Dear Professor Bianchi-Bandinelli:

We are informed by Mrs M.A. Richardson, a British subject now residing at Corso Imperatrice 22, San Remo, that a portrait of "Roderick Macleod, 3rd Lord of Cadboll", by Roscurn, was wrongfully taken from her family by the Fascist authorities in 1929. A photograph of the portrait is attached.

Mrs Richardson states: that "the Fascist Director of Art, Modigliani" seized the painting on the grounds that it had been undervalued for export; that a subsequent law suit, between Mrs Richardson and the Brera Gallery, resulted in her favor (1929); that the Pretore ordered the Brera to return the painting to Mrs Richardson; that the Fascist authorities refused to take notice of the decision; and that Sig Modigliani "was influential enough" to refuse to return the portrait, which Mrs Richardson believes is still in possession of the Brera.

Mrs Richardson says all the relevant papers in the case are in the possession of her lawyer of that time, Avvocato Agostino Lanzillo, Corso Porta Nuova 26, Milano.

In view of the gravity of these charges, would you not examine the case, taking the necessary steps to ascertain the facts and, if they warrant such action, to direct the release of the portrait to Mrs Richardson.

This office has of course no information on the case further than that furnished by Mrs Richardson.

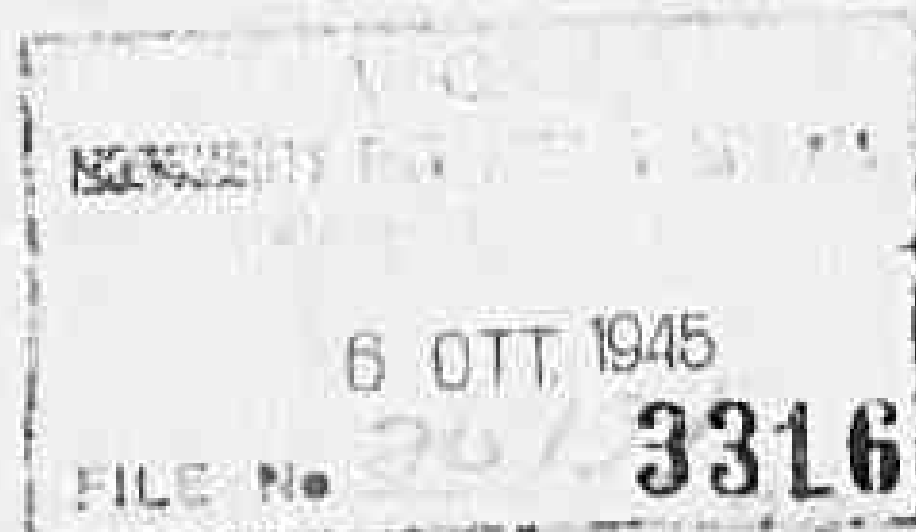

Subject: War Damage Compensation, 1945-1946

To: Regional Office, 1945-1946 Region.

1. Ref your letter of 15 Sept 45.
2. Photographs of VNCI 1945 are now in and filed.

3. The new list of projects is being developed. Be sure to provide this office, at closing of 1945, a definitive list of projects that have not been financed and that must accordingly be referred to the Ministry for Finance.

4. Whether all parish churches are to be put in order, for reasons of security or public convenience and hygiene, is a matter of policy that rests in all cases with the Regional Council. It is definitely not within the scope of VNCI, however, to improve such projects unless the Church is a national monument of distinction, or one the repairs suggested are likely to cause serious damage, and unless the funds involved are the subject of a special survey to prevent further deterioration of damage to national values. If repairs for any other reasons are to be made, it should be through another office, presumably the Regional Engineering.

5. Information regarding the situation of VNCI has been passed by the VNCI to the Office of the Regional Council, but you should arrange to keep careful track of the matter, either from your own office or through your representative in Geneva.

6. Your arrangements regarding the handling of VNCI files in Liguria, on Capt. Magenta's departure, seem eminently sound. We trust you will see Capt. Magenta before he leaves and that you will express to him on behalf of the Council the sincere thanks for the first help he has given.

2. Photographs of VENTURA are received and filed.

3. The new list of projects is noted. Be sure to provide this office, at closing of day, a definitive list of projects that have not been financed and that must accordingly be referred to the Ministry for financing.

4. Whether all parish churches are to be put in order, for reasons of worship or public convenience and comfort, is a matter of policy that rests in all on the will of the Regional Commissioner. It is definitely NOT within the scope of this, however, to approve such projects unless the Region is a national monument of distinction, unless the repairs suggested are solely those arising from war damage, and unless the funds requested are the minimum necessary to prevent further material reduction of damage to church values. If repairs for any other reason are to be done, it should be through another officer, presumably the Regional Engineer.

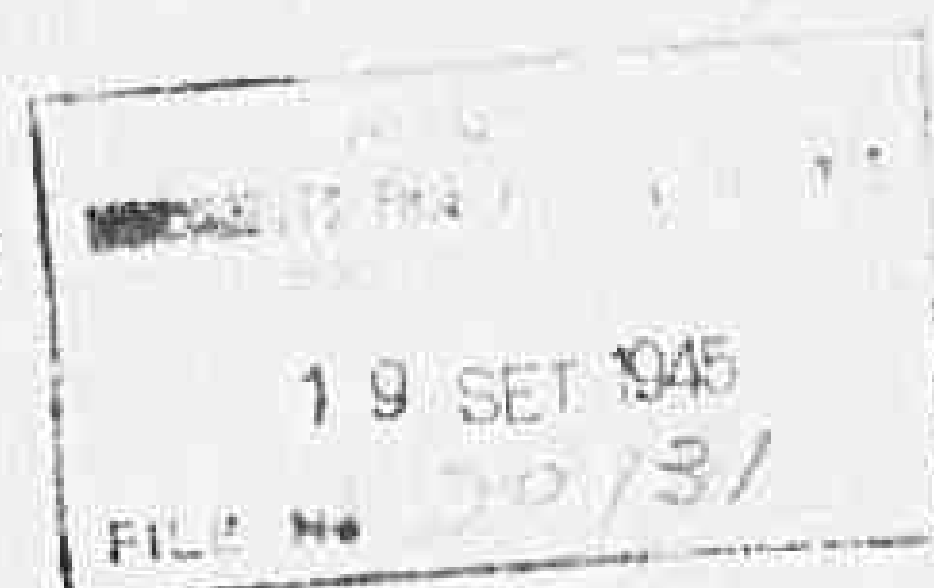

1. - Herewith copies of further photographs of war damage at Ventimiglia, taken by Prof. Lamboglia. It is confirmed that the Genio Civile at Imperia have been instructed by the Superintendent of Monuments to submit 5 projects as quickly as possible.

2. - The attached lists of projects for the Region supersedes that forwarded to you on 7 Sept. 45. Referring to Pal. Pignone (35) this project had been submitted to A.M.G. at 3.000.000 l. This did not appear to be justified and I have instructed Arch. Ceschi to revise the figures to include only work for preservation.

3. - Referring to Capt. Wagstaff's letter LIC/ED/MFA/22 dated 31 Aug. 45, of which I forwarded to you a copy on Sept. 7.

P.2. Ceriale Ligure. I examined this project for 3.200.000.== 1. which was with P.W. and U. waiting to go to Rome. It included considerable work of reconstruction of this church of certain merit but not listed. I gave instructions for the project to be revised to be kept under a million and include only urgent work for preservation. Or this point Capt. Wagstaff maintained that it is 'Policy' to put in order all Parish Churches and recommend the projects under MFAA. Is this so? It's news to me and has not been followed in Turin.

P.3. Pal. Ducale, Doria Tursi e Rosso. These schemes were submitted to A.M.G. direct by the Municipio without 3341 through the Soprintendenza and therefore were not included in the main list of projects. A fourth has been added. Pal. Bianca 5.343.000 l. itself used as Municipal offices.

4. - Arrangements have been made with A.M.G. Civilian trucking CO. to bring back to Genova at the beginning of October cases from the Deposits of Gavi and Tiglieto.

5. - Reference your letter 20909/20/MFAA. I unfortunately only received this on my return from Genoa, after passing twice through Sturla. I have taken this matter up with Capt. Wagstaff and Soprintendenza of Galleries.

6. - Capt. Wagstaff will be leaving for Release on 24 Sept. after which his office will be closed. I have arranged for all his MFAA documents to be left with the Adjutant, not to be sent to Archives without my prior agreement.

1. Ref your PR/FA/504/4a of 30 Aug 45.
2. We learn from Public Works and Utilities Subcommission that Regional Engineer Liguria did not stop reviewing projects on 15 Aug but is probably stopping today.
3. It is therefore all the more necessary for us to have a revised definitive list of projects that are deemed necessary in Liguria but that could not be financed by AMG. Such information will be passed to the Direction General of Antiquities and Fine Arts, for follow-up when the Italian Government takes over.
4. Regarding Ventimiglia in particular, it is assumed that your "Recommendations" mean that the Genio Civile of Imperia is preparing projects with the cooperation and knowledge of the Superintendency, for submittal ultimately to the Direction General. If this is not your meaning, will you please clarify?

Piemonte Region.1. - MONUMENTS, FINE ARTS & ARCHIVES

Work in this department has been restricted to approving schemes for making Monuments wind and water tight and a total of 54 schemes have so far been approved.

2. The war damaged church at Cerialle Ligure was visited but this is a 3/4.000.000 lire job at least and so no action can at present be taken though I was assured by the Priest that a scheme had already been forwarded to ROME by the through the Italian channels.

3. On 29 August 45 the following Monuments were visited in GENOVA accompanied by the Public Works & Utilities Officer in charge of schemes:

(i) Ducal Palace (now Courthouse). This place has been extensively damaged and an L.8.000.000 scheme has been submitted.

Major HALMITON (PW & U Division) was satisfied that the amount was "not unreasonable".

(ii) Doria Tursi Palace. Here there is a L.3.000.000 scheme (mostly roofing) again "not unreasonable".

(iii) Rosso Palace. Here the L.4.000.000 project is merely to make the place wind and water tight a very much larger sum will be necessary to reinstate the Palace.

Generally : Visits were paid to GENOA by the undersigned on 11, 17, 24 and 28 Aug. 45. The five groups of projects submitted by the Soprintendenza were traced and their passage through the A.M.G. Education, Public Works and Finance offices expedited as far as possible to beat the closing date for receiving schemes.

To date financial approval has been obtained for 6 projects, on 1 of which work has already started.

Capt. Wagstaff was contacted on the last visit, material for the Final Report being discussed.

Reports : On 28 Aug. 45 the undersigned inspected VENTIMIGLIA, accompanied by Prof. Lamboglia of the Museo Bicknell, Via Romana, Bordighera. The town both old and new, particularly the former, has suffered considerable damage from sea-and land-shelling.

Cathedral. - Shell-hit on facade corresponding to point where south aisle abuts nave, damaging stonework, also side windows, guttering, etc. Half the roof-covering of marsigliesi tiles has gone, but vault intact except for shell-hole in apse semi-dome where decorations fortunately are of little importance. Slate roof to Cupola intact. Stonework to Campanile damaged but not enough to affect stability. Stonework to portal, including several column-shafts, damaged ; wood door pitted.

Recommendations : Roof-tiling to be repaired as soon as possible. Shell-hole in facade to be protected from the weather until repaired.

Baptistry. Intact, including fonts, low relief fragments, etc.

Bishops Palace. Minor shell damage. Building of secondary importance.

Seminary. - ditto.

offices expedited as far as possible to beat the closing date for receiving schemes.

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Bishops Palace. Minor shell damage. Building of secondary importance.

Seminary. - ditto.

Also nearby:

Ospedale di S. Spirito with Chiesa di S. Antonio. - Shell hole in north facade, an important component of the Cathedral group. Roof covering completely destroyed. Two holes in vault. Pictures saved.

Recommendations: Although this building is not listed it is recommended that repairs to the roof be carried out as soon as possible.

Oratorio di S. Giovanni Battista. - Roof tiling shattered. Minor shell hits. Wood statue damaged and being repaired in S. Remo. Pictures reported saved.

Recommendations : Although this building is not listed, it is recommended that repairs to the roof be carried out as soon as possible.

S. Michele. - Facade, restored in false stonework, peppered by fragments but not seriously damaged. Shell holes on both sides but not enough to endanger stability of structure. Fine stone campanile and apse intact. Tegole roof covering to both church and campanile badly shattered.

Note : The key to the church, only located with great difficulty, was found not to operate the lock any more. This was not forced in view of Prof. Lamboglia's assurance that the interior was intact.

Recommendations : All roof-surfaces to be repaired as soon as possible. Shell-holes to be protected from the weather until repaired.

Also nearby :

S. Francesco. Roof covering destroyed. Minor shell hits and hole in floor made by Germans. Pictures reported stored in safety. Library collection saved, but room and fittings damaged.

Recommendations : Although this building is not listed it is recommended that repairs to the roof be carried out as soon as possible.

Museum. - Building intact, apart from negligible damage. All important contents deposited near Genoa. Remaining items intact but in some disorder, with the addition of a considerable quantity of private furniture.

Recommendations : Museum to be re-instated when possible.
Roman City of Aulimintium
Excavations : intact.

Theatre. - Shell-damage to surrounding walling, but stone seats and fine entrance doorway intact. All now rather overgrown.

Recommendations : Nothing urgent.

Grotte Grimaldi e dei Balzi Rossi. - Not visited on this

structure. Fine stone campanile and apse intact. Tegole roof covering to both church and campanile badly shattered.

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Roman City of Albintimilium
Excavations : intact.

Theatre. - Shell-damage to surrounding walling, but stone seats and fine entrance doorway intact. All now rather overgrown.

Recommendations : Nothing urgent.

Grotte Grimaldi e dei Balzi Rossi. - Not visited on this occasion owing to lack of time and A.M.G. warning of mines. Prof. Lamboglia reported that the caves have been blown up. Surviving two heads of paleolithic remains have been forwarded to Florence for repair.

Recommendations : Nothing required for the time being.

Photographs of damaged Monuments will be forwarded in due course.

It was not possible to interview personally the Genio Civile, Imperia, before they closed for the night. The urgency for immediate roof repairs will be brought to their notice through the Soprintendenza ai Monumenti and their local representative Prof. Lamboglia.

Museo Bicknell, BORDIGHERA. - Was inspected in passing. The contents are intact, including casts of the rock incised carvings from Monte Bego (Lago delle Meraviglie - Piemonte) but still in some disorder.

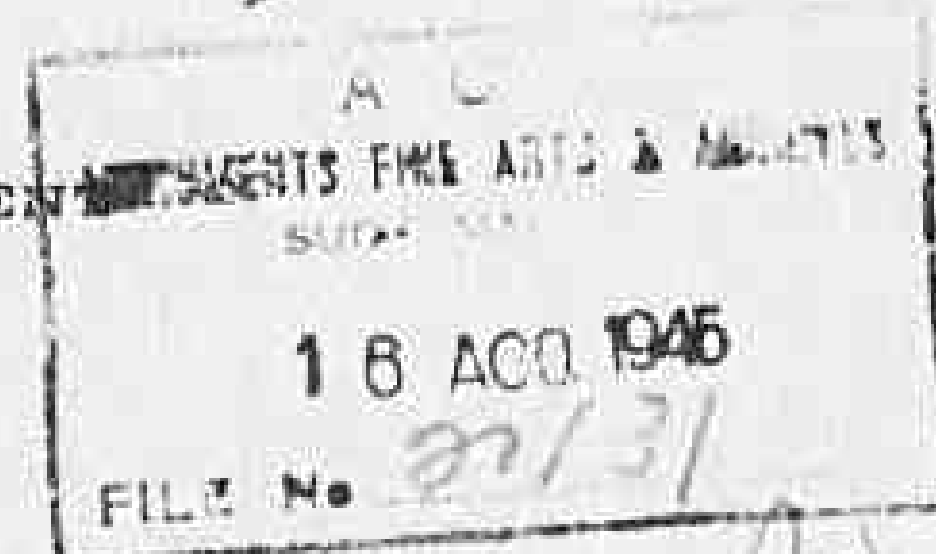

1. I was instructed to assume responsibility for this department by Lt. SIMONI and on going to the MFAA room I found a few papers and documents which I collected.

2. On 28 July 1945 I had a conference with:

Mr. CESONI CARLO, head of Monuments section;
Mr. CULTRERA GIUSEPPE;
Mr. GENTILE GALILEO.

They all expressed regret at Lt. COL. GARDNER's departure.

3. I discussed the following points:

a) the protection of damaged monuments:

They assured me that work was going on to make damaged buildings wind and water tight before the winter. (I myself have inspected Chiesa S. ANNUNZIARA where I have seen workmen working.)

They all stated the usual shortages of materials and transport.

b) the policy in regard to the normal protection of monuments;

c) the repair and reconstruction of monuments:

I asked them for any outstanding schemes to be sent in at once to me.

d) the question of the transfer of works of art back to Genova:

I promised to see what I could do in the way of transport.

e) the bringing up to date of libraries.

4. On 31 July I visited BORLASETTA and VENTIMIGLIA and discussed the various monuments in Ventimiglia with the C.A.O.

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The Caves at GROTTA GRIMALDI are still mined and various other buildings have been badly battered about.

Of course here the first priority is to get the people reached and I fear it will be a long time before monuments are reached.

At present no action is being taken to make the places wind and water tight.

I shall be visiting this place in the next week and hope to see if the Sindaco can do anything about the various buildings.

1. Inspections in Genoa Proper:

a. During the month, 37 monuments in Genoa were inspected with the Superintendent of Monuments to determine the necessity of projects of a protective nature.

2. Inspection Trips:

a. With the Superintendent of Monuments and the Assistant Superintendent of Galleries, the following depositories and centers were visited to check the objects stored and to determine the necessity of projects of a protective nature.

(1). Cavi: three depositories of objects from the museums of Genoa; all found in good condition.

(2). Brugnato: two depositories of objects and archives from museums and libraries of La Spezia; all found in good condition.

(3). Provinces of La Spezia and Genoa: the centers of La Spezia, Sarzana, Portovenere, Zoagli and Rapallo; conditions of monuments on the whole good; arrangements made with local Genio Civile for several projects to be carried out in La Spezia, Sarzana and Zoagli.

(4). Provinces of Imperia and Savona: the centers of Bordighera, San Remo, Imperia, Finale Pia and Savona; conditions of monuments on the whole good; arrangements will be made for necessary projects in San Remo and Savona.

b. Conference in Milan, 9 June, with MFAA Officer and Executive Officer of Lombardia Region in connection with possible assumption of MFAA duties in that Region by the undersigned.

c. Conference in Florence, 27-28 June, with MFAA Officer of Toscana Region with reference to the condition of monuments and projects in the Provinces of Lucca and Apuania.

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3. Projects for War Damaged Monuments:

a. After several conferences with the Regional Public Works Officer, the Superintendent of Monuments and the Head Engineer of the Genio Civile of Genoa, the following procedure was outlined for the handling of projects of a protective nature for war damaged monuments:

(1). The Superintendent of Monuments, together with the Regional Fine Arts of the Allied Government, will assume the responsibility of investigating and preparing the projects to be carried out and will designate a group of contractors best suited for the individual projects.

(2). The projects will originate in the Superintendency of Monuments and will be submitted to the Regional Fine Arts Officer of the Allied Government for approval. He will in turn submit them to the Genio Civile.

(3). The Genio Civile will prepare the necessary documents and submit them to the Regional Public Works Officer of the Allied Government for approval.

(4). The Genio Civile will assume the direction of the work. The Superintendent of Monuments will assume the artistic responsibility of the work, as conferred on him by law.

Subject: Status of Projects of Urgent Protective Measures
for Damaged Monuments in Liguria.

To : Director, Sub/Com., MFAA, Hq., A.C., APO 394.

1. To date, the Superintendent of Monuments for LIGURIA has spent approximately L. 17,500,000 on war damaged monuments, largely in GENOVA proper. Of this amount, about one fourth was preliminary protection at the outbreak of war.
2. The Superintendent of Monuments has compiled a list of thirty monuments which need urgent repairs to prevent further damage. The sum of these projects is approximately L. 16,000,000.
3. It was found that the Regional Finance Officer has no directives covering the financing of these protective projects. The local Intendente di Finanza was consulted and he stated that the Genio Civile had a section of its budget which could be used for this purpose. At a conference with the Head Engineer of the Genio Civile and the Regional Public Works officer for LIGURIA, it was the opinion of these two officials that the projects of the Superintendent of Monuments could be received and acted on. The Superintendency does not have a technical section to handle this work, as was the case in NAPLES, and it must all be done by the Genio Civile. Every precaution will be taken to supervise the work on the part of the Superintendent of Museums. It has been learned that the Regional Public Works officer can approve projects under one million lire; if more than that, they must be referred to Rome. Perhaps five of the projects proposed by the Superintendent of Monuments exceed a million lire.
4. Even after the projects have been approved by the MFAA officer and the Public Works officer, there is a question of the priority of the work and of the materials, all of which apparently must be brought in from out of the Region by rail. The question of the blocking of materials has not yet been decided. Every effort will be made to obtain a high priority for all monument projects and the allocation of needed materials.

2. Repositories of art Objects and Archives: A close check has been maintained by the competent authorities of all the repositories of the Region and it has been stated by them, that all are in excellent condition and that no objects were removed by the Germans. As far as possible, all repositories will be checked personally when transportation is available and roads open. The following corrected list of repositories is submitted:

3. Monuments: There has been severe damage of monuments in the Region and especially in GENOA proper. The majority of those in GENOA have been visited with the Superintendent of Monuments and the entire Region will be covered by field trips as soon as feasible. Reference is made to List of Reported Damage to Monuments, 20133/MFAA, dated 28 March, 1945. This is especially inclusive for GENOA and was compiled from material supplied by the Superintendent of Monuments and there have been small subsequent damages. It is reported that in recent fighting, SARZANA, SPESIA and VENTIMIGLIA have suffered severe damage and this will be checked in field trips.

4. Archives: Both Prof. Perroni and Dr. Grosso state that no important archives in the Region have been lost as far as they know. All important papers were removed to repositories and are presumably safe. This will be verified in later checking.

5. Protective Measures for Damaged Monuments: Most of the damage sustained by monuments in the Region is of long standing, having occurred in 1942 and 1943. Extensive and praise worthy protective measures have already been carried out by the Superintendent of Monuments. Recently, this work has been suspended because of lack of funds and materials. The Superintendent is compiling a complete list of works carried out and funds expended to date. A survey of additional urgent work is being prepared for this office.

6. Requisitioning: Due to the fact that practically all protected monuments, other than churches, have been seriously damaged and due also to the fact that large numbers of troops are not expected in the Region, it is anticipated that there will be few difficulties from requisitioning monuments.
