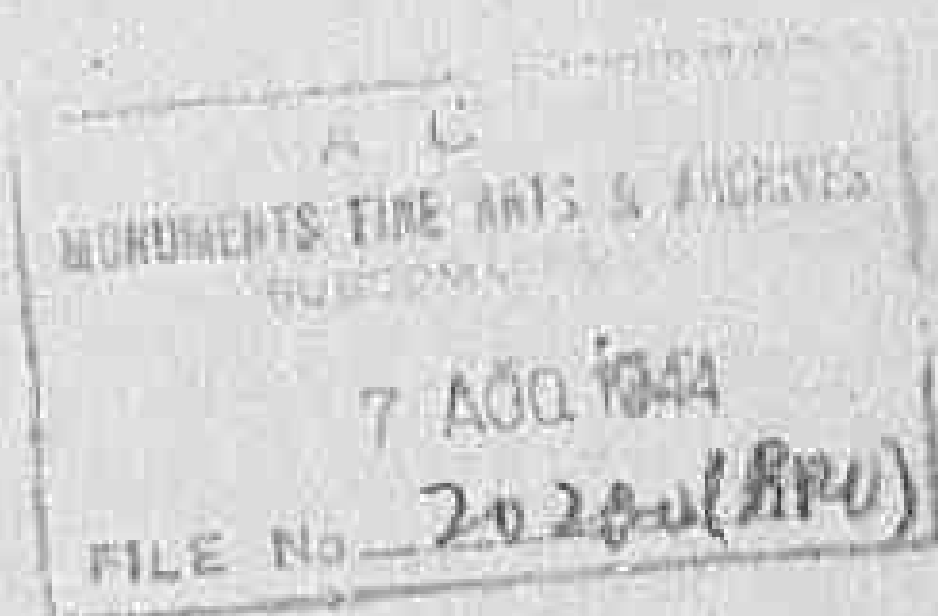

The Cause of Pearl Harbor

London: The British Minister for Production, Littleton, said, in the course of a speech at the Chamber of Commerce, that the pressure of the United States on Japan was the direct cause of the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor.

Outrages in the Ukraine

Lemberg: Refugees from Ukrainian territories, invaded by the Soviets, tell new stories of sackings and destruction committed by Bolshevik soldiers. As usual the Soviets plundered churches, damaging, destroying or using them for other purposes.

Increased Tank Production in the U.S.S.R.

Moscow: The "Pravda" publishes an article in which it is stated that the Kirov works in Leningrad must increase their production of tanks by at least 50%, in order to fill in the gap caused by the heavy losses sustained during the winter and spring offensives. The "Pravda" exhorts factory Commissars to watch workers closely so that there will be no waste of material and work will be without interruption.

Today's messages from Cherbourg report that the Allies are concentrating all their forces in the corridor for an attack on Cherbourg itself. Infantry and armored divisions are being brought up and assembled.

Subject: 6007 Major J. F. Brunswick, Middlesex Regiment.

To : C.S.C.2., Infantry Postings, C.S.C., C.M.S.

1. The Monuments and Fine Arts Sub-Committee of Allied Control Commission is at present occupied with the double task of installing available damage to artistic and historical monuments in this theatre and of applying "first-aid" where damage has already occurred. The work requires considerable technical qualifications and at the present moment the official personnel of this Sub-Committee in theatre personnel are heavily overstrained.

2. It has come to my notice that Major Brunswick is not at present actively employed. He is, I understand, a support-group officer with experience of 1st and 4th Divisions, but is at present surplus to establishment and is awaiting posting from 1 Coy, 5 Bn. No. 1, I.R.T.R. He is 42 and anxious to serve with an M.A.G. Bn., but may have to wait some time before a vacancy occurs in his rank.

3. This officer is, in peace-time, a research-student at Cambridge who has specialized in pre-historic and Roman archaeology and his technical qualifications are exactly those which would be most useful to us. 333

4. I am not in a position to request his transfer, nor is that the wish of Major Brunswick. It does, however, seem a great waste of qualifications that could be of the greatest use to us at this moment, and I am writing to ask whether it would be possible to give authority for this officer to be lent to this Sub-Committee for the remainder of the period during which he may remain operationally unemployed. He could be held on 24-hour recall, and I can assure you that his services even for a short period would be of the greatest value to us, and that my help that you are in a position to give will be greatly appreciated.

SUBJECT: Report on Pte William Acton, 13084221.
TO: Director, MPAA Subcommittee, Hq AG (for transmission).

1. Pte Acton was assigned to this section during late June and throughout July 44, giving ample opportunity to observe his behavior.
2. In spite of cultural manners and language acquired from his home background, Acton appeared to the undersigned to be a man of abnormal behavior and subnormal intelligence.
3. He was quite incapable of understanding and executing the simplest instructions given him, for example in the preparation of routine forms, the running of simple errands, etc. Although apparently quite willing to work, he could not comprehend the type of paper work that any bright child of ten could have done after five minutes instruction.
4. Moreover his conversation was extraordinarily illogical and even wild. Approached on a given subject, he would look vague, then nervous, then come back with a reply on an entirely different subject. This was a common occurrence. Also he made suggestions of the most irrational and fantastic nature, advanced as practicable schemes.
5. His handwriting, some letters big, some small, some slanting right, some left, and incapable of holding an even keel, or keeping a margin, was that of a very childish character.
6. Acton continually smelt most unpleasantly of a mixture of wine and stale sweat.
7. The impression given to the undersigned by this behavior was that of a considerably unbalanced person.
