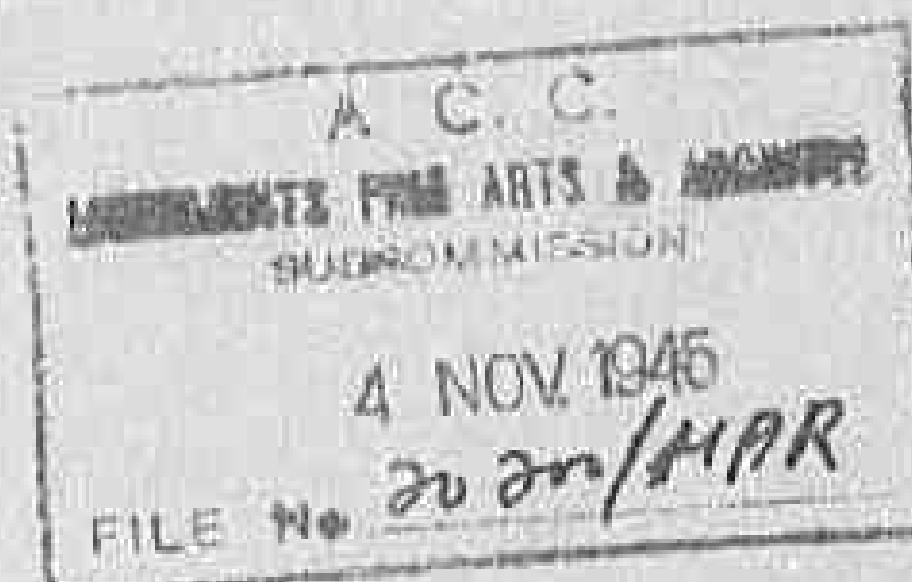

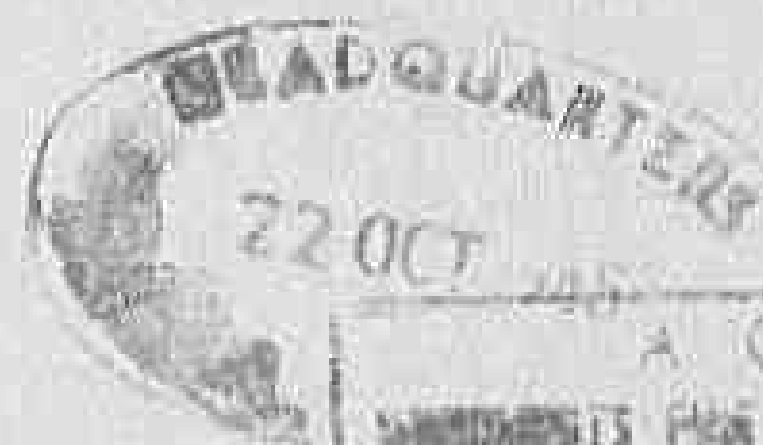

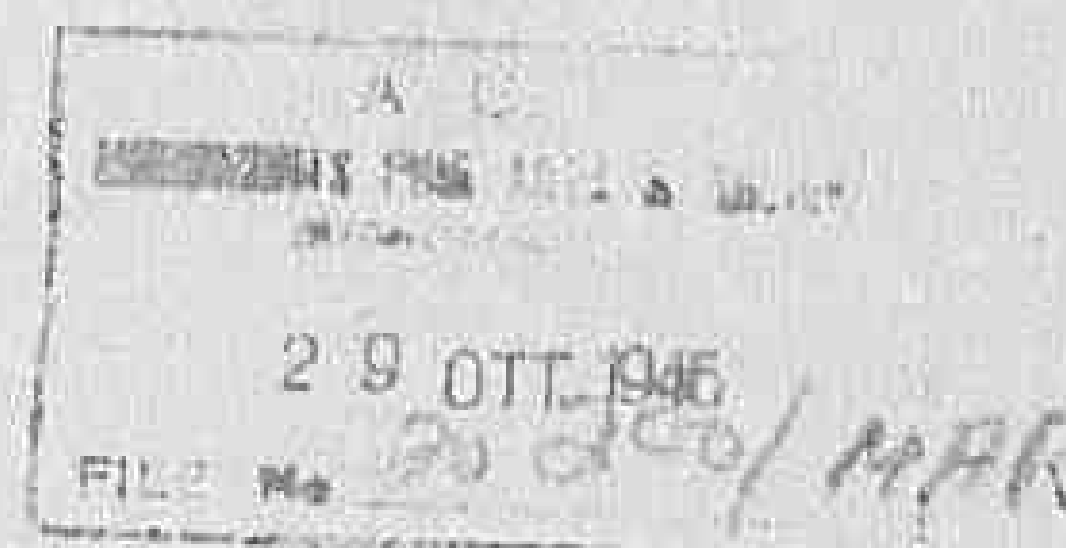

SUBJECT: Posting - Captain Marriott.

TO : MPAA Branch, Allied Commission for Austria (British Element).

1. The position with regard to Marriott is as follows. In order to relieve him it is necessary to withdraw the one remaining officer in the field in North-West Italy to replace him. This requires official approval (which is already being urgently sought), and the relief can barely be clear before a week or ten days from now. It is imperative that Marriott and his relief should meet. It cannot therefore be anticipated that Marriott will be clear much if at all before the end of this month. The delay is regretted, but it is hoped that you will appreciate that this Subcommission is going to considerable inconvenience to make Marriott available at all, and is making every effort to release him at the earliest possible moment.

2. Your suggestions as to procedure are noted and will if possible be followed as soon as formal application is received.

1. Reference to your two signals on the above subject, it will be appreciated to know as soon as possible when it is likely that Captain Marriott will be available for transfer. The officer he is to replace is considerably overdue for going home on release and is naturally unwilling to postpone his departure much longer. It is very desirable that the two officers should meet to ensure a proper hand-over and for this purpose, if it is possible, Captain Marriott should be available by 20th October, 1945.
2. To allow of this overlap for hand-over taking place, it will be necessary for Captain Marriott to be attached to this H.Q. in the first place until the officer he is relieving has gone, when the posting can be effected. It is hoped that this course will be approved and, in anticipation, M.S., B.T.A. has been requested to ask for Captain Marriott's posting without specifying an effective date. The reason for this request has been explained and it is not anticipated that any objection is likely to be raised.
3. As Captain Marriott will be filling an S.O.II vacancy, it is requested, if you approve, that an A.F.B194D may be rendered at once in respect of this officer.

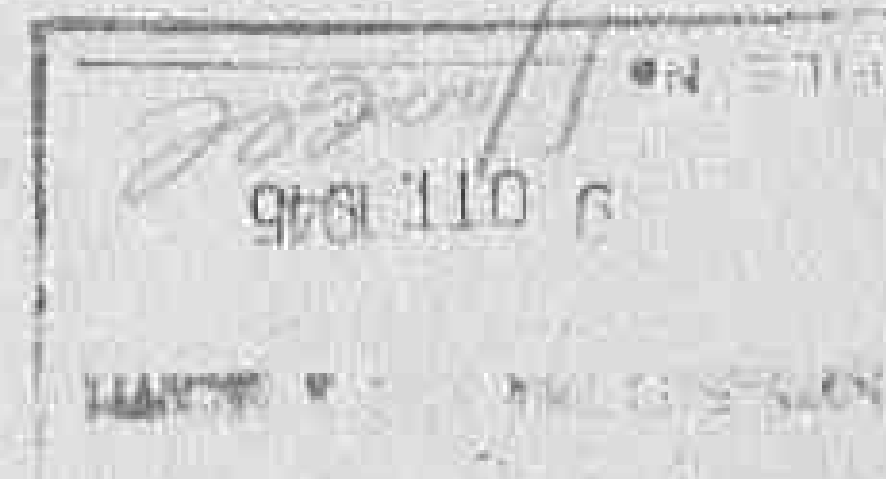
