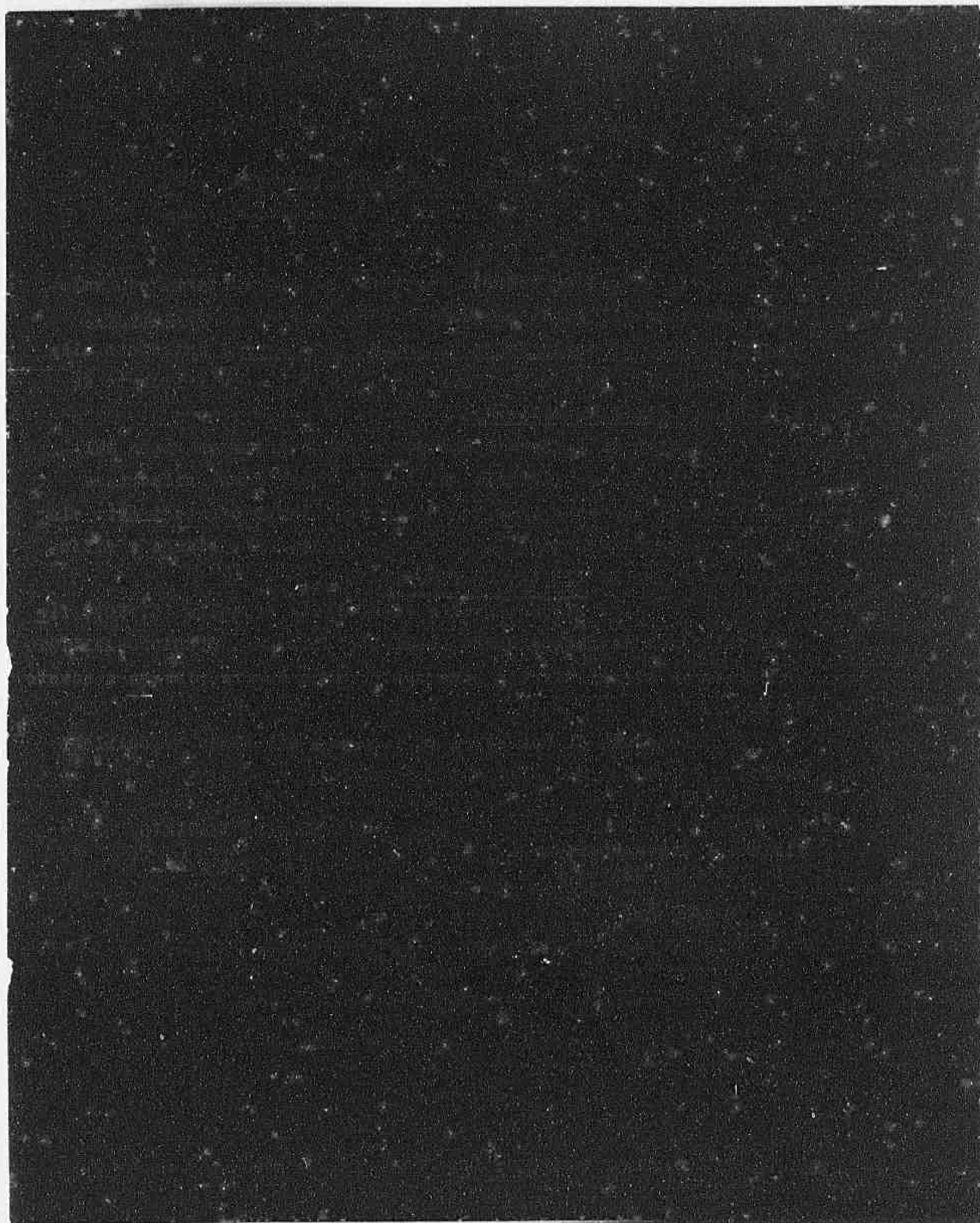

Subject : GILBERTI Ignazio

To : Director, Security Division, Public Safety Sub-Commission.

1. The following information has been obtained from various sources regarding the above named who has a prominent Fascist background and has now been appointed to a prominent post by the Italian Government.

2. Subject was born at Albano Laziale on 11/9/1878 and now lives at 46, Via del Tritone, Rome.

3. During the Great War GILBERTI was employed in the food distribution department of the Italian Ministry of Agriculture under BIGNARDI, the present Minister of the Treasury.

4. On 14/10/29 he was appointed Director General of the Istituto Nazionale delle Assicurazioni (National Insurance Institute) under a Royal Decree signed by the King, BIGNARDI and GILBERTI. He remained in this office until after the arrival of the Allies in June of this year, doubtless due to his strict loyalty and support of the Fascist Government. Shortly after the arrival of the Allies in Rome a Commissioner was appointed for I.N.A. by the Italian Government with the consent of A.C.C. The position was explained to GILBERTI as there was little known then of his past activities and he was invited to continue under the new Commissioner. He seems to have refused to accept the position as he failed to put in any further appearances at the Institute.

5. Large contributions were made by the Istituto Nazionale delle Assicurazioni to the Fascist Party whilst GILBERTI was the Director General, in fact between 1934 and 1944, the sum of L. 27,589,352 was donated, a sum which the allocation is attached.

6. On one occasion at a Cabinet meeting of the Republican Fascist Government after 8th September 1943, when FUSCO was proposed to replace GILBERTI by GILBERTI, GILBERTI is quoted as saying "Remember that after 20 years of Fascism he is worthy of your gratefulness for his faithful contributions".

7. After the formation of the Republican Fascist Party, GILBERTI is reported to have personally subscribed L. 20,000 to the Fascio of Rome.

8. Subject assisted in the removal of certain equipment from I.N.A. to North Italy and facilitated the transfer of some L. 1,587,000,000 of the organizations to the Fascist Party. He collaborated with GILBERTI who was appointed High Commissioner by the Fascist Party.

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During the Great War GREGORI was employed in the food distribution department of the Italian Ministry of Agriculture under GREGORI, the present Minister of the Treasury.

On 14/10/29 he was appointed Director General of the Istituto Nazionale delle Assicurazioni (National Insurance Institute) under a Royal Decree signed by the King, 10000 and 10000. He remained in this office until after the arrival of the King in June of this year, date of his strict loyalty and support of the Italian Government. Shortly after the arrival of the King in Rome a Commission was appointed for 10000 by the Italian Government with the consent of GREGORI. The position was explained to GREGORI as there was little known then of his past activities and he was invited to continue under the new Commission. He seems to have refused to accept the position as he failed to put in any further appearances at the Institute.

Large contributions were made by the Istituto Nazionale delle Assicurazioni to the Fascist Party whilst GREGORI was the Director General, in fact between 1930 and 1934, the sum of L. 27,559,332 was donated, a sum which was the allocation in 1934.

On one occasion at a Cabinet meeting of the Republican Fascist Party after 8th September 1933, when GREGORI proposed to resign GREGORI by GREGORI, GREGORI is quoted as saying "Remember that after 20 years of fascism he is working of your gratefulness for his faithful contribution".

After the formation of the Republican Fascist Party, GREGORI is reported to have personally subscribed L. 20,000 to the Fascio of Rome.

Subject assisted in the removal of certain equipment from L. L. to North Italy and facilitated the transfer of some L. 1,587,000.000 of the organization by funds to Venice. He collaborated with GREGORI who was appointed High Commissioner to the Republican Government and did all in his power to persuade GREGORI to join the Government. A document dealing with the transfer of equipment, Finance Administration was passed by Security Division to the Insurance Department, Finance Administration in August last. It is said that GREGORI did his best to convey to the anti-fascist elements the impression that he remained in Rome solely to protect the interests of L. L. L.

It is reliably stated that GREGORI anticipated a German victory and in fact withdrew L. 2,000,000, invested in postal bills, and sent it North.

A letter dated 2nd December 1943, addressed to Prof. Ignazio GREGORI, as Director General of National Institute of Insurance from the Italian Ministry of Insurance, asks for L. 1,000,000 to be placed to the credit of the latter to pay wages due to employees who had been dismissed after 8th September, 1943.

11. On 14th December 1943, a further letter was addressed to GURINI's Office asking for the matter to be expedited.

12. GURINI personally signed a letter on 22 December 1943 stating he would arrange for L. 1,000,000 to be made available to Unione Editrice Italiana Italiana as soon as the budgets of his organization had been completed. (The original of these letters are at the Banca Nazionale del Lavoro).

13. In a letter of 7th January 1944, a photographic copy has been made and is retained in this Division, from Unione Editrice Italiana Italiana to GURINI, as Director General, it is stated that following the instructions of the Republican Minister of Popular Culture it was decided to transfer all the machinery of the firm to Brescia in the North, and refers to the transfer of the L. 1,000,000, necessary to pay staff dismissed and the removal of the printing machines used in the publication of the daily newspaper "Il Lavoro Popolare".

14. On 15th January 1944 a letter (photographic copy in Security Division) was sent by GURINI's organization to the Banca Nazionale del Lavoro "authorising L. 1,000,000, to be placed to the credit of Unione Editrice Italiana Italiana and instructing the bank management to obtain a receipt to include the following words: "an extraordinary contribution for the year 1944, issued by L.N.I. for the editing printing and distribution of the paper 'IL LAVORO POPOLARE'". A receipt on these lines was prepared and the original is now with the bank referred to.

15. An extract from the "Gazzetta Ufficiale" No. 66 dated 19/10/44 is given below:-

ART. 1.

The Directorate of the Central Institute of Banks and Bankers is dismissed.

ART. 2.

The Chief Officer Doctor Ignazio GIROTTI is appointed Extraordinary Commissioner of the Central Institute of Banks and Bankers with all the powers of the late President and Directorate.

16. From the numerous enquiries I have made regarding the many officials of the more important insurance organizations I have not found one who was not an ardent fascist who gave both moral and financial support to the fascist party, in fact I am of the firm opinion that Insurance Directories was considered to be the best way to give tangible reward to those few who had rendered good services to fascists.

17. I respectfully suggest that a copy of this report be forwarded to A.C. of S., C-2 R.A.S.D.C. for information and consideration for intervention on the following grounds:-

- (1) A prominent fascist who through his position transferred enormous sums of money from an insurance organization to the fascist party.

(14) Supporting the Republican Fascist Party by placing 1,000,000 to the credit of the organization responsible for the publication of the leading Republican Fascist daily paper.

(15) Assisting in the transfer of considerable I.R.A. credits to the North when it was obvious that these would fall to the Allies in the near future.

(16) Making a leading part in the transfer of employees to North Italy.

Further I suggest a copy of this report be forwarded to the Vice-President, Finance Sub-Commission for his information.

1. The attached report relates to the activities of the above named and it will be seen that he has given practical support to the Fascist Republican Party, since the Armistice, has assisted in the transfer of employees and cash to Northern Italy and in general has shown that his sentiments are for the Fascist Party.

2. There is considerable feeling against GIORDANI in Rome, and in the present delicate position, I consider he can be regarded as a potential danger to Allied Security. A parallel case seems to be that of PELLEGRINI in Naples, whose continued liberty has caused so much civilian unrest which, following the disturbances in Palermo, give definite reasons for considering this to be a distinct threat to military security.

3. I will be pleased therefore, if you will carefully consider this case with a view to authorizing his internment.

1. With reference to previous report regarding the above name, I forward herewith photostatic copies of letters which passed between GIORDANI as Director General of "Istituto Nazionale delle Assicurazioni" and "Unione Editrice Sindacale Italian" in January of this year.

2. The documents show that GIORDANI authorised the transfer of L. 1,000,000 from the funds of his organisation to be placed to the credit of the "Unione Editrice Sindacale Italian" for the purpose of editing, printing and distributing the Republican Fascist newspaper "Il Lavoro Fascista". A further indication that GIORDANI remained an ardent Fascist under the Republican Regime.

1. Reference your 88/140.08 dated 3 Aug., the letter from C.C., 97 F.S. Section is not understood, and leads us to believe that the attachment made to the scheda of IGNAZIO GIORDANI has not been properly read.

2. It has never been known in this Department that GIORDANI was black-listed by the F.S. Section. The single report received from you was to the effect that he was "reported as being of good conduct."

3. The statement that GIORDANI was removed from his post (with the Istituto Nazionale delle Assicurazioni) by this Sub-Commission is not correct, as will be seen from the attachment to the scheda. GIORDANI chose not to accept the Commissioner of the Institute, and the fact that he was warned not to start a rival administration had nothing to do with whether he was or was not a Fascist, a point which still remains to be established.

4. The remark of the C.C., 97 F.S. Section about there being a 2 "fuses" regarding GIORDANI shows that he has not appreciated either the true situation, or who GIORDANI is. It is therefore repeated:

(a) that the undesirability of GIORDANI's political background remains to be established.

(b) that his leaving the Institute has nothing to do with his politics. He could have remained and cooperated, and in fact it was hoped that he would do so.

(c) that he is one of the half-dozen leading insurance men (from his connections, not necessarily his qualifications) in Italy.

(d) that he still retains six important posts in other insurance concerns (which are listed in the scheda), and that it must be established whether or no he is to be allowed to retain them.

5. Lastly, it is not agreed that membership of the Consiglio of the Confederazione in itself proves that he must have been a Fascist of importance. Such membership, coupled with his position as Direttore Generale of the aforementioned Institute and its associated companies

4. The remark of the O.C., 977.8. Section about there being a "fuss" regarding GICDANI shows that he has not appreciated either the true situation, or who GICDANI is. It is therefore repeated:

- (a) that the undesirability of GIORDANI's political background remains to be established.
 - (b) that his leaving the Institute has nothing to do with his politics. He could have remained and cooperated, and in fact it was hoped that he would do so.
 - (c) that he is one of the half-dozen leading insurance men (from his connections, not necessarily his qualifications) in Italy.
 - (d) that he still retains six important posts in other insurance concerns (which are listed in the scheda), and that it must be established whether or no he is to be allowed to retain them.
5. Lastly, it is not agreed that membership of the Consiglio of the Confederations in itself proves that he must have been a Fascist of importance. Such membership, coupled with his position as Direttore Generale of the State-owned Institute and its associated companies since 1929 is an indication to this effect, but can scarcely be regarded as sufficient proof to deprive him of his other six directorships. Little weight can be placed in what the staff of the Institute have said about him. Under present conditions, any official unpopular for any reason is liable to be dubbed "Fascist" by his employees.

6. It is to be hoped that the P.S. Section will be able to establish beyond any manner of doubt whether or no GIORDANI is to be regarded as a safe person or not.

Insurance Dept comment - Giordani was adverse to accepting Alfredo de Liguoro, who had been appointed by the Government as Commissioner for INA, Praeventia and Assicurazioni d'Italia in May 1944, with powers extended to AMG territory, and whose assumption of control of the Rome offices in June had been specifically requested by the Government and endorsed by HQ ACC. Giordani had to be warned off starting a rival directorate on his own. He was expelled by the staff in the early days of Allied occupation, but returned on the authority of Senator Scavonetti, who at the same time resumed his post as President whence he had been ejected by the Republican Government. The present Commissioner is insistent that Giordani is a source of political friction in INA, and he figures high on a list of officials whom sections of the staff want purged. Contrary to belief, Giordani does not appear to be a qualified actuary in spite of his membership of the Italian Institute of Actuaries. It is not known how a non-qualified man attained such a high position in Italian State and insurance circles.

1. With reference to the request for processing the above named, I am unable to find that there are any objections recorded from a military security point of view.

2. The following information has been obtained regarding his past, from various sources.

During the great war he was employed as Head Clerk in the food distribution branch of the Ministry of Agriculture under OLIVARI. From 1929 to 1944 he was Director General of I.N.A. and remained in this office because of his strict loyalty to the Fascist Government and it is alleged that large sums of money were transferred from I.N.A. to the Fascist Party on the instructions of Mussolini's Cabinet. He contributed L. 2,000,000 yearly to the newspaper "Il Lavoro Fascista" at the request of Mussolini's secretary. Other sums went to I.L.I. and to Depolavere. After 29th July 1943, RINALDI continued in his post under the Republican Fascist Government and gave L. 17,000 monthly to Adriano TULLI, a "Squadrista" the General Agent of I.N.A. At Turin who suddenly came to Rome and became a trusted acquaintance of General RINALDI. RINALDI, Commander P.A.I., the Republican Fascist Police in Rome. After the formation of the Republican Fascist Party RINALDI assisted the Republican Fascio of Rome by personally subscribing L. 20,000. He assisted in the removal of certain equipment from I.N.A. Rome to the north and facilitated the transfer of 65,000,000 of the organization's funds to Venice. He collaborated with OLIVARI who was appointed High Commissioner by the Republican Fascist Government and persuaded employees to go north. RINALDI endeavored to convey to the anti-Fascist elements that he remained at his post under the Republican Regime to protect the interests of I.N.A. It is said generally that he anticipated a German victory and did in fact withdraw L. 2,600,000 invested in postal bills and sent it to the north. After the Allies arrived in Rome a number of sources report he endeavored to ingratiate himself with the anti-Fascist elements.

2. The following information has been obtained regarding his part, from various sources.

During the past war he was employed as Head Clerk in the food distribution branch of the Ministry of Agriculture under Mussolini. He assisted in the removal of certain equipment from I.R.I. from the north and facilitated the transfer of 65,000,000 of the organization's funds to Venice. He collaborated with GILBERT who was appointed High Counsellor by the Republican Fascist Government and persuaded employees to go north. GILBERT said generally that he anticipated a German victory and did in fact withdraw L. 2,000,000 invested in postal bills and sent it to the north. After the Allies arrived in Rome a number of serious reports he endeavoring to ingratiate himself with the authorities and to cover up his past political activities. It is alleged that when the German Government commenced its withdrawal from I.R.I., GILBERT tried to delay it functioning and in particular to a field some of the more important ex-Fascist members of the staff including Braccato AS B. 40, Pietro TROTTA, I. ALBERTI and others.

GILBERT tried to gain support in objection to the appointment of a Commissioner for investigating the political background of I.R.I. staff through the newspaper "Lavorista". On one occasion when addressing a Cabinet meeting Mussolini said of GILBERT, "when GILBERT proposed to give the Fascist's post to GILBERT, after 8th September 1943, remember that after 20

He was inclined to quibble at the appointment of a Commissioner of the Institute by The Italian Government and ACC, and it became necessary to issue a warning to him to hand over.

A verbal security report received from you was negative of any adverse factor, but it is certainly correct that he has for many years carried out the Fascist Government's orders on all financial and other matters connected with his insurance posts.
