Io sottoscritto, Cap. aut. Ceci Pasquale riferisco quanto segue:

Il giorno 25/12/94 alle ore 12 circa mi sono recato con la jeep a me in consegna all'albergo Milano ove ho consegnato una borsa di pel-
le al Cap. Croft-Murray. Ritornando alla Caserma Mica, giunto in Piaz-
za del Cinquecento, sono stato fermato da due americani, che dopo avermi
chiesto dove andavo mi hanno detto che avevano intenzione di recarsi a
Napoli.

Dissi che non potevo perché non avevo ordini dai miei superiori per
effettuare tale viaggio e inoltre ero senza olio.

Costretto dalle loro minacce, e per evitare che mi prendessero la mac-
china (cosa che hanno tentato di fare) mi sono arreso alla loro volontà.

Mi hanno condotto alla Casilina - Durante il viaggio ho cercato di
incontrare la polizia Alleata ma non ho trovato nessuno. Arrivati ai pres-
si di Valmontone mi hanno fatto girare sulla strada che conduce a Velletri.
A circa 8 km. dopo Terracina la macchina si è fermata per mancanza di olio.
I due americani so o scesi (erano circa le 2,30) e sono saliti su un Truck
(C.M.C.) che passava di là. Ho cercato di fermare le macchine che passavano,
ma nessuna si fermava alla mia richiesta.

Sono passati di là tre militari italiani che si recavano a piedi a
Roma, e con il loro aiuto, un po' a spinta e un po' a motore avviato sono
riuscito a raggiungere l'officina del P.B.S. di Terracina. Quivi mi hanno
fornito di olio. Sono ripartito e non ho fatto più di 5 km. quando la
macchina si è fermata di nuovo. Ho avuto soccorso dal carro soccorso del
P.B.S. che per caso passava di là. Rimorchiato sono giunto di nuovo nell'offi-
cina ove mi hanno fatto capire che non potevano riparare la macchina. Ho
trascorso la notte a Terracina, ed al mattino seguente (26/12/94) so venuto
a Roma su un Truck guidato da militari italiani. Mi son subito recato nell'uf-
ficio Monumenti e Arti dell'A.C. (Palazzo delle Corporazioni) ove ho narrato
tutto ad un sergente americano. Questi mi ha condotto da un ufficiale ameri-
cano al quale ho riferito quanto gli avevo detto io.

OCCORRENZA: Incidente Cap. Aut. Ceci Pasquale.

Ho incontrato il Cap. Aut. Ceci Pasquale pochi minuti prima di mezzogiorno alla Caserma Macao, mentre usciva con la Jeep per recarsi all'Albergo Milano. Lo vedevo allora per la prima volta dal 15/11/44, data in cui era partito in servizio isolato. Il Sig. Cap. Croft-Murray. Fu lieto di vederlo essendo un ragazzo molto attaccato al servizio, disciplinato e rispettoso.

Interrogato in proposito mi disse che si recava al detto Albergo per incontrarsi con il suo capitano cui doveva consegnare della roba e prendere ordini per il mattino seguente. Sarebbe subito ritornato alla Caserma Macao per il pranzo che ufficiali e soldati della Compagnia avevano consumato insieme in occasione del Natale.

Si disse pure che avrebbe dovuto portare la macchina in officina del Supergarage e perché fosse rimessa in ordine prevedendo di ripartire il mattino dopo.

Non vidi più il Cap. Ceci che il giorno seguente di ritorno da Terracina dopo l'incidente dallo stesso narrato.

Sulla veridicità di quanto narrato dal Cap. Aut. Ceci Pasquale non ho risultanze testimoniali. La sua condotta, sempre irreprensibile, e la sua serietà mi obbligano però a non dubitare di quanto è stato da lui affermato.

A suo carico d'è da affermare che dovendo lui rispondere di un automezzo militare non avrebbe dovuto cedere alle minacce dei due soldati americani essendo implicita una consegna inviolabile e che doveva essere difesa a qualunque costo. In proposito però bisogna notare che il carattere del conduttore è estremamente timido e passivo, qualità che pur non essendo positiva può non amminuire la colpa della sua arrendevolezza.

Subject: Report on Supplementary Courier.

To : Lt. Col. Robertson.

1. On August 3rd I came by a supplementary courier (American Express Carrier, Driver QUAM, American) leaving Naples, 0900 hrs.

2. The truck had on board, besides myself and the driver, my complete kit, and two Italian civilian passengers (authorized), one of whom was a boy with a broken leg.

3. The truck broke down on a hill on the far side of Velletri at about 1530 hrs.. I took a lift into Rome arriving at 1745 hrs., and immediately reported the matter to the Directorate.

4. Sgt. HALL rang up the Super Garage, who said they would send round immediately a wrecking party to pick me up a H.M. and take me out to Velletri.

5. I waited at the Detachment Office till 1845 hrs., and then went to the Garage myself, where after some difficulty I was allowed to take a civilian Italian wrecking crane, belonging to A.C.C., which incidentally had been standing idle on duty at the Garage (according to its driver) since 1600 hrs..

6. I arrived at Velletri by 1930 hrs. to find no sign of the truck, and was informed that it had got moving about an hour previously.

7. When I enquired at the Super Garage this morning it had not yet shown up.

3. In January 1944, he was temporarily attached to the Displaced Persons Subcommission to help in dealing with refugees, and has since been in the neighborhood of Brindisi.
4. It is submitted that an officer of his special qualification is wasted on such duties, and that he should be returned as soon as possible to the Subcommission to which he was assigned by the War Office.
5. The MFAA Subcommission is losing the service of five officers, 4 American and 1 British on transfer to another theatre, and requires the services of its remaining personnel.
6. Capt Croft Murray's recall from Brindisi is therefore requested.
