PREPARATION OF CARDS

1. For the information and guidance of all concerned, the following instructions dealing with the preparation and submission of cards is published.

2. Preparation: Cards will be typed, and will be submitted to Message Center in a total of FIVE (5) copies, of which three (3) will be on the regular card form, and two (2) on white tissue. Such other additional carbon copies as are desired for file by the originating office or officer, may be prepared at the same time.

3. Distinguishing Information: All cards submitted for transmission will bear the following distinguishing information:

(1) The name of the originating office and officer, typed in the lower left-hand corner of the sheet.

(2) The "Card" number of the card, typed in the extreme upper right-hand corner of the sheet. Example: "P-100 123".

The purpose of (1) is to enable quick reference to the originating office of either reply or question in connection with the original card. It is for the protection of the originator.

The purpose of (2) is to facilitate quick reference on the part of the Armed Forces Agency - Island Base Section.

CARDS NOT PREPARED IN COMPLIANCE WITH THESE REQUIREMENTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR TRANSMISSION.

4. Authenticating signature and initials:

(1) All cards will be authenticated by the **1085** the originating officer, placed in the space provided for that purpose in the upper right-hand corner of the card. Such initials will appear on the third carbon copy only.

(2) All cards will be authorized for transmission by the

5. Distinguishing Information: All cables submitted for transmission will bear the following distinguishing information:

(1) The name of the originating office and officer, typed in the lower left-hand corner of the sheet.

(2) The "Cable" number of the cable, typed in the extreme upper right-hand corner of the sheet. Example: "2800 999".

The purpose of (1) is to enable quick reference to the originating office of either reply or question in connection with the original cable. It is for the retention of the cable.

The purpose of (2) is to facilitate quick reference on the part of the transmitting agency - United Base Section.

CABLES NOT PREPARED IN COMPLIANCE WITH THESE REQUIREMENTS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR TRANSMISSION.

6. Authentication: signatures and initials:

(1) All cables will be authenticated by the **1085** the originating officer, placed in the space provided for that purpose in the upper right-hand corner of the cable. Each initial will appear on the third carbon copy only.

(2) All cables will be authenticated for transmission by the signature of the Adjutant General of this organization, or of one of his regularly appointed assistants.

SUBJECT: Instructions for telephoning or passing phonograms to Senior Civil Affairs Officers

TO : All Senior Civil Affairs Officers & Headquarters Staff

1. In many cases speech may be so faint as to necessitate message relaying.

2. CALTANISSETTA:

Through GADGET direct
Through CLOVER

ENNA: Caltanissetta ask for E.T.O., Enna (Telephone is in R.T.O.'s Office, Enna) and leave message for S.C.A.O.

TRAPANI: Call 'Attack', ask for SCAO Trapani

SIRACUSA: Through Catania. If too faint, relay message.

RAGUSA: (a) Ask for 'Avveduto' then 'Tally-ho', then 'Comiso'; ask for Ragusa.

(b) Catania to 'Tally-ho'; ask for Comiso, then Ragusa.

AGRIGENTO: Direct. Ask for 'Avenger'

MESSINA: Through Catania or relay

3. The surest and most secure method of relaying a "phonogram" is to first write the message on a message form correctly and concisely. Then dictate the text clearly to the receiving operator and get him to repeat it back.

4. Senior Civil Affairs Officers may communicate with this Headquarters by the above procedure reversed.

5. Senior Civil Affairs Officers should inform this Headquarters of their Telephone numbers as military exchanges are not always familiar with them. e.g. Catania has No. 15050 for its Civilian Supply Section, and 14780 for Provincial Headquarters.

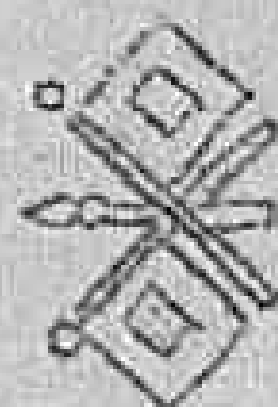
