I am asking to have you brought in to the Education Subcommittee to help in the Northern Regions; but Brigadier CAIR, when I talked to him, didn't seem to like the idea of giving you up. So I don't know that we have much chance.

But any way thanks a lot for the excellent job you've done for us.

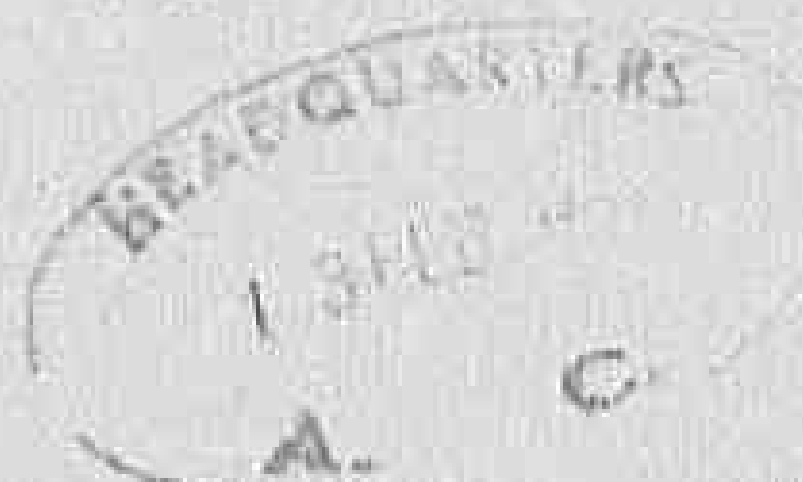
