OGGETTO: Request for transfer

As you know, I left Bergamo with my children in October 1943, on account of the racial persecution. We came to Ascoli, from where I had hoped to be able to cross the enemy lines and to offer my services to the Allied Armies.

This was however impossible and we lived in hiding here until the Province was freed in June last year.

Almost at once I was given the post as Preside of the Liceo Ginnasio here and at the end of November I was appointed Provveditore agli Studi.

It is however my ardent wish to return to the North as soon as possible. My old Mother, who has suffered very much, and my sisters all reside in the North, where I also have some property, and all my interests, also those of my children.

I would be most grateful to you if you would bear in mind that it is my wish and my intention to leave Ascoli at the earliest date possible, and beg you to recommend me for a post either as Preside of a Liceo-Ginnasio or Istituto Magistrale, or as Provveditore of one of the Provinces of Lombardia, Liguria or Piemonte, as soon as these are released.
