INSTRUCTION FOR THE COMPILED OR REVISION OF AF 3199A

(To be read in conjunction with Pamphlet AF 3199B/14)

TO ALL OFFICERS

All officers, on being commissioned, complete AF 3199A (Officers' Record of Service) in duplicate. It may not previously be known to what purpose these forms are put once they are completed. The object of these notes is to tell officers what this purpose is, and to assist them in the completion by indicating in a general way, what information is required.

As to the use to which these forms are put. One copy goes direct to the respective Personnel Branches of the War Office, and from Part 2 Officers issued in this branch of war, a complete chronological history of the officer's movements, occupations and appointments, is compiled.

Long Form 3199A was originally designed for the Regular Army and later applied to the Territorial Army in possession. Consequently, it falls short of requirements under present conditions in some respects, and it is for this reason that officers are being asked to go into additional details in compiling their forms.

The completeness of the information held in this Edition about the particular officer, may be seriously affected (a) his future employment and promotion (b) his suitability for special employment, and (c) THE PRIORITY OF HIS RECORD FROM THAT OF HIS OFFICERS. It should be remembered that an officer may become unemployable within his own Army or the Service, either by reason of his having been wounded and subsequently medically unfit, or upon receiving special confidential report recommending a change of employment. The AF 3199A is consequently the only source of information upon which these can be accurately judged the officer's suitability for alternative employment. It will be clear, therefore, that it is of the utmost importance that all questions on the AF 3199A should be answered fully and with intelligence.

The following notes are intended as a guide to the officer filling out his AF 3199A for the first time, or revising it at the request of HQ and Branch:

Para 1. Religious denomination: This will not vary from whether Christian or Jew, but all show exact designation, i.e. Q of F, Methodist, etc., Presbyterian, etc.

Para 1, 2. All names and addresses should be written in BLOCK CAP LETTERS. Missed in address on form for no important reason. This may occur, for example, when this has been up to completion. All officers' names should be in.

Para 6. Other rank awarded: Any officers, having filled in the original type of AF 3199A, will not have received details of other rank service. The revised form provides for this and it is of the utmost importance that it should be filled fully.

any form that was originally submitted for the regular Army and later applied to the Territorial Army in connection. Consequently, it tells short of requirements cannot present conditions in some respects, and it is for this reason that officers are being asked to go into additional details in compiling this form.

The completion of the information held at this Echelon about the particular officer, may be partially offset (a) his future employment and promotion (b) his suitability for special employment, and (c) THE PRIORITY OF HIS RECORD FROM BEHAVIOR OF THE OFFICER ON INSUBORDINATION. It should be remembered that an officer may become unemployed while his command of the Service, either by reason of his having been awarded and subsequently medically downgraded, or upon receiving special confidential report recommending a change of employment. The 13 of 1994 is frequently the only source of information upon which this 13 can accurately assess the officer's suitability for alternative employment. It will be clear, therefore, that it is of the utmost importance that all questions on the 13 1994 should be answered fully and with intelligence.

The following notes are intended as a guide to the officer making out his 13 of 1994 for the first time, in advising it in the request of GPO and Bomber:

Para 1. Religious persuasion: This will not usually show whether Christian or Jew, but will show exact denomination, i.e. O of F, Methodist, etc, Presbyterian etc.

Para 1, 2 All names and addresses should be written in BLOCK CAPS. Distinct in address due to bad or indifferent handwriting can have the most serious consequences. This may occur, for example, when this is not in conversation with an officer's next-of-kin.

Para 4. Other Bank Service: Any officers, having filled in the original type of 1994, will not have recorded details of other bank service. The revised form provides for this and it is of the utmost importance that it should be stated fully.

Para 6a. Language qualifications: Degree of proficiency in languages, i.e. speaking, reading and writing, on a number of interpretation standard, is of greater importance than the mere fact that an officer claims to speak a language.

Para 6b. Knowledge of Foreign Countries: It is of primary importance that an officer should record not only the extent he travelled in a foreign country, but also the part of the country and the circumstances of such visit, that is to say, whether it was a business or holiday visit. If the visit was connected with business, it is of interest to know what his business interests were. His local knowledge was gained of a particular country or countries should be recorded.

Business qualifications : For officers an complete justice to the subject in answering this question. Job experience obtained by an officer prior to his enlistment should be recorded in detail. For example, it is not sufficient for a professional accountant to state merely "accountant." It is required to know the type of accountancy, whether "General", "Cost" or "Managerial" accountant, and whether he is employed or practicing on his own account. In the latter, the number of years of such practice must be stated.

An officer may have changed his employment and then still retain a business qualification No. his former employment. The fact should definitely be recorded and an indication given as to the interval which has lapsed between the change of employment and the date of his joining the army.

Para 6d.

Special knowledge or experience not included in para (a) to (c). This is the one question that few officers answer clearly. It should include any information which, although apparently irrelevant at the time, might, under certain circumstances, be of value as regards the posting or placing of an officer. No restriction is placed on the facts which may be included under this heading. An officer's interests, hobbies, pastimes, however seemingly unimportant, should be stated. The fact that he has captained his XI or XV at school or university, that he has formed a dance band, is a church organist, has interested himself in his home town debating society, be certain that a few interests, one of the utmost importance, because they help to give a more or less reliable pen picture of an officer.

Any knowledge of local towns, County or Rural Government Organisation is worth recording, as such experience might well prove of use in many cases/ data in the army.

1. In our view the attachment of Major Bell to AMG 5th Army is necessary for the following reasons:-

- a. To clear up problems still outstanding in Toscana.
- b. To prepare the way for an eventual move as part of the AMG team into Emilia.

2. In the event of this attachment being arranged Major Bell's duties, in more detail, will include the following:-

- a. Visiting principal Archive repositories, particularly those where heavy damage has occurred, viz, Florence, Pisa, Livorno and Pistoia.
- b. Visiting deposits of evacuated documents, which include many of the most important records in Toscana, from the following repositories, Florence, Siena, Pisa, Arezzo, Lucca, Pistoia and Livorno. These have not been inspected by an archives officer for several months.
- c. Effecting, through the Subcommission, liaison between the Italian Archive Service in Toscana and the central Administration in Rome. Among the problems to be handled in this connection are questions relating to personnel, buildings and the survey of the present state of lay archives to be undertaken by the Superintendency of Toscana.
- d. Arranging with the church authorities for a similar survey of ecclesiastical archives.
- e. Obtaining field experience and making necessary contacts with AMG staff and plans for safeguarding archives in Bologna.

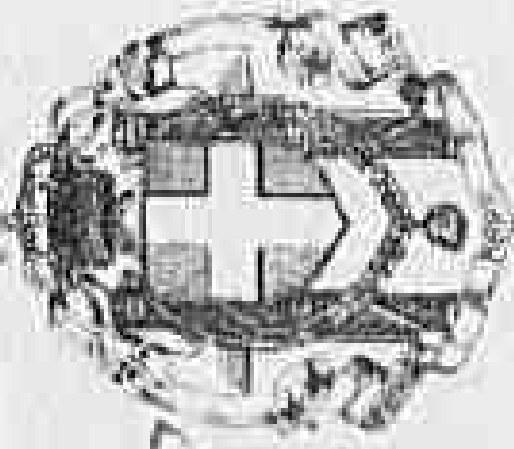
