officer.

Col. CALZAVARA, who was one time fuel officer for the City of Rome and was recently trying to obtain a post as liaison officer between the Italian Army and the Allied Command, appears to have Danish Consular notices on his new apartment.
