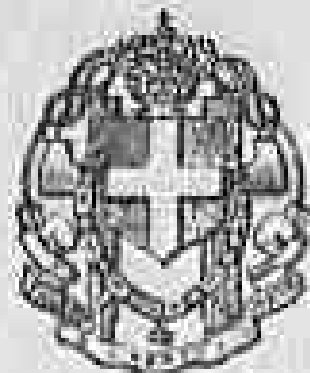

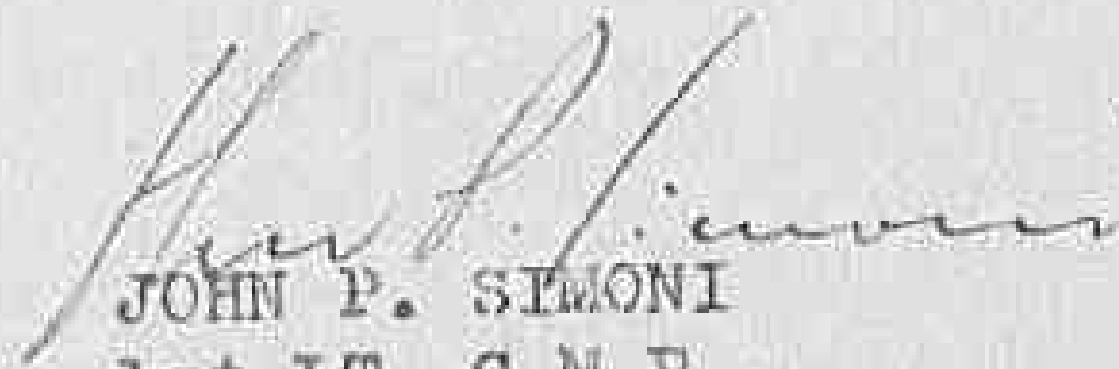

1. Reference your letter of 7 December 1944 (20031/MFAA) I visited the University Library MACERATA, on 14 Dec. contacting the Direttore Amministrativo of the University.
2. The major portion of the University is occupied as a Corps Main H.Q., and the rooms containing the books in question are being used as Offices, G.S.I. Room etc.
3. The books, of which there are some 30,000, are with the exception of some 50 old and precious volumes mainly legal text-books of no great intrinsic value or antiquity. They are in locked bookshelves and the rooms are dry and undamaged. Capt. WATNEY (Intelligence) had already kindly appointed himself unofficial "custodian" of the books and relations between the University Authorities and the occupying Unit appear to be excellent.
4. By arrangement with the occupying Unit some 50 text books needed for students during the present term were removed a few days ago by the Direttore Amministrativo, who expresses himself as entirely happy about the remainder, which he prefers should stay there in safety rather than be moved to a place of possibly no greater security and in bad weather.
5. It was agreed, however, that if any circumstances arose to cause the Direttore to change his mind, such as the use of the rooms in question for other purposes or by other occupants, every facility would be given by Capt. CUTTING (C) and Capt. EGGLESTON (G. Ops.) for the removal of the 50 or so more valuable ones. It is possible that these are the ones referred to in MFAA Advisers report of 11 Sept. 44 (para 3 d)) as having been taken to ENOLA and in part returned.

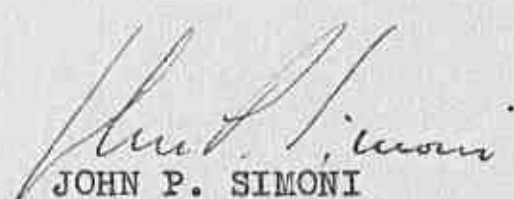
