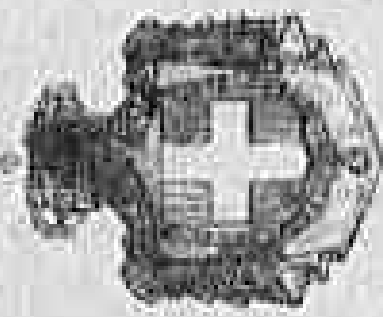

1. Herewith, in Italian and English, official Regional suspension-order for Prof. Vogliano Achille, of the R. Università di Milano.

2. Herewith also Scheda and all relevant documents regarding epuration of above person.

3. Herewith in addition documents to complete general epuration-picture, including a preliminary account sent by the Commission of Epuration on 7 July 1945, and all documents regarding Profs. Cambi and Sborgi.

4. Ref. Vogliano, the following facts are important:

- a) Vogliano is known to have mixed on the best of terms with the Germans, to have acted as intermediary between the University and the German authorities during the German occupation, and to have obtained German air-transport without any trouble to visit his wife, a German who lived in Berlin.
- b) Vogliano's case was referred specifically as "doubtful" by the Commission of Epuration to the R.S.O., with a request for a decision. The R.S.O. decided in favour of suspension, whereupon the Commission acted in a most peculiar way: when its first list of suspensions and acquittals appeared, Vogliano's name, without any explanation or even a note in passing, was entered simply under acquittals. The Commission was questioned closely about it, but never offered a

satisfactory reason for its action : it merely said that insufficient evidence had been brought forward. Whereas certain of the charges originally referred to Vogliano by the R.S.O. may have been inadequately founded, the case as in (a) above remains in full, and the Commission's action was very suspicious : it is highly likely that influences of various kinds had been brought into play on Vogliano's behalf, particularly as Vogliano is an obvious intriguer-type (on my first arrival here, he was frequently in my Office trying to get on good terms with me, presenting me with copies of books, etc.). The R.S.O. maintained that it was necessary for Vogliano to be suspended, at the very least as a precautionary measure so that the case could go up for final decision to higher authority, and the Commission therefore ultimately accepted the R.S.O.'s recommendation and made the necessary proposal.

- c) It may be that Vogliano is merely a rather peculiar mental type (hardly desirable, incidentally, for a University-Pro^fessor in his position) but it should be added that his actions, under Fascism and during the German occupation, led many (rightly or wrongly) to attribute to him certain espionage-activities : of these, there appears to be no actual proof.

1. With reference to the decisions taken by the Commission of Epuration of the University of Milano, the following considerations are submitted for your attention.

2. PROFESSORI DI RUOLO

- a) VOGHIANO ACHILLE - Reference is made to our S/840 dated July 17th 1945. The President of the Commission declare that no evidence could be found on the charges preferred against Subject. It is however noteworthy that also in the speech held by Prof. PESTALOZZA on 12 November 1940 (see file PESTALOZZA) is said "Al camerata Vogliano venne affidata dal Ministro dell'Educazione Nazionale una missione archeologica in Persia". This seems to confirm that he was "persona grata" to the Fascists. The Presidente of the Commission said that he will send a detailed report on the Vogliano case. At any rate suspension is recommended as a precautionary measure.
- b) ERRANTE VINCENZO - The case has not as yet been decided by the Commission. Information concerning Subject has been referred to the President of the Commission.
- c) VECCHI FRANZ GULIO - While in his file is contained the photographic copy of a document handwritten by Subject, stating that he was a Consul of the Fascist Militia, he did not indicate this fact in his cheda personale, and denied it in his memorandum. For these reasons he should be denounced to the Judicial Authorities. 427 FSS is aware of the case.
- d) CAMBI LUIGO - Both Professors and students have signed two letters requesting that Subject be allowed to remain in his post. Subject was, however, National Councillor and we cannot

but agree with the decisions of the Commission.

e) VINCI FELICE - From the documents contained in his file it does not appear any definite charge against Subject. Furthermore he took part in the clandestine movement. We disapprove his suspension.

f) DONATI - BOGGATTA - LASAGNA - As for these three Professors the Commission has not as yet forwarded the documents. The charges preferred against them do not seem, however, sufficient to justify a suspension.

3. PROFESSORI INCARICATI

a) ANGELUCCI NELLO - He was Sciarpa Littorio and Centurione della Milizia, charge that he had for 13 years. He should be suspended.

b) LANZANI CAROLINA - She joined the Republican Fascist Party. She should be suspended.

c) MARSILI SANTE - Member of the Directorate of the Sindacato Naz. Fascista Veterinari. Member of the Directorate of the Fascio of FIATRA. Member of the Battaglioni Territoriali Squadristi (which were the armed guard of the Party against popular movements).
Applied for membership in the Fascist Republican Party. He should be suspended.

4. As for the others we agree with the decisions taken by the Commission.
