TO: Regional Commissioner, EMILIA Region.
(Attention: Regional Education Officer).

1. Reference your EMIL/ED/100.61 letter dated 26 April 45 of the above subject.
2. We do not have 629 rolls of paper available for you. Due to additional requirements of our own we now have approximately 550 rolls of paper.
3. We called Major MACMOS on this subject and he suggested that we retain a certain amount of paper on this Region at disposal of Prof. GOOLINI. Therefore we will have 450 rolls available for you together with 92 cases of Blue Offset X. Paper for cover, to be picked up at your convenience.
4. When you have transportation available to pick this up, this office will supply the locations as to where the paper is warehoused in FLORENCE.
5. When the paper will be received by you this office will have to receive a receipt from REGION IX acknowledging it.

SUBJECT : Release of Paper.

TO : Regional Education Officer,
Emilia Region.

Reference your RIX/ED/100.61 of 26 April to REO Toscana.

1. In the light of my recent letter to you regarding the printing of text books this spring, do you still need the 629 rolls of paper and 92 cases of cover stock?
2. We are informed that there is a considerable stock of paper in Bologna. It is recommended that this be taken over immediately by you, insofar as it is not required by the combat army and is suitable for text books and quaderni.
3. It is also recommended that you conserve all paper, not immediately essential, for summer printing of text books for 1945-46.
4. In the absence of a REO in Toscana and of Major MAGNUS from this office (he is on loan to Displaced Persons), all paper releases are being handled by Captain VELLA in this Headquarters.
