1. May I please request permission to bring to your notice the present position and rank of Lt. R.H. Ellis, a British Officer of the MFA Subcommission.

2. This officer enlisted in October 39 and was promoted Captain in April 41, a rank which he held for a period of 2½ years broken only by periods of hospitalisation. In Nov-Dec. 43 he held a major's command during operations. In Jan. 44 he was posted on W.O. instructions to ACC as an Archivist. Owing however to an error (which has now been traced to the failure of his Battalion in Nov. 43 to publish an order reinstating him in his temporary rank after a period in hospital) GHQ 2nd Echelon posted him to ACC as a WS/Lt. A further period of hospitalisation cut short enquiries at the time, and on 16 May he rejoined ACC as an MFA officer, again in the official rank of Lt.

3. I immediately put the case to G-1 (B), who made enquiries, and on 15 June on their advice I submitted a 194 D as being the most practicable method to right an obvious case of hardship. Col. Jones assured me that the name had gone forward and that the case had his personal sympathy. In the recent list of promotions from Lt. to Capt. however, Ellis's name has not appeared. *JM* 5/6?

4. Ellis's work with the Subcommission has been consistently excellent; and yet he finds himself junior to Capt. Brooke, who is like Ellis an archivist in civilian life and was Ellis's junior in the Public Record Office and has come to the Subcommission almost direct from civilian life. Two architects posted recently to the Subcommission direct from civil life are also captains.
