288. Appointments - Staff Officers (Civil Affairs) for Europe and Africa

Reference is made to ACI 173/45.

1. A Civil Affairs Selection Board (EUROPE and AFRICA) to be called CASS (E and A) will shortly be convened for this Theatre for the purpose of interviewing officers who apply to serve as Staff Officers (Civil Affairs) with a view to general service in Civil Affairs in European and African Theatres.

2. (a) It is emphasized that successful applicants may expect to be retained beyond the normal date of their release, particularly if they are in one of the early groups for demobilisation. It may become necessary to retain them on the grounds of military necessity for substantial periods beyond the date upon which they would normally become eligible for release. Moreover, although an officer may volunteer for Civil Affairs specifically in EUROPE or AFRICA, he may be required to serve in any Theatre.

(b) This ruling does not apply to officers who have been appointed to Civil Affairs under the terms of ACI 53/44 or GSO 49/45. The ruling applies only to all applicants to

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3. Before applicants are interviewed their names will be forwarded to the War Office for preliminary checking. Those regarded by the War Office as suitable will subsequently be interviewed by CASB (E and A).
4. CASB (E and A) will be concerned solely with selecting officers for service as Staff Officers Civil Affairs, or Staff Officers Military Government.

5. The names of successful applicants will be forwarded to the War Office for registration. In due course officers may be required to attend a Course of Training. Pending instructions, the majority of officers selected will form a reserve pool. Accordingly they will not necessarily be called on for Civil Affairs training or for appointment for some time after their attendance at a Selection Board.
6. Arrangements will be made for candidates with specialist or technical qualifications to be separately interviewed by the appropriate specialist or technical ~~qualification to be separately interviewed by the appropriate specialist or technical~~ officer with regard only to their particular qualifications.
7. CASB (E and A) will normally interview officers of the rank of Lt-Col and below. Only such officers of higher rank as may apply will be dealt with by the War Office, on receipt of their application forms.
8. Candidates for employment as Staff Officers, Civil Affairs (EUROPE and AFRICA) must in the first place fulfil the conditions as laid down in paragraph 2 of ACI 173/45, otherwise their applications will be rejected.
9. Applications in the form set out in Appendix "B" to ACI 173/45 are required in quadruplicate. They will be forwarded direct by Commanding Officers to the Secretary CASB (E and A) G1 (Br) AFHQ and will where possible be typed.
10. Should an applicant proceed to another Theatre before he is called before CASB (E and A) his application will be sent by AFHQ to the Theatre in question in order that he may be interviewed by a similar Selection Board in such Theatre.
11. While an officer will be entitled to withdraw his application before he is interviewed by CASB (E and A), once he has been accepted he is committed and, save in exceptional circumstances, may not withdraw. An officer who withdraws his application before being interviewed will have the right to re-apply later.
12. The decision of CASB (E and A) will be final. Reasons for selecting or rejecting a candidate will not be disclosed except to the War Office.

13. It is pointed out that as all applications have to be checked first by War Office, some time will inevitably elapse before an officer is called for interview before CASB (E and A).

14. Authority to appoint Staff Officers (Civil Affairs in GMT has now been cancelled.

Accordingly, applications by officers who have applied under the terms of GRO 49/45 for appointment as Staff Officers (Civil Affairs) in CWP and whose applications have not as yet resulted in their receiving notification of acceptance or refusal will, if the officer so wishes, be re-submitted in accordance with ACI 173/45 and this GRO.

16. (a) Separate instructions with regard to applications for the Far East are contained in GRO 199/45.

(b) Separate instructions with regard to applications from ATS officers are contained in ACI 781/44.

(c) This GRO is not applicable to QAIMNS not to Other Ranks.

(d) GRO 49/45 is hereby cancelled.

17. Dominion officers serving in the British Army are eligible for Civil Affairs, but officers of Dominion Forces may not apply unless special arrangements are made for them to do so after consultation with their own Dominion authorities.

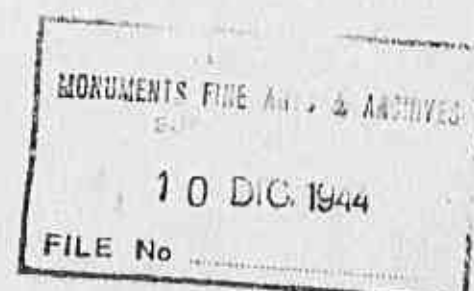

Due to the fact that a large percentage of Civil Affairs Officers in this and other theatres will come within the groups liable to be affected by the recently published release scheme, it is essential that War Office know at an early date what the commitment for replacements of Civil Affairs Officers is likely to be.
2. Owing to the shortage of manpower it is of the utmost importance that as accurate a forecast as possible is made.
3. It is believed that a large number of Civil Affairs Officers will wish to continue serving after the release scheme as published has been set in motion.
4. It is therefore requested that you ascertain from all Officers at present employed in Civil Affairs whether they are prepared to stay on after they are eligible for release, should they be requested to do so.
5. To enable the War Office to compile statistics it is requested that the following particulars are forwarded, stated as briefly as possible:
 - (a) Regimental particulars.
 - (b) Age/Service Group. (If not in possession of a chart quote age and year of enlistment).
 - (c) Whether Officer is prepared to serve after emergency has passed.
 - (d) Qualifying remarks if answer is yes. (Such qualifying remarks to be kept to a minimum.)
6. You are to assure all Officers that they are at liberty to alter their decision when the time arrives for the necessary certificate to be signed.
7. Please treat as a subject of the greatest urgency. Do not wait until replies from all officers have been received but forward rolls to this Branch as received.
8. This matter has no relation to the post war employment referred to in this Office No. G-1E/3/A dated 18 October 1944 as it can be assumed that the latter will be of a more permanent nature.
