4. This man (Mirone) has been dismissed by this office because of his notorious fascist past. He joined the party in 1922 and was a Squadrista.
5. It is suggested that the A.C.C., should make strong representations to the Badoglio Government concerning this direct communication by the Undersecretary and regarding the type of people he wishes to employ.


In order to give S.C.A.O.s the fullest possible assistance I suggest that in the case where the S.C.A.O. has removed an official he should be instructed to notify me so that I can look into the whole question of his successor. Naturally, the successor must not only be politically acceptable, but he must have the qualifications to fulfil the appointment. It is on the latter score that some very bad mistakes might be made if the S.C.A.O.s are not given this assistance.

I have in mind as the appointments concerned, such as Provediture of provinces, University professors and Rectors of Universities.

This suggestion raises no question of precedent, as these appointments have always been from Rome.

If you agree, I will get out a letter for your signature.
