Captain A.A. VESSELO, A.E.C., (168583) (B), Regional Director of Education for Region II, from November 17th onwards. Region II was first 5 Provinces, then 6, then 10, and is now 9. It has always been a difficult Region, with exceptionally long distances and bad communications; and on the hand-over to ACC, complications were increased by the addition of a territory which had never been under A.M.G. Captain VESSELO handled the whole of the Education for this Region alone until March 17th, when Captain GREGORY was sent from Naples to assist him. He dismissed Fascists, opened the Schools, and carried out all necessary tasks with despatch, travelling thousands of miles all over the Region to accomplish them.

Captain VESSELO has several times been recommended for promotion, both by the Education Sub-Commission and by Region II. In a recommendation made by Lt. Colonel GAYRE on February 9, he said:

"This Officer entered Region II as the first Director of Education in the Region and has done excellent work in a territory of exceptional difficulty. Although isolated and having little contact with Headquarters, and needing to use his initiative, he has always done so with judgment and discretion. He has carried out scrupulously the policies laid down by this Headquarters. I recommend that this Officer be promoted to the rank of Major."

As a Regional Director of Education, Captain VESSELO's official status makes it in any case desirable that he should carry a rank not less than that of Major, if only to give him the correct standing in dealing with the Italians.
