He is in hospital at the moment, but his work is being handled by Capt Smith, with whom I have talked. If they do not hear from AFM in a few days, they will send a signal. Your safe is being used for very earnestly by G-1(8) and I promise to keep after them and to keep you informed.

4. No return is made on the II basis on the strength of the A/C since it was agreed verbally between Lt. Col. Gripps and Major Ward Perkins that the present requirement calls for II.
