1. Last February the Education Subcommittee asked the president of the Consorzio of Text Book publishers in Rome to secure for you the long list of sample books which you requested.

2. Repeated requests have met with a passive resistance. Considerable labor was involved in seeking the books in many book stores. No profit to the Consorzio was in sight. The dearth of books in Italy made publishers reluctant to send any outside. There could be no assurance that any quantities of the books you desired would be available when you decided to order them.

3. Nevertheless, after much pressure, the books have begun to arrive in the Education Subcommittee. Two packages are being forwarded to you now and others are promised within the next few days. Bills will be forwarded as different booksellers send in their consignments. It will be appreciated if you will arrange prompt payment of each bill as received.

4. Because of the shortage of books and paper in Italy it is suggested that you reprint there any books you want in quantity. Where the number desired are small, the Education Subcommittee will attempt to purchase and ship such books as are ordered. But scarcity here precludes any promise of success.

5. The publishers insist on payment in advance for any books you order in quantity. Naturally any payment in excess of quantity available will be refunded.

6. We regret the delays and the unsatisfactoriness of this response. But the conditioning elements are outside our control.

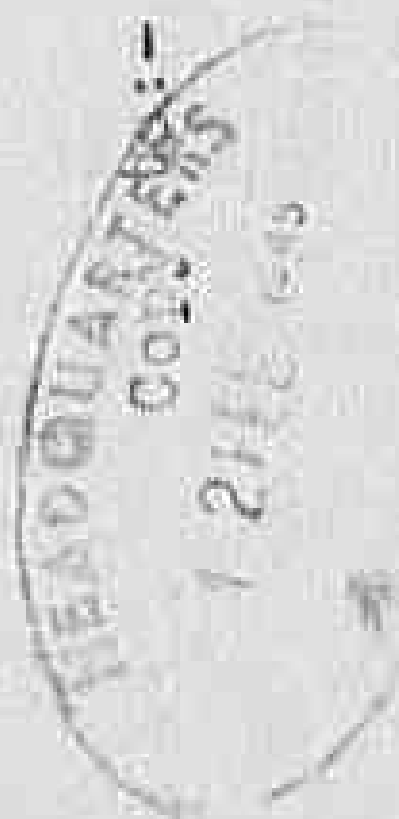

Reference our telephone conversation, 25 Jan.

1. The Civil Affairs Branch, CHQ. M.E.F., requested the Education Subcommittee to buy a few books and send them last August. They were sent, with a bill from the bookseller.
2. Eventually we were told that the money for them was placed to our credit there but that means for transmitting it would have to be worked out.
3. On 1 December we called attention to the fact that the money was not received and that we were embarrassed by the unpaid bill of the bookseller.
4. On 21 December they wrote : "Arrangements were made on 21 December to remit to you the sum of £ 1.1.3 sterling (equivalent 425 Italian Lire) through Pay Office Channels, to cover the cost of the Mathematics and Engineering Text Books obtained for this Branch in August of this year (your letter No. ED/CWW/AOC of 12 August refers). It is regretted that the procedure of crediting the sum to your account at this Branch was not found satisfactory. A copy of this Branch's letter No. 11896/409/CA of 21 December addressed to O.I/c 4 CPO (Base) Cairo, is enclosed for your information."
5. The letter enclosed read as follows :

Civil Affairs Branch

As one of the hang-overs of Empire, two groups in Eritrea have come to you through the Chief Civil Affairs Officer there to ask advice on projects going or about to be set under way. The Civil Affairs Officer asks me to report to him your judgment (1) as to "the measure of recognition you are prepared to give to students who have successfully completed the courses already held or who in future complete any specified syllabus of further study." This touches especially the Medical work which is described in the report hereto attached.

The other project, which is attached, perhaps requires advice as to the future course of a veterinary project.

Whatever the fruits of war upon empire may be, it is natural that Italian schools still look to Italian educational standards by which to measure themselves -- and to Italian schools as the goal of their students.

Whatever advice you wish to give, I shall be glad to transmit through the proper military channels.

For the last three years certain Italian professors in Eritrea have been conducting classes in medicine in order to allow students who had completed their Secondary School curriculum and wished to become doctors to proceed with their medical studies. No official recognition has been given to this "Medical School", but the British Military Administration has unofficially given it such assistance as was feasible.

2. Now that communication with the authorities in Rome is again possible the Professors of this school are naturally anxious to ascertain whether the work of the last three years will be recognised and whether students who have succeeded in local examinations will, in due course, be accepted for further study in Italy. They also wish to know under what syllabus and conditions a fourth year course would be recognised. They have accordingly addressed a letter on this subject to the Italian Minister of National Education in Rome, together with a full report on the work of the last three years.

3. I am not forwarding this letter in original since I do not consider that it would be proper to allow Italians in a territory under British Military Administration (a territory, moreover, which may well never return to Italian rule) to address a Ministry of the Italian Government, but I attach a translation for your information. I would be grateful if you would ascertain the reaction of the appropriate authorities to this proposal too.

I have the honour to hand your Excellency a report on the activities of the Asmara School of Medicine during its first 3 years of work.

The first part of the Report contains a clear Statement of how and why this School came into existence: in the succeeding parts Y.E. will find an account of its organisation, and results achieved by the School.

The last part contains brief notes on the future possibilities and some suggestions as to improvements which may be made.

I do not hide from Y.E. that this has cost a lot of work and considerable sacrifices on the part of all. But what to-day most worries the Faculty Council and myself is the responsibility which, with the passing of the years, we have assumed vis-a-vis the students, the prolongation of the conditions of war being beyond our control.

It is true that the British Authorities in Eritrea have followed with much comprehension and feeling this work of ours: and it is equally true that we have received from them much help and encouragement.

1. Your 316/389/CA of 21 July received. It refers to your 316/388/CA of 19 June.
2. I find that the letter of 19 June was not addressed to my attention, that it was delivered to Rear Hq., ACC., while I was at Advance Hq (they are now consolidated here), and that the lieutenant who received it wrote to the Minister of Public Instruction on 5 July asking him to supply the information requested by you. The change of ministers and the move of the Ministry apparently resulted in the request being buried.
3. I enclose my own answer to your questions, since I have been in charge of all elementary and secondary school programs, working during recent months, in close cooperation with the successive Ministers of Public Instruction. This responsibility for programs we have now transferred completely to the Minister.
4. I am sending you under separate cover a complete set of programs published under our supervision and effective throughout liberated Italy. These programs, however, are now being revised by the Ministry of Public Instruction for the school year 1944-45. The Minister has expressed his intention of making only minor changes at present and appointing a national commission to do a thorough job of re-thinking the whole program during the coming year, in preparation for 1945-46.

2.

5. With the programs you will find, in English and Italian, the Educational Directives we have used and still use in Military Government Territory. In Italian Government Territory these Directives are necessarily modified insofar as they make Allied Officers the channels of authority, and in some cases where they delegate ministerial powers to the Provveditori agli Studi.

6. May I take this occasion to tell you how sorry we are about the various delays, etc., regarding text-books. We printed the books under extreme pressure and under circumstances so difficult that it often seemed as if they would never be issued. When we offered to send you plans we were unaware, and apparently our printer and publishers were unaware that mats could not be made from type that had been used for printing. We could not have made mats before printing as there were no blank mats obtainable. It was not until your mats finally arrived (after having been misaddressed to "Sicily"- no city named, and having been delivered to Catania, Palermo, and Naples successively) and we tried to make themats that we discovered that it was impossible. The transfer sheets for the Sillabario were not in the case of mats and never arrived. Here we are having to reset all the books and make mats before printing, for the printing here and further north. Lack of electric power is delaying us, but we have mats and printers.

7. When your cable came today asking for original drawings of cuts we arranged for one of our officers, going to Naples tomorrow, to see whether the drawings have been preserved as we hope and as they should have been. If so, they will be sent to you by air immediately. When the officer returns Friday or Saturday (11 or 12 August) we will signal you the results. If the drawings are not available we will try to make a set of duplicate cuts for you.

8. I know that from your angle we must have seemed hopelessly slow and inefficient. Actually we have gone to the greatest pains to try to cooperate with you in every possible way. of

ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS RAISED BY PROF. F. AIBERA,
SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS, ASMARA, ERITREA.

1. The Scuola Media Unica, now called Scuola Media Superiore, is retained in all essentials except for the elimination of fascist propaganda.
2. Following the Scuola Media Inferiore the classical school consists of Ginnasio Superiore (two years) and Liceo Classico (three years).
3. The Istituto Magistrale has four years.
4. All Istituti Tecnici have five years.
5. No new arrangements have been made affecting examinations, etc., except a ministerial decree of May, 1944, establishing methods of holding examinations.
6. A set of Educational Directives which have been issued in all parts of liberated Italy and which are valid in all Military Government Territory is sent under separate cover, with all programs issued to date. Some parts of the Educational Directives, especially those which make Allied Officers the source of authority and some of those in Directive No. 3 which give Provveditore responsibilities ordinarily belong to the Minister, are not applicable to Italian Government Territory. The Programs are undergoing some revisions by the Ministry of Public Instruction this summer.

SUBJECT : VISIT OF LT.COL. T.V.SMITH TO MIDEAST

1. MIDEAST wishes to use in Italian schools the State text-books which we have purged and perpetrated in Italy. Our efforts to help this enterprise have, through a long succession of cables, involved misunderstandings and delays not yet concluded. I wish to take some material over personally and both to get and to give information on our common educational problems.

2. Going or coming I wish to visit my old Charlottesville (Virginia) teacher, Brigadier Blackley, now I believe in charge of Civil Affairs in Tripolitania, in order to get perspective upon our work in Italy from the vantage point of a newer and less tradition-ridden Italian group. The fact, too, that our educational efforts in Italy have been predominantly an American show makes me wish all the more to see what the more distinctly British-managed educational officers are doing in the late colony of this late empire.

3. This project, long delayed by pedagogical preoccupation, could now be consummated, it appears, in the lull bridging our latest turn-over and our earliest take-over of territory. If the Acting Vice-President approves the visit, would he, please, be good enough to help me negotiate the shoals of an inter-theatre mission?

2. Whether the "Liceo-Classico" begins after the three years of "Scuola Media" and lasts for five years, or whether the 4th and 5th "ginnasiale" classes followed by three years of 'Liceo' have been revived.
3. What is the duration and regulation of the 'Istituto Magistrale' (student-teacher's college).
4. What is the duration and regulation of the 'Istituto Tecnico' (Book-keeping and surveying side).
5. Whether there are any new arrangements affecting the examinations for 'idoneita', 'licenza', 'ammissione' etc.,
6. The nature of any temporary arrangements concerning the secondary schools in general.

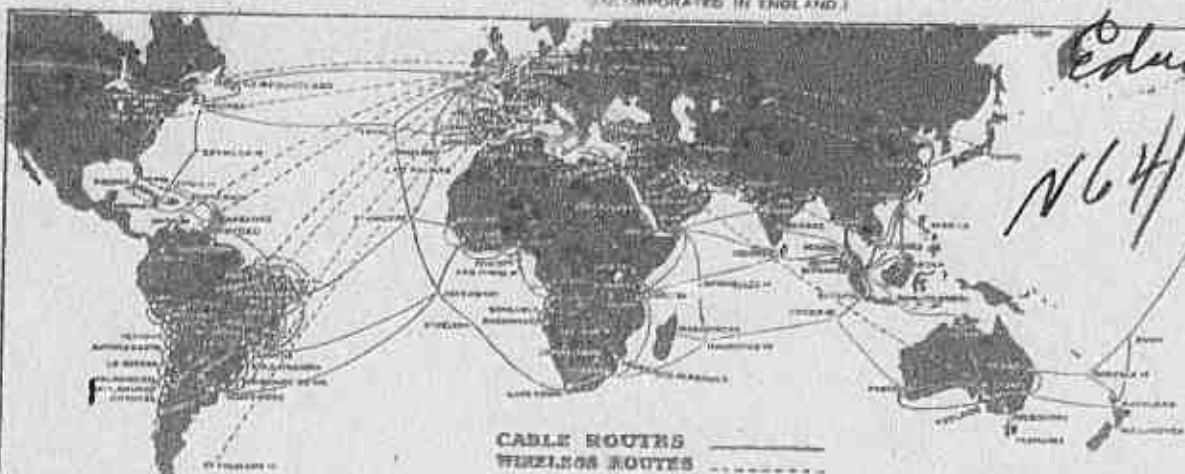
