Tomorrow I go to Frankfort for a week at the Safety School. Someone had to go and the General thought it would also give me a chance to be near my boy. He got over here for ten days during the holidays. I'll be back on the 22nd. I am planning to leave here on or about the 15th of February for Rome to attend the Consistory. My friend Archbishop Spellman is to be made a Cardinal. My cousin, the Auxiliary Bishop of Boston is expected to be there, also. There will be many things to tell you so I'll save them until I have the added pleasure of seeing you face to face. My Lieutenant was pleased with his visit and reported you well and busy. Unfortunately, so few of my old friends are left. By the way, I did want to include your gracious testimonial to my service with you in the files but it was turned down as not being sufficiently specific. May I impose on you for another? Remembrances to Miss Rombo and every good wish to yourself.
