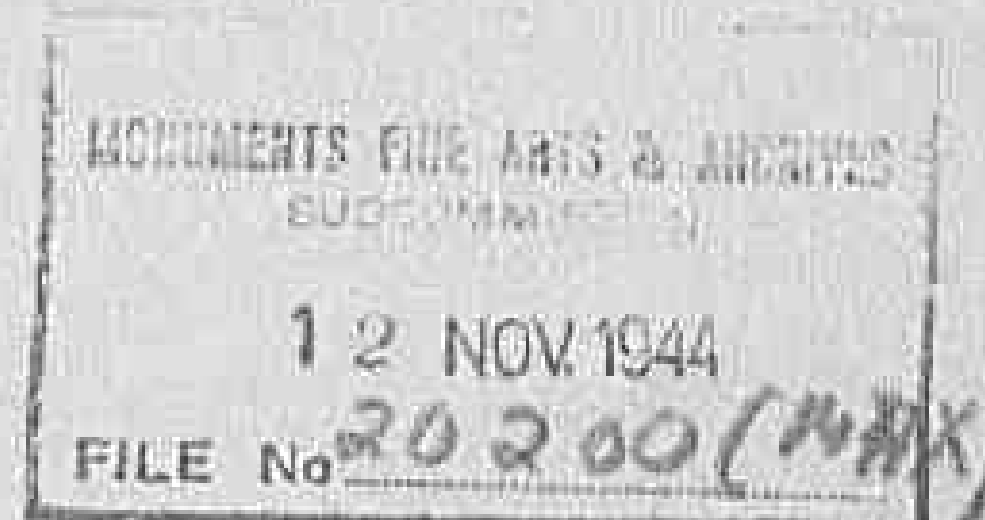

Memorandum to: Lt. Col. Farley-Smith, British Chief of Staff.
Subject : Promotion of Capt. F.H.J. Wasse.

1. Capt. Wasse has been a member of the Territorials (Royal Sussex, I believe) since 1927 (I believe). He has been a substantive captain for three or four years (I think) and was a company commander before entering Military Government. He attended Wimbledon, Chorea, etc. and therefore is one of the "oldest living members" of ANGOT. His services during the past five weeks in this Office have been excellent and much appreciated.

2. In view of his age, his previous service, and his present position, and in view of the general level of rank in ANGOT Hq. and in view of the rates of pay for a man of his age, it is recommended that he be recommended for a majority.

3. The TO(WT) of this Office at present is unknown to me; it originally called for a Lt. Col. and a Major. If this Hq. is to be a general Hq. for all ANGOT, since the regional Advisers are being breveted generally as Majors, it would seem reasonable that in this Office the Deputy should have the rank of a Regional Adviser.
