Through an office slip-up I had not seen the Special 1. Orders assigning Major Lund to you, although they were written at my request. I, therefore, did not catch the error in the orders. The designation of Major Lund as Regional Education Officer was due to a misunderstanding as to terminology on the part of the officer who sent the request to G-1. I am having the order amended to read "Education Officer", and also am making the date of Major Lund's Rua 1 February to let him wind up his work as PO in Aquila Province. I have had a good talk with Major fund and explained to him your ability to teach him the ropes. I have told him that your present rank is to be ignored as you should be major, and, I hope, will be before many weeks. You will find Lund, I believe, very able and energetic and rarin' to go. The more work you can give him the better remember how you felt when you came up from Tizi. His had an even longer period of sitting around. With him and Orighton to help you, and limited territory you'll surely go to town? Where Lund should report on 1 February ? Let me know, but to save time communicate also directly with him he is a P.O. in Aquila Province, at Sulmona, and can be reached by mail through the P.C., Aquila. His telephone is Sulmona 9. Section, A.C. TO (Att: Major DOLLARD). Reference our conversation 29 December. 1. The suggestion that Major LUND, if assigned to the Education Subconsission be reassigned to Piesonte Region as Education Officer would contravene our purpose in saling for Major LUMD. 2. As explained in the letter requesting Major LUND, we have only two officers competent to act as Regional Education Officers for Brilia, Toscana, and Lombardia. We must have one for each of those three Regions. Major LUMD would make the necessary third. 3. Fissonte Region is satisfactorily covered by the present arrangement to which the Regional Commissioner, the Public health Subcommission, the Education Subcommission and the officer concerned have all agreed - i.e., Major BIRT will combine his duties as Regional Welfare Officer with his duties as Regional Education Officer as he did with satisfaction to all concerned in Marche-Abrusai Region. Licutement SEWNI, REO for Liguria, will assist Major HIRT with the two southern provinces of Pismonte, he having long worked with Major BIRT in Marche-Abruszi and having agreed to this arrangement. 4. My original request that Major LUMD be assigned to the Education Subcommission for later reassignment to Toscana, Fmilia or Lombardia Region as Regional Education Officer, is therefore reaffirmed.
