1. Ref: your 20391/MFAA of 14 May 45, transmitting various documents from the Ministry of the Interior for State Archives officials and others in Venezia, Udine, and Trieste.

2. It is fully appreciated that every effort should be made to enable governmental agencies to function normally at an early date. If the Ministry wishes to convey information to its field officials, this office will gladly do all it can to facilitate transmittal of such documents. This territory, however, is not yet under either the responsibility or the authority of the Italian Government, and letters sent out by the Ministry should clearly indicate this fact, at least to the extent of asking that such-and-such report be sent in through the courtesy of AMG and not in response to a direct order which the Ministry has no authority to issue in this territory. To permit field officials to receive orders from the Ministry will only contribute, as it has already contributed elsewhere, to the confusion of these field officials in their endeavor to do a good and correct job under AMG.

3. In line with the above, there have been sent forward to Venezia item 17 to Museo Correr, and item 16 to Archivio dello Stato. In the latter case, however, it was necessary to interpolate frequent references to AMG to keep the letter clear. Such waste of MFAA Officers' time on amendments should not be necessary; the Ministry can perfectly well phrase their letters correctly if indeed they write them in good faith.

4. Items 18 and 19 cannot yet go forward in their present state, as these places are still in Army area where the confusion caused by terminology of the letters would be most unfortunate. Rather than return the letters, as no doubt should be done, this office will hold

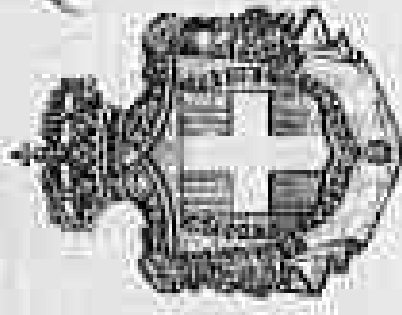

b) Effetti diretti o indiretti degli avvenimenti bellici sulla consistenza e condizione degli Archivi: precisando anche qui, in caso di danni subiti, la qualità delle serie manomesse o perdute, il numero delle unità per ciascuna di esse, evidenziando, con assoluta esattezza, la causa delle singole perdite (bombardamento, combattimento, distruzione sistematica o casuale da parte di truppe; o anche dispersione o saccheggio da parte della popolazione civile, e abbandono o insufficiente attenzione da parte delle autorità).

c) Stato presente: provvedimenti attuati o in corso di attuazione per il ritorno allo stato normale (ritorno in sede, riordinamenti, revisioni etc.) Eventuali proposte.

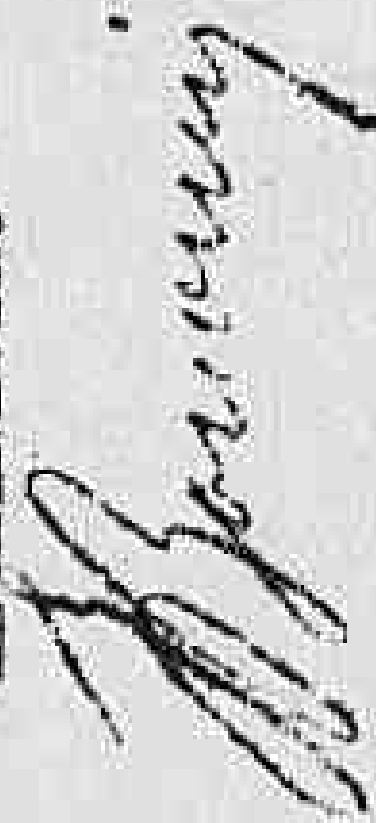
