Liberata la citta', i coniugi Piraino si presentarono a questo Comando chiedendo di far ritorno a Livorno, ma per le disposizioni militari vigenti, fu risposto loro negativamente e fu chiesto che essi continuassero a restare a disposizione del R. Provveditore di Roma.

Stando cosi' le cose, e dovendo detti Professori riprendere servizio in Livorno con l'inizio del nuovo anno scolastico, questo Comando chiede l'intervento del Commissariato degli Alloggi di Livorno perche' ai coniugi Piraino sia restituito il loro appartamento di via dell'Eremo, 9. Qualora cio' non fosse possibile, si chiede che venga loro assegnata altra abitazione in Livorno o ad Antignano.

Si fa inoltre presente che detti insegnanti hanno perso completamente tutte le proprie masserizie per i saccheggi subiti e che il presente stipendio non permette loro di vivere in pensioni.

The Provveditore of Livorno, during my visit to that Province, gave me a memorandum for the Ministry of Public Instruction in which he asked:

1. Not to be removed from Livorno.
2. To be made "effettivo" and not "reggente".
3. To be promoted to grade 5.
4. To receive payment from 1 January 1944.

We took the matter up with the Ministry.

It is not likely that Prof. Menasci will be removed from Livorno, but he cannot be given a permanent status as this would be contrary to present disposition. It is equally impossible to grant him promotion. When he was dismissed by the Fascist Government, he had already lost his post of Provveditore and was only a Preside. He will therefore be reinstated as preside, with grade 6, (the highest grade a preside can reach) and receive payment from 1 January 1944.

The Ministry feels sure that Prof. Menasci will have a very good chance of keeping his present post and receive promotion in due course.

Will you please inform him on the subject.

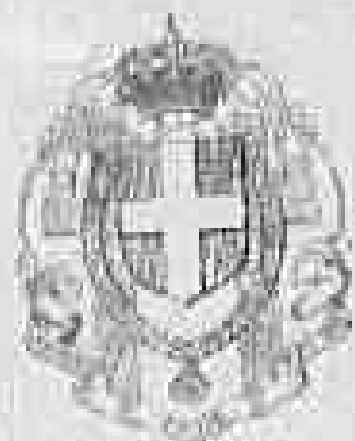

SUBJECT : Transfer of the janitor Minocci Elino

In reference to the letter of this office n. 2 from Jan 8 45 in which the application for transfer of the janitor in question from this Provveditorato to that of Siena was sent on, I inform you that the Provveditore of Siena, while not refusing Minocci the desired transfer, specifies that in his office the "subalterno" staff is too numerous and that therefore the transfer could only have provisional character.

Even in this case I wish to insist that the application of Minocci be accepted.

I doubt whether he can or wants to return to Grosseto where he would have no possibility of having a good position and I imagine that he has every interest in remaining at Siena where he is living with his family.

This supposition is supported by the fact that Minocci after his demobilization has asked for 3 successive periods of leave for reasons of health and has remained at Siena.

His transfer to Siena would therefore regularize his situation: and I do not conceal the fact that the measure would be gladly seen at this office where the provisional janitress Giulia Massai, widow and mother of 4 children, an excellent person from every point of view, could remain to fill the position.

SUBJECT: Subalterno di ruolo Balestri Ugo

Art 44 of the statute of the Scuola Normale Superiore approved in D.D. 24 Oct 1938 n. 2216 and successive modifications prescribed that the admission to positions of employees "subalterno di ruolo" of this school must be effected by way of a public "concorso" to be held by the School itself.

Since all "concorsi" have been suspended for several years and it is not possible to hold the abovenamed concorso, since on the other hand the necessities of the service are urgent and since the provisional employee Balestri Ugo aged 29 has for several years given excellent proof of his capacity as errand-boy it seemed just to me - in the interests of the school - to propose to the Directive Council in the meeting of Jan 24 1945 the assumption "di ruolo" of the "subalterno" Balestri Ugo to date from Feb I 1945. The Directive Council has unanimously approved my proposal. I beg this office to examine my proposal and, if it finds it just, to ratify it and to inform me of it. I am sending a copy of the present letter to the Ministry of Public Instruction for information.

The enclosed letter has been handed to us by the Minister of Public Instruction.

Prof. Sogaro Lorenzo, a teacher of professional drawing for 25 years, was taken by the Germans to Ravenna. On November 12th he escaped and went back to his school. He found his post occupied by a young student who had never had any experience and was the son of a "capo-officina" of that same school.

He was told by the Provveditore that all applications ought to have been sent in August. On the 5th of January he was finally assigned to the Scuola Tecnica of Bibbiena.

The secretary of his former school in Arezzo refuses to pay him the month of October, normally due to him, because he was not present at the examination session, while the school in Bibbiena refuses to pay him the months of November and December, as he was only appointed in January.

For the same reasons they refuse to give him L. 2000 (apparently due to him) and the "indennita' bombardamenti" for the past 8 months.

In his letter Prof. Sogaro goes on describing the other members of the staff, and how they all receive, in one way or the other, double salaries. Some of them do not attend to their duties.

We shall be grateful if you will investigate the case and take appropriate action.

I sottoscritti coniugi Rocchetti Montillaro Maria e Montillaro Salvatore titolari di disegno l'una nel R. Ist. Magistrale "De' Carmi", e l'altro nel R. Ist. Magistrale "Margherita", di Palermo per le eccezionali condizioni di vita determinatesi nella loro sede bombardata furiosamente, chiuse le scuole sin dal dicembre 1942, sfollarono a Siena portando il bagaglio indispensabile che, oggi, costituisce quasi tutto il loro avere. Per tutto l'anno scolastico 1943-44, essendo nell'assoluta impossibilità di tornare a Palermo, furono comandati a prestar servizio qui, a Siena, nelle Scuole Medie l'una in via Roma e l'altro in via Montoli. Quest'anno, sorpassata Siena dalle truppe anglo-americane, studiarono l'eventualità del ritorno in Sicilia, non solo per ragioni affettive e per recuperare il poco che nella loro casa è rimasto dopo i bombardamenti e i saccheggi, ma anche per riprendere servizio nelle loro scuole nelle quali erano rimasti e sono tutt'ora effettivi. Ma per quanti espedienti abbiano escogitato non sono riusciti ad organizzare praticamente il loro ritorno, impossibile sia con i pochi e rari mezzi a disposizione degli sfollati (in quanto è proibito portare bagagli) sia con mezzi privati anch'essi entrati nel circolo del mercato nero (Per i soli bagagli la minima richiesta è stata di £ 100.000!) Per quanto fortemente amareggiati avevano pensato di attendere il ristabilimento delle ordinarie comunicazioni e di metterli intanto a disposizione di questo R. Provveditorato per occupare due ~~o~~ due posti alle quali sono stati invece destinati due supplenti; ma con loro viva sorpresa si son visti completamente scaricati e ammessi a godere dello stipendio solo sino al 30 novembre 1944 con l'ordine pe-

rentorio di raggiungere la loro sede di Palermo, come se fosse possibile per degli insegnanti, per giunta sfollati e che han perduto quasi tutto, disporre di decine di migliaia di lire o abbandonare alla ventura i loro bagagli.

Per quanto contrari ai loro drammatici, i sottoscritti non possano fare a meno rappresentarli la loro situazione scoraggiante se si attuerà il provvedimento della sospensione dello stipendio dal 1° dicembre sopra tutto avendo esaurito completamente tutte le loro risorse.

Pregano che col Vostro autorevole intervento i sottoscritti possano ottenere o i mezzi di trasporto adeguati alla loro età e alla loro condizione per il ritorno a Palermo con i loro bagagli o essere per quest'anno scolastico comandati a prestare servizio in queste scuole medie o, comunque, vedere il ripristino a Siena dei loro stipendi, necessari per affrontare il rigido inverno, mentre essi, nelle condizioni attuali, corrono il pericolo di soffrire il freddo e la fame.

I sottoscritti sono sicuri che, sensibili ai gravi irrimediabili malanni subiti soprattutto dagli sfollati Voi vorrete dare presto disposizioni improntate a sensi di comprensione e di umanità.

2. As we cannot issue passes for the Provinces of Livorno, will you let us know whether we could send up Prof. Piraino Giuseppe of the Liceo Classico of Livorno and his wife Piraino Giatti Fiorella of the Scuola Campana in the same time.

3. Prof. Piraino is ready to leave Rome but having two small children and a wife on the verge of a nervous breakdown (she came here and she is really in a pitiful state) does not dare to venture to Livorno without knowing whether or not he still has a house to sleep in. He lived at Via dell'Eremo 9 (corner of Piazza Sant Jacopo) in a flat to the right on the ground floor.

4. Could you possibly find out if there is any furniture or other belongings left there. He is specially concerned about mattresses and blankets, as he did not take any thing with him when he left. It is a very sad case and we would very much like to give the little assistance we can.
