

The Italian Legation in BERN has protested to the Swiss against their attitude on transit traffic, particularly with regard to a great part of transit material slated for the Nazi Ministry of War and Armament.

The Italian customs officials, who used to handle matters at CHIASSO in Swiss territory have moved to COMO under direct orders from the Fascist Government.

The following buildings in LYON are occupied by the Germans:

PALAIS DE LA FOIRE (camouflaged) : Air Corps personnel with the insignia on the blouse collar.

Air Corps General Staff personnel with insignia identical to the above, only on RRD ground instead of yellow.

BARRAGENS northwest of LAG DU PANG: The troops dig trenches (? for exercise?)HOTEL TASSIERS (Cour de Verdun) and ECOLE PIANTS (avenue Berthelot) : occupied by the Gestapo.HOTEL ROYAL (Place Bellecour), CARLTON HOTEL, GRAND HOTEL (ave Republique), HOTEL DU LION, HOTEL DE RUSSIE (ave Gasparin), — all occupied, also HOTEL GRAND DAUPHIN (ave Gralée).CAFE DES STRANGERS and LYON GOVERNMENT GENERAL STAFF : occupied by the "Plate-Kommandant".HOTEL DE NICE (Place Carnot) : occupied by military in transit.NOTES:

- (a) Luftwaffe band: concerts on place Bellecour Sunday, Oct. 10th morning and afternoon - Place de la course: Wednesday Oct. 13, evening.
- (b) Soldiers have been seen in LYON with the designation "Armenian" seen on the arm sleeve.

Manifestations are reported to have been taking place in the TOULOUSE region because of the frequent Communist radio talks over ALGIERS radio.

It is stated that there has been some change in the resistance groups' attitude, and it is believed that the many Communist radio talks have caused disappointment and strong resentment.

Furthermore, there have been attempts at the lives of personalities, which have never been fully explained to the people; the population thinks that, in many cases, these killings are acts of sheer terrorism.

Certain people who have engaged in resistance group activities, today are "marching backwards" because of the turn of events in the liberated countries.

As to the killings of people in France, it is obvious that the majority of the people favor acts which might lead to the liberation of the country; however, their opinion is that such acts be dictated by necessity and should be committed at an opportune moment. Meanwhile, the people do not want anything except to live in peace and with the least possible disorder.

Commenting on the killing of a French police official, informant states that the French people do not seem to understand that the Gestapo which exercises a complete control over the French police has automatically driven the French Police back into the camp of the Anti-German resistance.

- (a) The powder factory of ESTAGNE has been reinstated and is working for the Germans, since the Germans are delivering to Chemical Plants like KUHLMANN and ST. RAPHAEL the pyrites necessary for the manufacture of sulphuric acid. The pyrites, reportedly coming from ESTAGNE, are of bad quality. They do not "roast" well, inasmuch as they are very fine.
- (b) The powder factories of SORGUES and ST. CHAMAS are as yet not working. Also not working is the powder factory of TOULOUSE.
- (c) The KUHLMANN factory at ESTAGNE has installed an atelier for synthetic oils. It is expected that production will start in January, 1944, and that it will possibly reach an output of 25 tons a day. The date of initial production was previously set for June, 1943, but could not be maintained. The Germans had insisted, in January 1943, that KUHLMANN start production in their ethyl chloride shops. However, voluntary and other delays have made production impossible and it is not contemplated to resume production until after the war.
