SUBJECT : Promotion.

TO : VP, CA Section.

1. Major Sir Philip MAGNUS has requested that I write to you recommending that he be promoted to the grade of Lt.Colonel.

2. Major MAGNUS has been in his present grade since December 1943. He feels that his frequent changes in assignment have been the cause of his non-promotion. If this is the case, it is evidently unjust. An officer deserving of promotion should certainly be entitled to it regardless of shifts, on command, from one Subcommittee to another.

3. During his period of work in the Education Subcommittee he always cheerfully accepted every assignment given to him, and asked for more work and responsibility.

4. This Subcommittee recommends that his promotion be considered on the basis of his length of time in grade and the effectiveness of his work.
