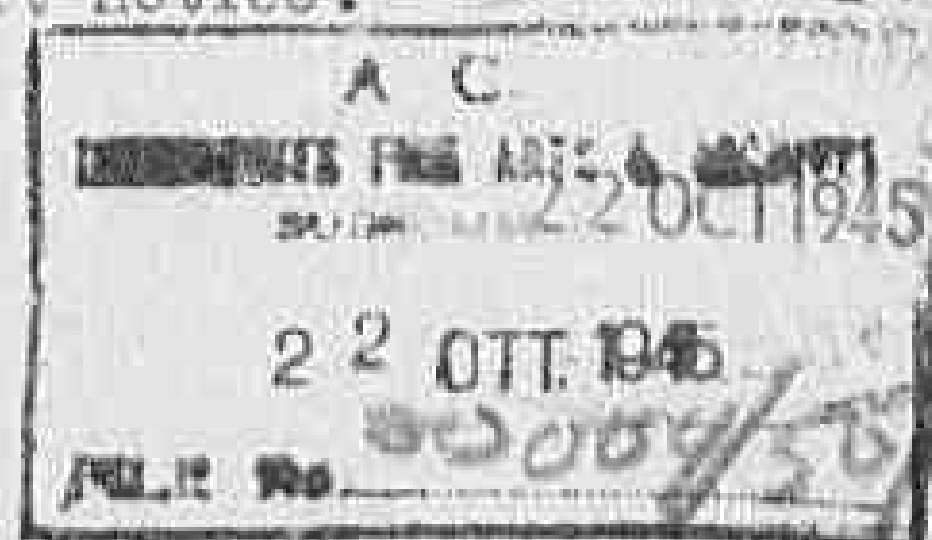

Subject:- Travel to Tripoli - Dott. Caputo.To :- H.Q. Allied Commission, APC 394,
(For Civil Affairs Section).

1. Please refer to your letter 20004/50/2/MFAA dated 3 October 45 and signal 6950 dated 11 October 45.
2. On receipt of your above mentioned letter Dott. Caputo was called to this office with a view to initiating his despatch to Tripoli.
3. Caputo stated that his passport had been sent to H.Q. A.C. for the purpose of obtaining Military Travel Authorisation and that this passport had not been returned to him. Enquiries were made to trace this passport vide telephone conversation Lt-Col White and Lt-Col MacCallum.
4. On receipt of your signal 6950, intimating that Caputo's passport could not be located, a telegram was sent to Caputo as shown at appendix "A", and the replies we received are attached at appendices "B" and "C". It will be noted from the latter telegram that Caputo now states he has never submitted a passport to H.Q. A.C., but confused a passport with a Military Travel Authorisation application form.
5. Despite all our efforts to get Caputo away which included plane reservation made through G.C. British Troops Sicily, and the provision of transport for Caputo to pick up his baggage and proceed to Catania Airport, Caputo himself presented all kinds of difficulties and left us with the impression that he is not too keen to undertake this journey.
6. It is requested that we may be informed of the action which we desire to be taken, we have requested Caputo to be prepared to leave for Tripoli at very short notice.
