He is very desirous of being released in Italy and has been awaiting certain papers which have now arrived and it will be noted that he has a signed document from the Prefect of Genoa and from an Italian family by stating their no objection to his release in Italy and that the latter are willing to maintain him until he establishes himself; he is engaged to marry the daughter of this family. In view of these documents and services he has rendered to me during his period here I strongly recommend and request that every consideration be given to his application for release in Italy and I have every confidence he will prove an asset to the community.
