1. His Excellency, Prof. Arancio Ruiz, Minister of Public Instruction for Italy, is going to Switzerland with me on AC travel orders which authorize him to travel in WD vehicles and by military aircraft.

2. I shall not be returning with him, and therefore request that you facilitate his return to Rome as indicated below.

3. He will arrive in Chiasso on Sunday, 25 September, or possibly later. I have given him a letter to the Allied Officer in charge at the border in which I request the officer to telephone you and ask that a car be promptly dispatched to Chiasso to take His Excellency to Milan.

4. I have told the Minister to go direct to the dispatch office and arrange with you for passage on the first available plane to Rome. I have instructed him further to hold the car while arranging with you and then let it take him to his lodging in Milan.

5. Will you please get from him the address where he will be staying and arrange to send a car for him in time to get the bus to the airport. Please tell him when to expect the car.

6. Your help in this matter will be much appreciated.

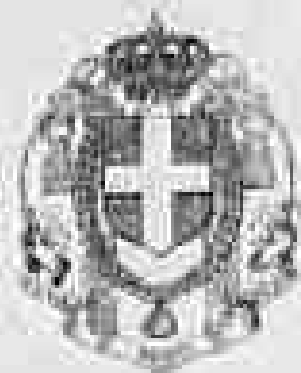

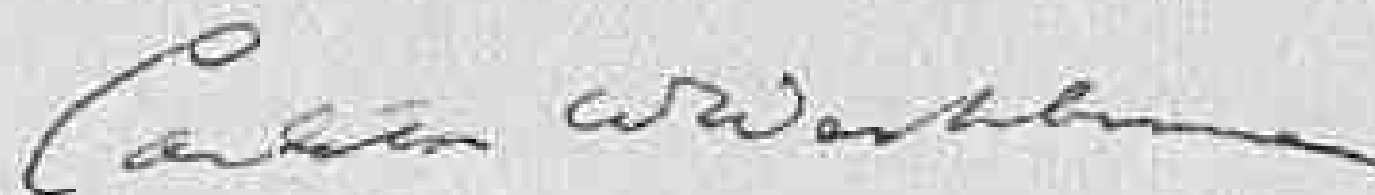

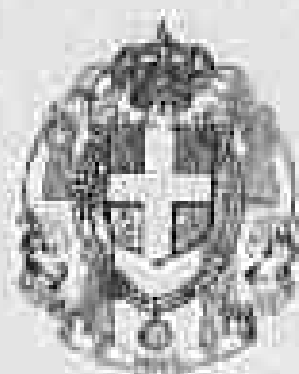
