1. Recent inquiry as to the requisition of schools in Bari has resulted in a letter from the Provveditore agli Studi there to the Minister of Public Instruction, showing that as of 15 October all schools in Bari were still under requisition. A list of principal schools requisitioned in Bari is attached.

2. While ten of the schools are occupied by refugees and Italian agencies, it is pointed out that the requisition of many other buildings by the Allies has forced Italians to occupy certain of the schools.

3. It is also pointed out that some of the twenty seven schools requisitioned by the Allies are only partly occupied or not occupied at all. This is in direct disregard of British Administrative Instruction No. 25 of 20 September.

4. A letter of 19 October (G-5:386.2) states that all schools in Bari and Foggia held by the US AAP have now been derequisitioned. How many of these, and which ones, are in the list of buildings still occupied on 15 October is not known, but information is being sought.

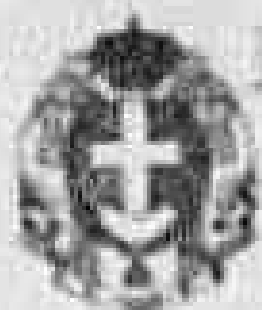

2. In his monthly report for August, the Bari Liaison Officer states that many schools in this area are still requisitioned, and adds that he has sent a list of them to Headquarters, 54 Area, requesting early release.
3. We would be grateful if you could follow this matter up, and let us know what the position is.

SUBJECT: School Buildings under Requisition.

TO : Chief Commissioner, Allied Commission, APO #394, US Army.

1. Reference your note of 26 May 1945 on the above subject. Every effort will be made to release school buildings when it is possible to do so. The present stage of redeployment of the Armies does not permit any definite program for releasing these school buildings. However, I feel that by September a material reduction in the number of school buildings can be made.

SUBJECT: Cadolelo School.

Since June 1944, the elementary school has been requisitioned by RAAC and is in use by 5th Canadian General Hospital. Some weeks ago I followed up a newspaper report that it was used by 4 or 5 nurses. This I found to be completely incorrect, since the whole edifice is in use. I spoke to Real Estate RAAC and while sympathetic to the urgent need for a school in such a bad quarter, RAAC could not entertain any idea of derequisition wholly or in part. Unfortunately at least at times, schools are well suited to be hospitals.

This morning I ascertained that:

- a) Real Estate is still of the same opinion as before.
- b) the Comune of Rome has found the problem of alternative premises for the pupils insoluble. Most of them are not attending school, although while visiting a neighbouring Church school

1. The Education Subcommittee of the Allied Commission reports that despite every effort on its part and on the part of the Provveditore agli Studi many schools in Rome are unable to open because of lack of effective action, on the part of the Prefect and Sindaco.
2. According to the latest available data from the Provveditore agli Studi, the situation is as follows:

5. Visits have been made to the Sindaco by the Acting Director of the Education Subcommittee, the Provveditore agli Studi, and, three times, by the Regional Education Officer. He is always courteous, always promises action. But no results appear. Letters to him from the Regional Education Officer and the Regional Commissioner have likewise brought no results.

6. A letter to the Prefect has been equally fruitless.

7. Public protests about the situation are mounting. The inertia of the provincial and communal officials seems to require strong pressure from your government if the failure of Rome to provide schooling for its children is not to become a public scandal.

My dear Mr. Prime Minister,

I should like to draw your attention to the very perturbing situation that exists in Rome in regard to the requisitioning of schools.

In the middle of October, in view of the serious situation in this respect, I caused my Education Officer in conjunction with the Provveditore agli Studi to make an analysis of the position in the hope that it might prove possible to secure the release of some schools.

Since that date the Allied Forces have released 16 requisitioned buildings and the Italian Armed Forces have released 9.

It appears, however, that the Italian civilian authorities have made little or no progress and so far only one building, that occupied by the Communist Party, has been released.

The present position is as follows:-

I am sure, my dear Prime Minister, that your government will desire to take energetic steps to remedy a serious situation, particularly in the derequisition of no less than 16 buildings occupied by the political parties.
