1. It is desired that the attached sheets be completed by you so as to provide information which this headquarters may utilize in the future, to facilitate meritorious distribution of promotions. All enlisted men except 1st Sergeants and Master Sergeants will be included.
2. THESE FORMS SHOULD BE COMPLETED AS EXPEDITIOUSLY AS POSSIBLE. Only one copy need be forwarded. (Room 28, 6th Floor)
3. Use a separate form for each grade. For example, Grade Three (will include Staff Sergeants and Technicians 3rd Grade); Grade Four (will include Sergeants and Technicians 4th Grade); Grade Five (will include Corporals and Technicians 5th Grade).
4. Priority will be indicated within each grade in last column, considering each grade separately. For example, if Company "2" has a combination of 20 Tec 5's and Corporals, and it is desired to recommend four for promotion, the numeral "1" will be placed in the last column opposite the name of the man most highly recommended, "2" opposite the next highest, etc.
5. This compilation will NOT include men with an Adjusted Service Rating Score of 85 or over.

SUBJECT : Civilians (Gr) for the Allied Commission (FEAR)

TO : Distribution below

1. It is desired to plan for the replacement, by civilians, of British Other Rank personnel in this HQ.

2. Will you, therefore, please make a survey of Other Rank posts which can be civilianised and forward your recommendations to this branch giving the following information:-

(a) Qualifications of individuals or groups of individuals by equivalent army ranks, e.g. general duty clerks, shorthand typists, statisticians, office supervisors, specialists, etc.

(b) Any particular post which can be filled by an Italian civilian as opposed to a British civilian.

3. It will be assumed that civilians can be provided in equivalent army ranks from Private to W.O.I.

4. Please base your calculations on the phased programme assuming that our Sub-Commissions will remain very approximately at the same strength as at present for 3 months, but will then gradually decrease over a period of a further 5 months as responsibilities are handed back to the Italian Government.

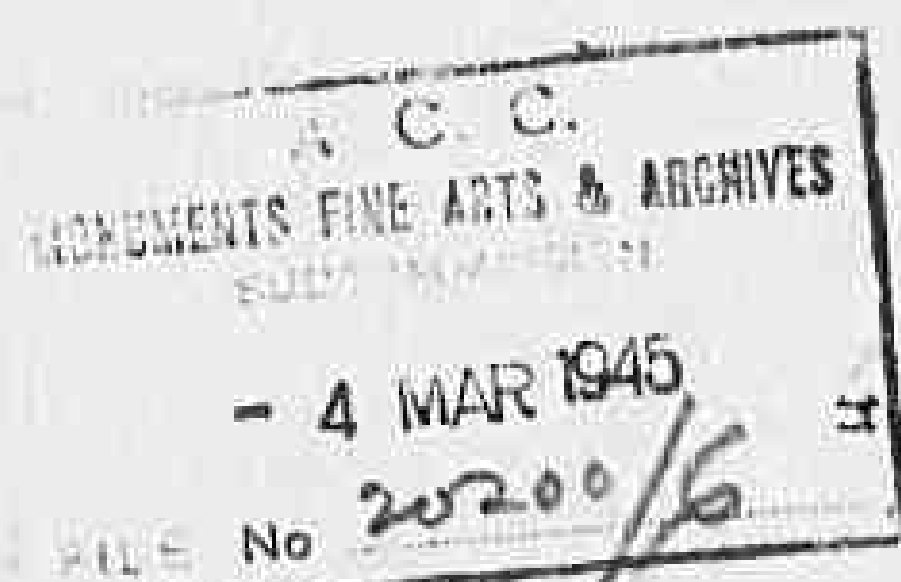

SUBJECT: Enlisted Men.

TO : All Concerned.

1. Exchanges of limited and general assignment enlisted personnel are now being consummated in which young and physically fit enlisted men are being transferred from this Regiment for duties more consistent with their ages and medical classifications. These men are being replaced by men of limited status who have been classified as such by reason of combat duty or inherent physical disqualifications.

2. This letter is being published in order to insure that these limited assignment enlisted men who are being assigned to companies for duty with the Regions, Provinces, Sub-Commissions and Sections of Allied Commission receive sympathetic consideration and are not treated as unwanted personnel thrust upon them.

3. These soldiers have also to adjust themselves to their new surroundings. In most cases, they have been front-line fighting soldiers, a fact of which they are very rightly proud. They do not always take the trouble to analyze for themselves the importance of their new employment, and are apt initially to feel some quite unjustifiable sense of inferiority to their late front-line comrades.

4. They should be made to feel that they are welcome members of their new organizations, and that here also exists the comradeship and esprit de corps which they had formerly known. They should also be made to realize the value which their new assignments contribute to the War Effort.

5. These men must be trained to become efficient in their new duties. The cooperation of every individual officer and enlisted man in the Regiment is necessary. The job must be done---we must all help these men, show them how, so that their help will bring our mission to a successful conclusion.

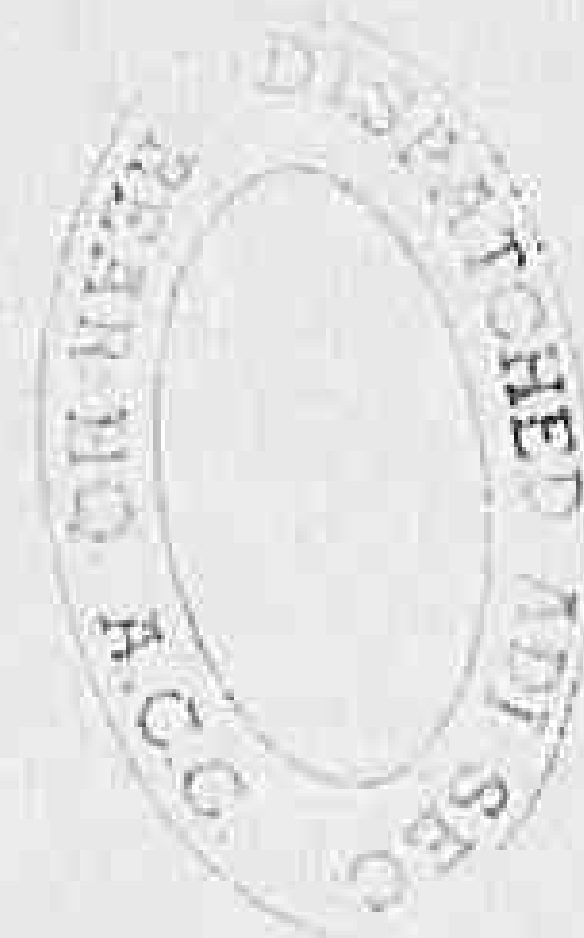

1. The Army Council have drawn attention to the fact that accounts of personnel serving overseas reveal an increasing number of abnormally large debtor balances. In a number of cases individual debts exceed £100.
2. It would appear that certain Officers serving overseas whose duty it is to make payments to soldiers show little or no regard for their personal responsibilities in regulating the amounts paid out to individuals.
3. The attention of every officer will be drawn to his responsibility, in the absence of official knowledge of the state of a soldier's account, an officer has no authority to make a payment in excess of the net rate of pay shown in A.B. 64, Part II. If he does so, he may be called upon to make good from his own pay, any resulting loss to the public.
4. The Council desire to make it clear to all officers that write-off of a debt on a soldier's account does NOT preclude subsequent consideration of whether the officer or officers responsible for the over-payments should make good the loss of public funds.
5. It is pointed out to the recipients of excessive cash issues that the rates of pay shown in A.B. 64, Part II are for the guidance of the soldier as well as the paying officer. A soldier who falls heavily into debt through accepting cash payments, which on the evidence of his pay book are clearly excessive must not expect relief such as is given to soldiers who fall into debt through causes beyond their control.
