LECCE, ITALY (PROV. LECCE)

The whole town should be considered as a national monument, as it is unique in all Italy for its remarkable Baroque buildings

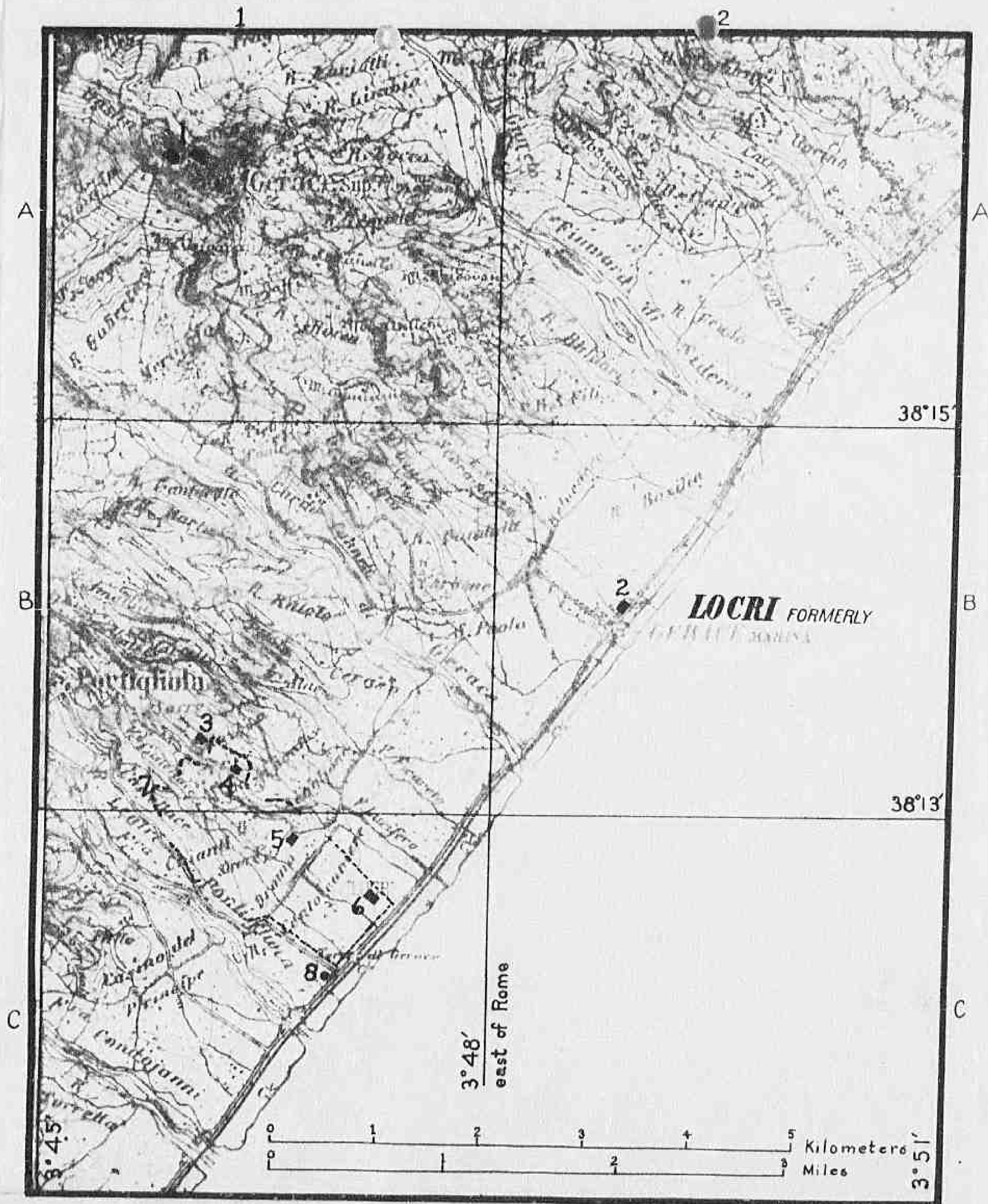

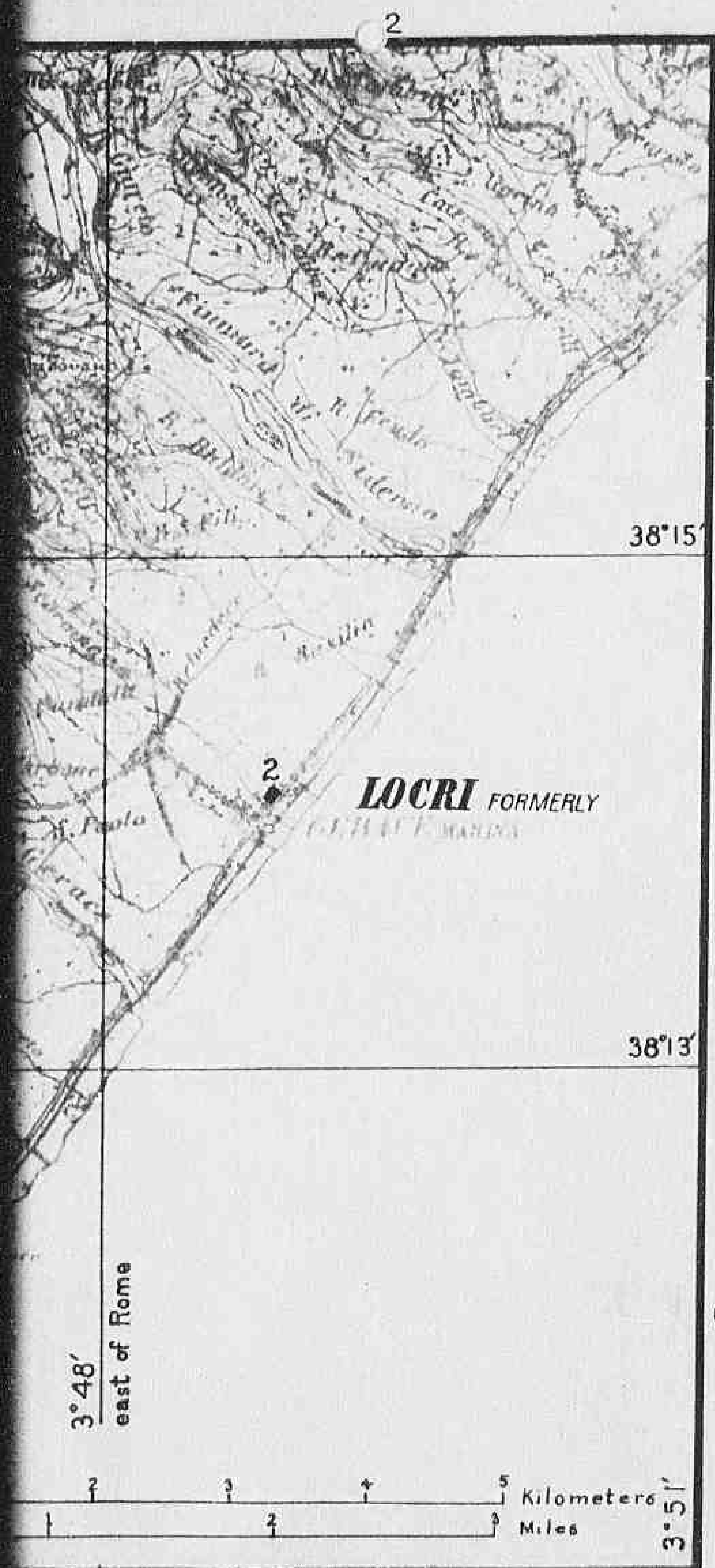

LOCRI EPIZEPHYRII

- 1 B/C-3/8 Greek city walls.
- 1B-3 *Santuario di Persephone; excavation yielded invaluable terra cotta reliefs.

- 1C-5 Tempio dorico; foundation reburied; scattered architectural fragments.
- 1C-6 *Tempio dei Dioscuri, or Tempio ionico; foundations of exceptional Greek Ionic temple (5th century B.C.), only one in Italy except fragments at Vibo Valentia (Hipponium).
