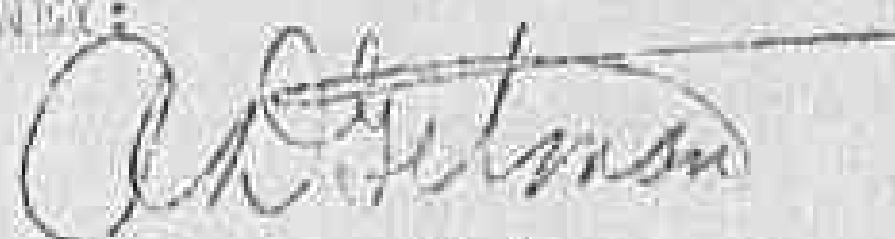

Dear Colonel DeWald.

Since leaving I have spent most of the time in a school of frustrations the like of which I have never seen. Buildings have been assigned to us and either reassigned to before we could move in or we were forced to move out to larger quarters. Excepting one convoy of refugees in Reggio Emilia has come our way and yet we are still preparing for the arrival of 2,000. The prospects of taking care of a Torino and Milano overflow here in Varese in a large old barracks is good, provided the British Red Cross exists and I can push through the necessary preparations without more officer personnel. Fortunately my experience in England in organizing hospitals is considerable and so my assistance is of the greatest value. Two Italian Lieutenants and some 20 soldiers have blossomed out from zero indifference to loyal workers. The local Red Cross young ladies have shown extraordinary fine qualities and work and made the statement that they would not work for any command except the present one and if we are transferred they wish to follow us.

All this schooling in a month's time has fitted me for running chaos hotels when out of service, provided the unlimited headaches and futilities of this experience could be eliminated and of course they never will be! All this is so far from actual work with the M.F.H. S/C that I very much hope you will recall my at the first opportunity. Col H. D. Bonham - 5033's letter of April 30th stated the loan to this S/C was for a period not exceeding two months. Ref 1/17.1/CH. I am now working under British officers which can in no way further the chances of promotion which have been so needlessly side-tracked in the three years of service as Captain.

I therefore urge that every measure be made to allow me to have what is rightfully due. I feel very strongly and very deeply about this whole situation.

Before leaving Major Ballard stated that our hotel rooms were to be kept. I left my baggage at the Milano in consequence, one box, one leather bag, one canvas bag, one ammunition case and some clothing. He also said A.C. had no way of caring for officers baggage so I was obliged to leave matters as they were, the hurried departure preventing moving anything to Kossolas who volunteered to care for them should the occasion arise. I would greatly appreciate your having the matter investigated and receiving a report on that baggage and the two trunks in the office, as the value of effects and photographic equipment totals a great deal and I cannot afford to lose it. It also contains my full equipment for painting.

It is so difficult for me to get away because of work that I have not been able to obtain any of the information about being relieved from service. Can you send me the papers bearing on discharge?
