1. MONTMAGNANO ABBEY examined from top of remaining walls at 1700 hrs 18 May 1944.
2. West end of Abbey remains standing to top floor. East and south sides, facing GASSINO, mostly levelled to ground floor. Interior form of three lower cloisters still visible but without cross colonnades. Great stairway pulverized. Statue of St Benedict is headless but otherwise intact. Cloister of the Benefactors ruined. In Basilica south wall of Apse and part of two large piers at crossing still stand. Basilica appears otherwise gone.
3. Floor at High Altar and floor of Sacristy may be intact under rubble. Saw no visible evidence of important bronze doors. Sala Capitolare, Biblioteca, Pinacoteca and Archivio probably destroyed but possibly intact under rubble.
4. West end of Refectory still standing.
5. Reconstruction of entire Abbey is possible although much is now only heap of pulverized rubble and dust.
6. This report amplifies the summary prepared earlier today.
