SUBJECT : Quaderni.

1. Reference your letter Subject Quaderni of 14 Oct. 1944.

2. I am instructed to reply that in view of the most urgent shortage of scolastic material in Sardinia that 25,000 of the 50,000 quaderni referred to in your letter be sent to the Education Officer (Capt. Wagstaff) Sardinia region.

3. It is suggested that these be parcolled up so that they can be sent - one, two or more parcels at a time - by courier.

4. Prof. Albin knows the arrangements which Capt. Wagstaff has asked for in connection with parcelling up scolastic materials for Sardinia. It is important that consignments and invoices be in agreement with one another. I say this because in the past there have been some unexplained differences.

5. Arrangements made by Capt. Pratt and Major Washburne for the sale and distribution of these quaderni were that if there were still some left open after the close of the 1943/44 scolastic year they be sold on the market at the price arranged.

6. If, as you tell me, the reason why low-priced quaderni cannot be sold on the market is because the shops are selling a 40 lire exercise book then I would suggest severe measures to be taken by the proper authorities against these profiteering retailers.

7. It is hoped that the establishment of the Patronato Scolastico be established within a very short time throughout liberated Italy. When this is done quaderni can be sold legally through these bodies, thus cutting out the profiteer.

Subject: Quaderni for schools

To: Director, Education Sub-Commission
Hq. A.C.C. - Rome

1. Attached is a letter from Prof. Adriano Albin pertaining to the distribution of approximately 50,000 "quaderni" locally.

2. The situation has been discussed with the Provveditore agli Studi in Naples who states it is contrary to Italian law for teachers to sell such material in the schools.

3. In view of the fact that the matter involves A.C.C. blocked paper and that the local need is pressing, it is suggested that official authorization for the disposal of these be secured from the Minister confined strictly and solely to the situation now obtaining in the Commune of Naples.
