SUBJECT : Transfers of Teachers.

TO : Regional Education Officer,
Lombardia Region.

Reference ED/3-09 of 17 October.

1. The question of non-recognition of transfers made by AMG on the part of the Provveditore at Pavia, etc., has been discussed with the Minister.

2. The Minister is clamping the lid very tight on such transfers of *ascolati* in Italian Government Territory. He therefore does not wish to issue a general order which would seem to approve them.

3. We have therefore agreed that he will state to *provveditori* that he is powerless to prevent transfers made by AMG officials in their own territory and that therefore such transfers will have to be recognized.

4. This saves his consistency and recognizes the validity of the few necessary transfers made by you and others. We all know that you have limited transfers to the very exceptional cases.

SUBJECT : Provisional transfers of teachers between Cremona
and Parma

TO : Allied Commission HQ.
(Att: Education Sub-Commission)

1. Further to my ED/3-09 of 17 October regarding a complaint of the Provveditore of Cremona that in one or two cases Provveditori in Italian Government territory would not recognize AMG provisional transfers :

2. I have to-day spoken explicitly to the Provveditore of Cremona on the matter, and believe it now to *ad* be from a simple misunderstanding.

3. There is only one Provveditore in question, that of Parma, whose position is simply that he does not wish to retain a certain person whose original seat is Cremona. On hearing this, I informed the Provveditore of Cremona that he had no legal right to insist on such retention.

4. The Provveditore of Parma appears to have been a little high-handed in his language, but I have pointed out to the Provveditore of Cremona that his colleague's case is legally perfectly sound *in*

5. This is the only case that has arisen. My regrets for having bothered you with it.

SUBJECT : Provisional transfers of teachers

TO : Allied Commission HQ.
(Att: Education Sub-Commission)

1. The Provveditore of Cremona informs this Office that in two or three cases where, on his proposal, this Office has provisionally confirmed the transfer (originally made before our advent) of a "sfollato" teacher to his Province from another in Italian Government territory, the Provveditore of the Province of origin has stated that he does not recognize the actions of A.M.G. in this matter, and demands the return of the teachers, in line with what he claims is Ministerial policy. Our informant refers particularly to the Provveditore of Parma.

2. Will you kindly take this up with the Minister, and ask him to inform Provveditori under his direct command that provisional transfers made by A.M.G. - which are only made in special circumstances, which in all cases of the kind cited are merely confirmations of already existing situations, and which are generally in line with dispositions of the Ministry contained in eg. Circular of 1st October 1945 (Prot. n° 6780/14) - must be accepted by them.

3. It is worth while adding, that the fact that the Ministry is prepared to admit exceptions to the regulation concerning return of "sfollati" to their original posts even in Italian Government territory, which has been liberated for over a year, is a clear enough indication of the necessity for admitting such exceptions in A.M.G. ter-

ritory, which is still very much closer to war-conditions.
