1. The attached proposals for Liaison and AEC teams (less Venezia Giulia) are sent to you for prompt attention.
2. The appointments to be filled have been passed by G-3, A.F.H.C. and the proposed assignments are based on proposals made by Regions, etc. and in some cases by Sections or Sub-Commissions.
3. Sub-Commissions are asked to scrutinize the assignments forthwith and to take action as follows:
 - (a) Make any alterations necessary, bearing in mind that all nominations must be those of officers who are definitely remaining until at least Jan 1946 (except that in the case of the Milan Economic Group it may be decided that certain assignments may not require to be filled beyond December.)
 - (b) Fill in nominations for appointments left blank on the draft. Where an (A) is put against a blank space every effort should be made to fill it with an American officer for parity reasons.
4. G-4 (A) is issuing to you a list of American officers who have signed deferment certificates or with sufficiently low point scores to justify their nomination. G-4 (A) or G-1 (A) may be consulted by phone concerning the eligibility of any officer.
5. Your requirements in Venezia Giulia must be considered in making these nominations. Generally speaking American officers should be considered as specially desirable. It is requested that an over-all priority may be obtained there

3. Sub-Commissions are asked to scrutinize the assignments forthwith and to take action as follows:-

- (a) Make any citations necessary, bearing in mind that all nominations must be those of officers who are definitely remaining until at least Jan 1946 (except that in the case of the Latin American Group it may be decided that certain assignments may not require to be filled beyond December.)
- (b) Fill in nominations for appointments left blank on the draft. Where an (A) is put against a blank space every effort should be made to fill it with an American officer for parity reasons.

4. C-1 (A) is issuing to you a list of American officers who have signed Government certificates or with sufficiently low point scores to justify their nomination. C-1 (A) or C-1 (B) may be consulted by phone concerning the eligibility of any officer.

5. Your requirements in Venezuela Giulia must be considered in making these nominations. Generally speaking American officers should be considered as specially eligible for Venezuela Giulia in order that an over-all parity may be obtained there (even if this involves a lack of parity elsewhere).

6. Finally you are asked to submit your Venezuela Giulia nominations at the same time as those discussed above. As it is expected that your nominations for all these assignments are already practically complete, will you please submit your replies as soon as possible to C-1 (B) (Copy to your Section) as publication of the basis is now considered an urgent matter.
