is already a grave shortage of timber and fuel and unfortunately most of the wood is located East of the Morgan Line. It is hoped that the Economic Committees, which appear to be working well, will be able to provide some remedial arrangement. A great deal of work has been done in collating lists of Italian civilians deported into Yugoslavia before occupation by Allied troops. A few have been returned.

The port of Trieste looked moribund as regards shipping and the great naval harbor of Pola, which has suffered tremendous damage from Allied bombing and is still full of mines (at any rate in the commercial harbor), was empty.

Altogether the AMG team there, which will be progressively built up until it has a strength of some 50 U.S. and 50 British officers under its SCAG, Colonel Alfred C. Bowman (A), is doing with tremendous help from 13 Corps and in spite of many difficulties (of which the torrid climate is not the least), a quiet and efficient job.

THE RETURNING TIDE AND OTHERS

The repatriation of Italian and other nationals is rising to a peak, the Displaced Persons and Repatriation Sub-Commission indicates according to its latest sitrep, which mentions that home-comings of Italians from SHAEF via the Brenner Pass has increased to 4,500 a day and from Switzerland to 2,500 a day. About one third of the SHAEF Italians (mostly from Germany) are from South Italy. Re-settlement within Italy is also proceeding apace. In the last week 9,310 refugees with homes in the South went back to their native towns while another 10,155 refugees arrived in Rome from the North to await the dispersing process. Allied and other nationals are also going home — 927 of various nationalities leaving for France and 710 Greeks returning to Greece by sea.

In brief, the results of the Bolzano conference of 14 June are working out exceedingly well according to Lieut. Col. C. F. Fothergill (4967), deputy director of the hard-working Sub-Commission. Close liaison is maintained with the Transportation Sub-Commission. All major movements are made by rail. The some 60 camps, which, besides Italians, hold some 15,000 United Nations nationals, are all active on a virtual assembly-line production basis. Sanitary conditions in the camps have received the o. k. of medical ex-

straighten out tangles with AC officers at this end. Switzerland is reported to have had 32,000 Italian refugees and the SHAEF area 350,000.

Since the complete liberation, more than 265,000 refugees are said to have entered Italy. There were 80,000 in May, 81,000 in June, and 103,000 in July up to the 22d. Statistics are not as accurate as could be wished, since many refugees streamed over the Austro-Italian border in the first days before adequate controls could be set up. 5th and 8th Army AMG's heroically took care of most of them. The Records Bureau of the Sub-Commission is fast expanding its rolls, now listing nearly 90,000 names covering 72 nationalities and being very busy answering inquiries from families in search of relatives.

Books Closed.

The Sub-Commission has finally closed its books of financial assistance to hard-pressed refugees of more than a score of nationalities, including Germans. The program, started in October, 1944, wound up in June with a total cost of more than 75 million lire. Loans up to 4,000 lire a person a month or 12,000 lire for a single household were made and helped prevent malnutrition and privation for many. UNRRA now has taken over this program and also expects to take over United Nations nationals Northern camps (they are already operating in most of the South) this fall. When the money aid program was started, heads of 273 families were receiving help. The number rose to 5,000 persons last winter.

The job pioneered and organized by the Sub-Commission is no doubt in its last stage, (since January, 1944 to, date, the Sub-Commission has handled 490,000 Italian and 70,000 United Nations refugees). In its latest report, for example, the Sub-Commission states that 58,873 refugees were repatriated by land, sea and air through other organized movements. UNRRA is now taking an increasingly larger share of the burden. The report also refers to the ubiquitous but little-known IGCR or Inter-Governmental Committee for Refugees, which is not primarily an operating agency but a general advisor on the problem and lastly, the final catch basin for the refugees of other than Italian and Allied origin who do

with the IGCR for the simple reason there will be refugees with no place to go to.

The IGCR was formed in 1938, on the initiative of the late President Roosevelt, and with the prime purpose at the time of succoring victims of Nazi persecution, for instance, Jews, deprived of German citizenship by Nazi laws, who fled on account of their race, religion or political beliefs. As an official humanitarian organization representing 36 member governments, IGCR, which one day might well be converted into one of the auxiliary agencies centered around the nascent United Nations Organization, has had as its particular baby the problem of what has been commonly but rather erroneously called "the stateless". More accurately, it is a complex and far-reaching problem concerned with individual conditions of "non-repatriability". Of those who might be loosely termed "stateless" now in Italy there are relatively few.

However, the number of Poles, Yugoslavs, Russians, Greeks, Spaniards, Balts and others now in Italy who for one reason or another do not wish to return home runs into many tens of thousands. They present another and analogous problem which may clarify as general post-war conditions in Europe improve.

Italian citizenship.

Sir Clifford E. Heathcote-Smith was IGCR representative in Italy until a short time ago when Lieut. Col. Julian L. Tomlin (B) took over. Sir Clifford arrived on the scene in the spring of 1944. A letter of his is on record to Mr. Harold Macmillan, former British Resident Minister at AFHQ and former Acting President of the AC, in which Mr. Macmillan is given the credit for suggesting in April, 1944 in Algiers that Italy herself help take care of part of the problem of the stateless. As a result of IGCR efforts and Italian cooperation, a decree of the Italian Government was published which offered Italian citizenship to IGCR-certified stateless refugees and cut red tape and costs to allow such refugees to accept Italy as an official haven. The first eight stateless refugees received their citizenship applications in October, 1944 and by March of this year had finally become Italian citizens. The

Of those who might be loosely termed "stateless" now in Italy there are relatively few.

However, the number of Poles, Yugoslavs, Russians, Greeks, Spaniards, Balts and others now in Italy who for one reason or another do not wish to return home runs into many tens of thousands. They present another and analogous problem which may clarify as general post-war conditions in Europe improve.

Italian citizenship.

Sir Clifford E. Heathcote-Smith was IGCR representative in Italy until a short time ago when Lieut. Col. Julian L. Tomlin (B) took over. Sir Clifford arrived on the scene in the spring of 1944. A letter of his is on record to Mr. Harold Macmillan, former British Resident Minister at AFHQ and former Acting President of the AC, in which Mr. Macmillan is given the credit for suggesting in April, 1944 in Algiers that Italy herself help take care of part of the problem of the stateless. As a result of IGCR efforts and Italian cooperation, a decree of the Italian Government was published which offered Italian citizenship to IGCR-certified stateless refugees and cut red tape and costs to allow such refugees to accept Italy as an official haven. The first eight stateless refugees received their citizenship applications in October, 1944 and by March of this year had finally become Italian citizens. The usual residence requirement of five years was eliminated for their sake. Approximately 30 such non-repatriables have accepted the Italian offer to date. Many others would like to stay in Italy, but are waiting to see if bars will be let down in the future to other countries.

A recent survey of post-war refugee aspirations among about 1,000 families showed that

There were 80,000 in May, 81,000 in June, and 103,000 in July up to the 22d. Statistics are not as accurate as could be wished, since many refugees streamed over the Austro-Italian border in the first days before adequate controls could be set up. 5th and 8th Army AMGs heroically took care of most of them. The Records Bureau of the Sub-Commission is fast expanding its rolls, now listing nearly 90,000 names covering 72 nationalities and being very busy answering inquiries from families in search of relatives.

Books Closed.

The Sub-Commission has finally closed its books of financial assistance to hard-pressed refugees of more than a score of nationalities, including Germans. The program, started in October, 1944, wound up in June with a total cost of more than 75 million lire. Loans up to 4,000 lire a person a month or 12,000 lire for a single household were made and helped prevent malnutrition and privation for many. UNRRA now has taken over this program and also expects to take over United Nations nationals Northern camps (they are already operating in most of the South) this fall. When the money aid program was started, heads of 273 families were receiving help. The number rose to 5,000 persons last winter.

The job pioneered and organized by the Sub-Commission is no doubt in its last stage, (since January, 1944 to, date, the Sub-Commission has handled 490,000 Italian and 70,000 United Nations refugees). In its latest report, for example, the Sub-Commission states that 58,873 refugees were repatriated by land, sea and air through other organized movements. UNRRA is now taking an increasingly larger share of the burden. The report also refers to the ubiquitous but little-known IGCR or Inter-Governmental Committee for Refugees, which is not primarily an operating agency but a general advisor on the problem and lastly, the final catch basin for the refugees of other than Italian and Allied origin who do not fall under any convenient category. Germans outside of Germany, these days, of course, are usually prisoners-of-war and they are being returned through military channels. The refugee problem which now passes from the military in the form of the AC Sub-Commission and its field units to UNRRA will eventually finish up

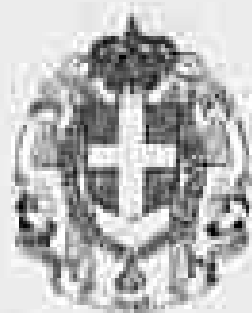
