1. It is urgently requested that the assignment of the undersigned in FERRARA, with U.S. jeep no. 2021487 or alternative means of transport, be prolonged until 20 August 45.
2. The principal reason for this request is the disastrous state of the Superintendency of Monuments for PISA, LIVORNO, LUCCA and APUANIA, probably the hardest hit of all the Superintendencies in Italy.
 - a. 22 projects for repairs of war damaged monuments in APUANIA Province have been approved by the undersigned. These are monuments of considerable quality and all have been badly damaged. If an AFMA Officer is not on hand to push them through, there is little likelihood of repairs being financed before the turn-over to the Italian Government.
 - b. 16 projects for badly damaged monuments in LUCCA Province, have been authorized by the undersigned and approved by the Genio Civile, but no word whatsoever has been forthcoming from the Regional Engineer in GENOA, in whose office these projects have been for more than a month. This will necessitate a trip to Genoa to settle properly.
 - c. The entire budget for the restoration to pictures in the Museo Civico of PISA, after having been approved by the Provincial Finance Officer of Pisa, was abandoned by the Regional Finance Office, TOSCANA, and has never been heard from. The budget will probably have to be tracked down in Archives Section, and financed directly through Finance Subcommission, as PISA is still under A.M.G.
 - d. Practically all the important projects for PISA and LIVORNO cities still remain unfinanced, in the hands of Public Works Subcommission. The Superintendent, who is already about 25,000,000 Lire in debt, is having to stop work entirely on these projects, with disastrous consequences to monuments of great importance. For this and (c) above the presence of the undersigned in ROME for two or three days will be indispensable.

3. The important work in the Provinces of FLORENCE, SIENA, AREZZO, PISTOIA and GROSSETO has been seen personally by the undersigned in the last weeks, and except for two projects there is practically nothing left to worry about. But the northeastern provinces of the Region, are still, in spite of all the efforts of this office, in a condition which can only be described as tragic, with at least 50 monuments in which work either cannot be commenced or has had to be suspended on account of the failure of the cumbersome and unwieldy system of financing ISMA projects.

4. In addition the final report on the work in this Region is still in a state of forms and notes, due to the ten days of continuous work by the undersigned in connection with the return of the works of art from the Alto Adige to Florence, and will take weeks to put in shape.

5. It is difficult to see how the presence of the undersigned in Austria (there one way or the other can be of an urgency comparable with the problems outlined above. It would be extremely regrettable if the work of the Subcommittee in the Provinces of PISA, LIVORNO, LUCCA and APIZANIA should be left in a state of collapse, and in the whole of Tuscany, the most important and the worst damaged Region in Italy, without a coherent record.
