Subject : Inspection of Archives in Bergamo.

To: Regional Commissioner, Lombardia Region.

1. Ministero della Produzione Industriale.

The Archives Officer, following information that offices of the Ministero delle Corporazioni had been located in Bergamo, visited the town on May 22. These offices, which apparently were first the Ministero delle Corporazioni, then the Ministero dell'Economia Corporativa, and finally the Ministero della Produzione Industriale, were located in a large new state office building on Via Largo Adua near the Prefettura. The building is guarded by Partisans and its keys are in the custody of an Italian, Lt. Prospero Giura, appointed by the Prefetto to look after the place and its contents. Every in good order. The locking of every room retards inspection of the contents, but certainly would deter looters and souvenir hunters. The numerous offices, which appear to have been left by workers who expected to return to their desks the following day, contain a vast quantity of records pertaining to the industrial resources and production of Italy. The Archivio e Protocollo del Ministero (Room 61) was too securely locked for inspection. The small library of the ministry was in good order. The mail room contained undistributed mail. There was practically no evidence of destruction of records. Several offices contain records of the Corte dei Conti, Ufficio di Controllo per gli Atti del Ministero della Produzione Industriale. Some offices seem to contain some records of the Partito Fascista Repubblicano, Gruppo Fascista Repubblicano del Ministero dell'Economia.

orporativa (Produzione Industriale). The Provincial Commissioner, Lt. Col. D. Morley-Fletcher, is of the opinion that the Allied Commission should send an expert from the Industry Subcommission, accompanied by an Italian official from the appropriate ministry, to inspect these records and make recommendations for their use and eventual removal to Rome. The present guarding arrangements seem excellent, but the records should be returned to Rome as soon as possible.

2. Archives of Angelo Tarchi, Ministro per la Produzione Industriale.

The Archives Officer was informed by Lt. Col. D. Morley-Fletcher that he had taken certain records belonging to Angelo Tarchi, Ministro per la Produzione Industriale, from the villa in which Tarchi lived and stored them in the building occupied by the Ministero della Produzione Industriale. The Archives Officer, in the limited time at his disposal, did not find these records and will return to the building at a later date. The Provincial Commissioner realizes the value of such records and has been very careful to see that they have been safeguarded.
