2. It is suggested that there may be some misunderstanding with your G.-1 branch regarding the rendering of 194D, as under ACI 545 of 43, AF.B194D may be rendered at any time if the officer is thought worthy of it.
3. There are the further complications that W/Comdr. Goodison will not be able to render a 194D until Capt. Brooke has been with him for at least three months and it will not be possible to date his promotion prior to the recommendation initiating it.

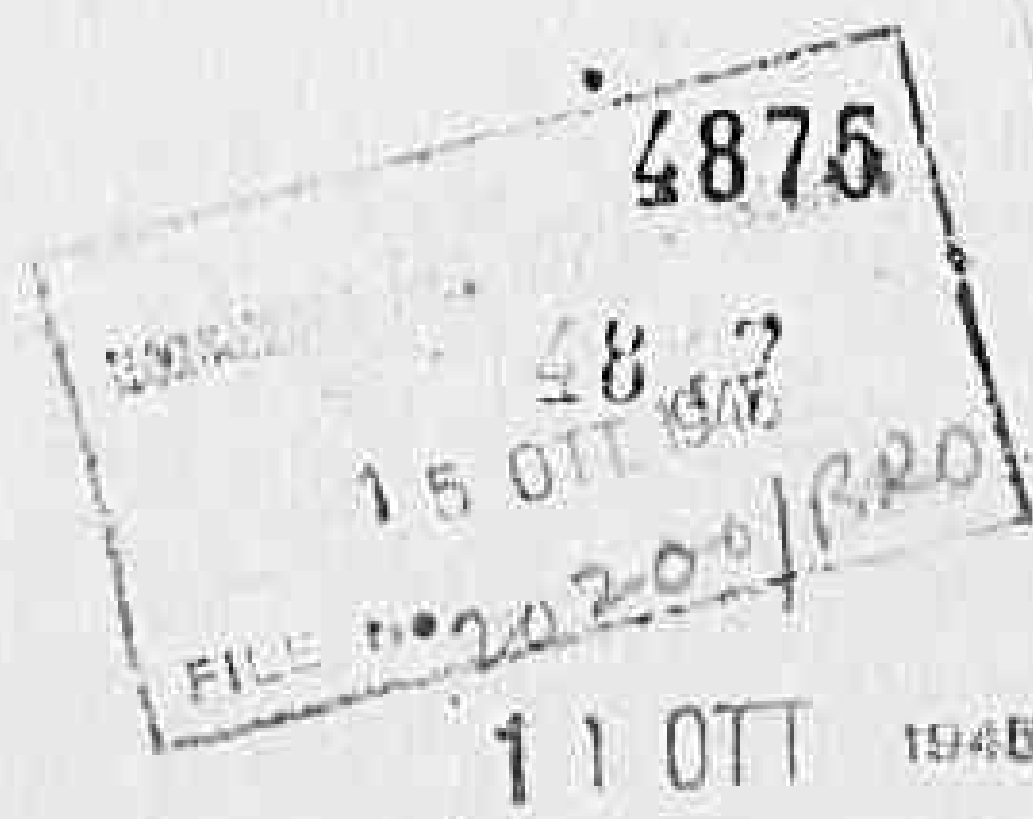
