SUBJECT: Movement Orders.

TO: H. A.M.G.  
(Attention of Chief of Staff).

1. Reference your cable dated 31st, ordering me to Naples. On my return from Messina University late on the 3rd, I made immediate arrangements to comply with this order. I was told there might be a ship on the 4th or 5th. If not I was to proceed by air on the 6th or thereafter as soon as transport was available. Meanwhile I was sent for on the 4th by Lord STANSGATE to discuss general policy and prepare an immediate report. I informed him of the fact that the work of investigating professors and Catania and Messina Universities was being completed and if I had till the 10th I thought I would be done. (about 20 professors are involved). Lord STANSGATE also suggested necessity of looking into affairs of Regno II especially concerning the Como incidents. As this agreed with the suggestion made in my letter of 1st January a cable as attached was sent off yesterday which I hope has your approval.

2. The actual delay involved in reaching Naples is not more than about 4 or 5 days and it enables all these pressing problems to be settled or strongly investigated.

3. Meanwhile 3 officers are in Naples representing Education.





  - c. Rear Party - all remaining personnel.
2. Each Section, Directorate, Sub-Commission and Branch will list by name the officers to be included in the Advance Party and Rear Party and the number of officers in the Main Body. Lists will be completed on the attached forms and turned in to the Executive Officers by Section, Directorate and Branch Staff at the earliest and not later than Monday, 29 November 1943.
3. Each Section, Directorate, Sub-Commission and Branch will promptly eliminate non-essential materials and equipment. A committee, under direction of C-4 branch, will visit all offices to estimate quantities and weights of equipment and supplies to be moved. The committee, also, will arrange for marking and numbering.

TO : Lt. Colonel CHAPPS. 22 November 1945

1. Further to our talk this morning on the above subject.  
  
2. From the point of view of the work we have to do, it will be impossible to split the HQ and therefore we must either move all forward or else keep the sub-commission in the rear liaison with a responsible liaison officer forward.  
  
3. I would prefer the former course, but there are several points, at the moment, in favor of the latter. They are as follows:
  - (a) We have already made a re-organisation of our department on this basis - Lt. Colonel V. V. SHIPLEY (Deputy Director of the Conventional Sub-Commission) is leaving tomorrow to go to Trapani and remain with A.C.C.
  - (b) actually there are more universities in Sicily than on the mainland under our control.
  - (c) we are finishing off several months of work with these universities at present, and it is essential to do this quickly, otherwise it may never be finished satisfactorily at all.
  - (d) It is assumed that it will be possible for us to travel backwards and forwards in any case.
