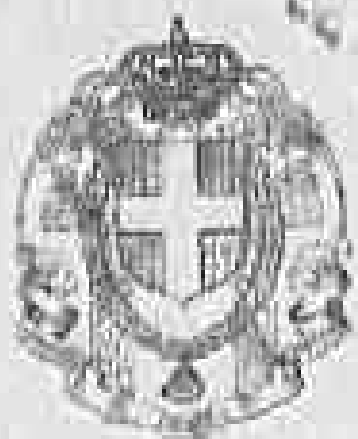

Dr. John F. Simoni, Regional Education Officer of Abruzzo/ Marche Region suggested me to contact you for the following:

As an employee at Teramo I was asked by several Italian (professors and physicians) to co-operate with them in the publication of a Review dealing with modern literature which had not been made available to the Italians for the last 20 years. They wanted me to take charge of the English written literature.

I am well prepared to fulfil their request and wish, therefore, to ask you whether there is a literature (short novels, short plays, poetry, essays) available for translation and publication in either the above mentioned Review or independently from it in a separate form for which I would try to resolve with possible help from you- the technical side of paper-supply and printing.

One of the arguments I am interested in, is: "Exile-Literature in America and England in the last 20 years". This chapter would include German anti-Nazi authors. (I myself am a German-born Jew, who came to Italy in 1933, taught, as a lecturer, at the University of Bologna until 1938 -year of the Italian race-laws-, was sent to prison and concentration camp in 1940 and reached AMG immediately after its arrival in the region in which I was living at the time).

Captain Pratt of your Division let me know, on my request, that I am likely to return to Bologna with Education Division (Letter of 5 Oct. 44, Ref.
