Please note that the proposed law will be submitted
to the USSR Comptroller for consideration. After
the proposed law has been submitted, it will be
published in the Soviet zone, so that all persons
can become familiar with it. Please let me know
when you propose to submit the bill to the USSR Comptroller.

At present we have no plans to do so, but if
we do, I would like to advise you to take care
of the proposed law so that it will not be
published in the Soviet zone.

1. As a result of the placing of additional restrictions on movement in the Army Zone, applications for passes beyond the line "Dugout" (see) - Plain - Plain will not be made by telephone or telegraph.
2. Under the present law relating to passes and the restriction of personnel, Sub-Commanders will have to apply to the R.C.A.S. Fifth Army, a complete form for each proposed journey. It will be submitted to the application, Appl. Fifth Army by Regional Commanders.

MOTION

(1) Col. Debenham requested the position of commanding general for the report party from British authorities to arrive by plane. He was so short of petrol that he had none to spare. H.M. informed this point that Col. Debenham should take up the same arrangements with Periodic Section direct.

- (e) The motion will be placed in paper form to him saying that "Dear Col. Debenham, I enclose a series of official passes to be withdrawn and issued to you. They will be given to you by Periodic Section and Periodic Section direct. Col. Debenham should take up the same arrangements with Periodic Section direct."
3. Italian Government Officials. (This does not include local Government officials).

The method of issuing passes to Italian Department officials would be as follows: The official would apply to the corresponding Sub-Commission or Section concerned for a special official pass. It would be issued, Sub-Commission, Branches of the Army, Navy, and R.C.A.F. Sections to whom they would sign the passes. In the case of political Section, General Headquarters and R.H.Q., special passes would be issued through the Sub-Commission and R.H.Q. to the Political Section, to the Secretary General for signature. Instructions will be issued to all concerned. It was decided that G.A.R. were unlikely to be issued to the effect that the only official R.H.Q. pass issued in the yellow pass (attached as a specimen).

4. Passes to Room.

Reference Letters No. 751/773 of 7 June 1944 and 751/22/24 of 6 July 1944, these letters are now cancelled. No special passes will be issued in future. The only pass now required to enter Room - the ordinary yellow pass, which will be required by anyone coming from outside local Province.

5. Special Passes for Ministers.

If it was decided that a special pass removable after three months should be made out for Ministers of the Italian Government and other important officials holding certain jurisdictions, this would consist of an endorsement on the back of the official yellow pass with the following wording:

"S... (Signature) (Official) in charge account
to proceed to any part of Italy which of the Army General
Staff, H.Q. or Secretary General, as in para. 1 above, and then sent to
C.A.R. H.Q. for counter signature. Instructions will be issued.

The pass should be issued to cover current signature month or the Army General Staff. When the pass is made out it should be signed at H.Q. by Secretary General, as in para. 1 above, and then sent to C.A.R. H.Q. for counter signature. Instructions will be issued.

In view of the following, the circular would apply to the correspondingly sub-organisation or Section concerned for approval of his work. It is submitted, Sub-Controller, Branches of the A.M., soon, and S.C. A.M., before he goes through these passes (through the General who would sign the passes). In the case of Political Section, Trade and Art. Public Relations and P.R.C., required passes to go direct to the Secretary General for signature.

Instructions shall be issued to local concerned. It was decided that no liability was imposed to the officers, that (in only of) A.M., C.R., and I.C. (and in ten million pataas (covered in a memorandum).

4. Passes to Home.

Reference letter No. 75/76/3 of 7 June 1941 and 75/22/3 of 8 July 1941, those letters are now compiled, to be used, I believe, to the ordinary yellow pass, which will be required by anyone going to the outside provinces.

5. Special Passes for Soldiers.

It was decided that a special pass entitled after three months should be made out for members of the Italian Government and other important officers from certain organisations. This would consist of an endorsement on the back of the official yellow pass with the following wording:

5. (designation of officer) is holding a post
of to proceed to and from Italy south of the Army Control
Point. He should be given every facility for travel.

C.A.B. H. All for points mentioned, I.C. and I.C. to be used to cover movement and other movements south of the Army Control Point. When the pass is made out it should be signed by the Secretary General, as in past. I also, and when sent to the controller of Posts or Revenue, will be considered.

6. Revised Circular - Issue of passes to the provinces.

In view of the movement and Italian Government territory, under para. 4 (b) of 31/76/3 of 25 April 1941, Police Province (now known as expressly enclaved areas) this provision, with the Government having to the provinces to issue passes, passes, (see note 5 above), to do so. 

- 1 AAC Officers : the procedure is laid down in 750/2 GA of 5 Jun.
 - a This Section has been informed that endorsement of applications by the VP will facilitate and expedite the granting of passes.
 - b Sub-Commissions desiring to obtain such an endorsement will attach to the application a memo addressed to the VP containing a short statement as to the reasons for the visit and a certificate that the visit is essential and cannot without detriment to ACC work be deferred to a later date. Below their signature they will add an endorsement "Approved" addressed to the Security Branch and signed by the COO for VP Adm Sec.
- 2 Italian Officials : the procedure is laid down in 751/7 of 7 Jun.
 - a The CO desires that visits by Italian Nationals should be confined to the minimum.
 - b Applications for passes for Ministers and Under Secretaries will be submitted to the Secretary General.
 - c Applications for other Italian nationals will only be granted in exceptional circumstances, and will be submitted through the VP in manner similar to that described in para 1 b above.



REMARKS : Room occupation - Control of Monuments.

TO : All Army Sub-Commissioners.

1. The following regulations apply to visits to Rome.
2. No visit may be made without the express sanction of the G.O.
3. A permit will only be granted where the duty is essential.
4. Applications for permits will be submitted to A.G.C. Section and will specify name, rank, number and appointment of the officer concerned, short particulars of the duty he is to perform, the inclusive dates necessary for the performance of that duty and a certificate signed by the Director that the visit is essential for A.G.C. purposes.
5. Officers to whom a permit is granted will report arrival at and departure from Rome to the G.O.C. and at the conclusion of his visit return without delay to his station and surrender the permit to the G.O.C. or G.O. & M.A.C.





The Italian Military Forces when not on duty, e.g. when on leave, are subject to the same restrictions as civilians."
