SUBJECT : Promotion

20 February 1945

TO : Capt. Paul L. Heilman, Education Officer
Toscana Region.

Reference RVIII/E/6/3/11 of 15 February.

1. Recommendations for promotion of officers serving in Regions must be initiated by the Regional Commissioner. They can then be endorsed by the Subcommittee, which can attempt to push them through the Promotions Board.
2. On 11 November 1944, I wrote to the Regional Commissioner of Toscana Region asking him to recommend Capt. Noe, you and Capt. Tilroe for promotion. Instead he recommended only Capt. Noe.
3. I have, therefore, been able to endorse and push the recommendation of Capt. Noe, but I am powerless to do anything about your promotion until the Regional Commissioner puts in formal application.
4. Length of service is not the sole criterion for promotion. The responsibilities of the officer and the position he occupies are a significant factor, the degree of initiative he shows is another. As Regional Education Officer Capt. Noe has greater responsibilities and a higher position than you. There is reason to believe that he has more initiative. It is, therefore, not improper that these factors should outweigh the difference between his 21 months and your 25 months in grade, and that his promotion should precede yours.
5. My suggestion is that you wait until we get Noe's promotion through and that then we ask Noe to speak to the Regional Commissioner about your promotion. At that time I shall be glad to write to the Regional Commissioner again. If he will initiate proceedings I shall be glad to support them.

SUBJECT : Promotion.

TO : A/Director, Education Subcommission, Headquarters Allied Commission.

1. On 13 February 1945 I completed twentyfive (25) months in rank as a Captain. I have been in the Army since 5 June 1942, having entered service as a 1st Lieutenant and having been promoted in a little over seven months.
2. I have held an assignment in an active region since arriving in Italy over a year ago, except for a few days assignment to the Education Subcommission, approximately six months each in Region III and in TOSCANA Region.
3. I know that I was recommended for promotion several months ago while I was education Officer in Region III. It was through no fault of mine that promotions were temporarily frozen and my papers were apparently lost or forgotten. It now appears to me that I have waited in silence long enough and that something should be done about my case.
4. It has come to my attention that you are pushing the promotion of officers who have been in the service and in rank fewer months than I have. I am at a loss to understand this apparent disregard for my case. I have filled the assignments given to me without criticism or at least none has come to my attention. As a member of "the team", I am asking for equal consideration.
5. I would be pleased to know just what I may expect will be done in regard to my case.
